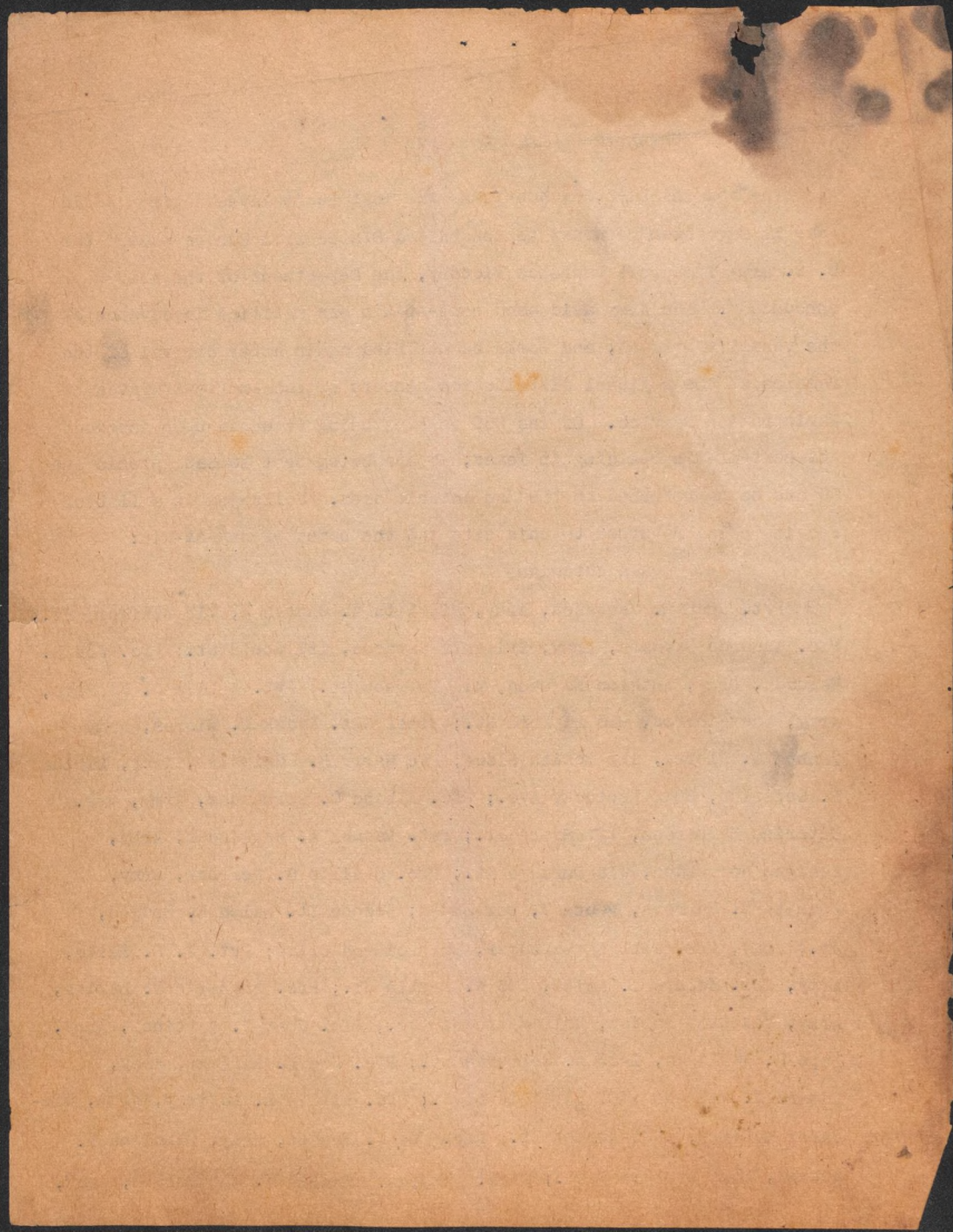


ARMY RETURNS REMAINS OF SOUTH TEXAS HEROES
FOR BURIAL IN CEMETERIES NEAR HOMES

The remains of 5,864 Americans who lost their lives during World War II have been returned to the United States from Europe aboard the U. S. Army Transport Lawrence Victory, the Department of the Army announced. The Army said each next-of-kin was notified in advance of the vessel's arrival, and would be notified again after arrival of the remains at the regional distribution centers of the American Graves Registration Service. Of the 259 remains being returned upon instructions of next-of-kin residing in Texas, 25 are being sent to San Antonio and 65 are being returned to the San Antonio area. 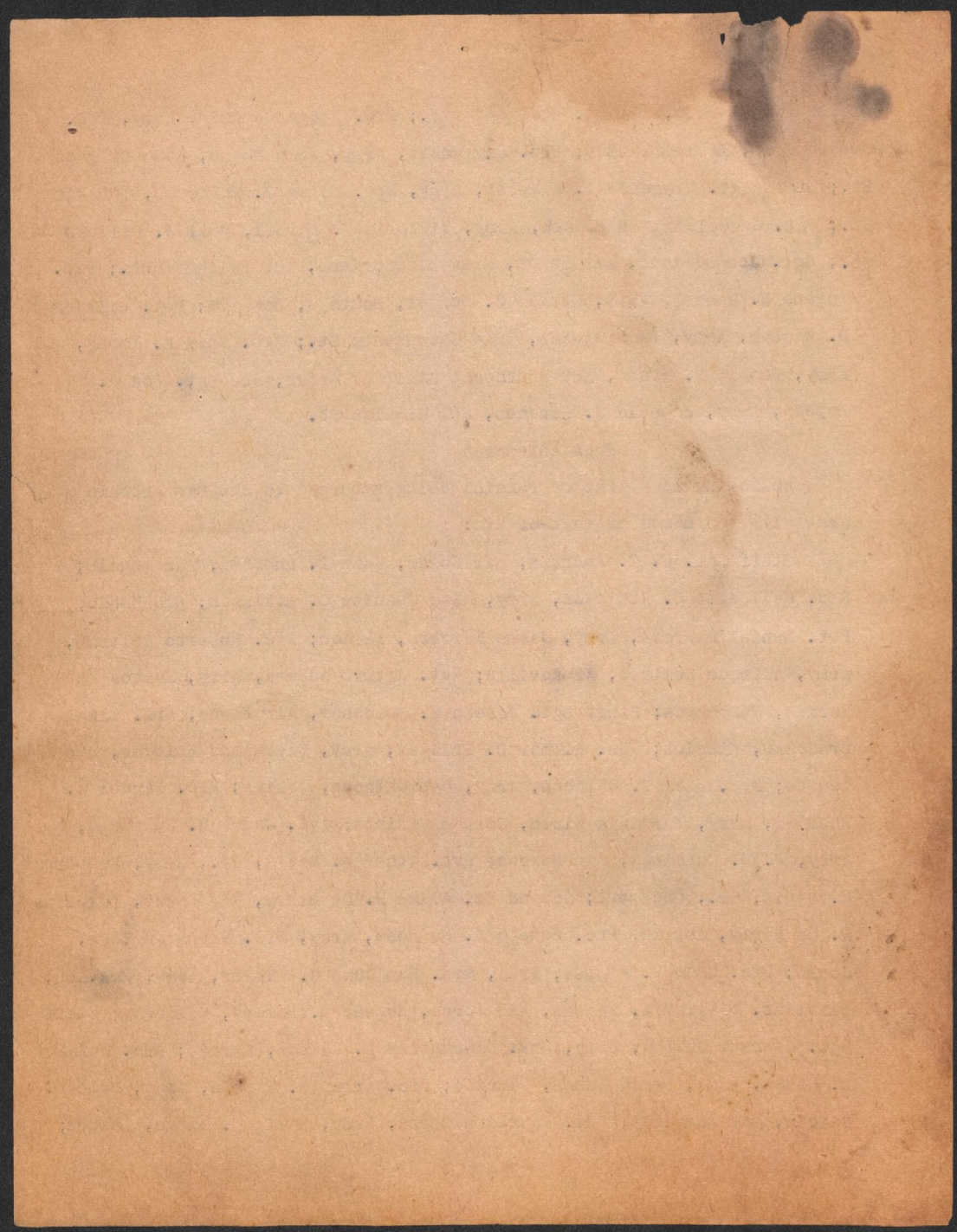
