## The Exhibit

**T**he holiday exhibit, from the extraordinary collections of Frell Albright, reflects the interests of one of the library's most ardent benefactors. Holdings in the Department of Special Collections have been enriched over the past twenty years by Frell Albright's generosity and involvement in library activities. Items on exhibit represent only a portion of Mr. Albright's gifts of rare and unusual materials.

Frell Albright is a native of Sylacauga, Alabama where, as a child, he enjoyed collecting "things." Particular attractions included old books with colorful prints. At an early age he used his weekly allowance of 25 cents to purchase an Audubon print and an oil painting of a Greek icon. Both items are still in Mr. Albright's personal collections and the painting has significantly increased in value. The collector's interests also include Meissen porcelain, stamps, and ancient and primitive art.

Mr. Albright became a student of typography and his interest in printing extended to books. He won a scholarship in art and eventually pursued a career in commercial art. Mr. Albright is now Vice President of Advertising for a major Houston firm. His many artistic talents have been shared with the Friends over the years as he has provided invaluable assistance in their many printing and graphics projects. In addition, he serves on the Executive Committee of the Friends organization.
