Dear Sir:

This owns receipt of your letter of November 30th.

1st: As reported to you in my letter of November 5, 1925, the building and ground plans were submitted to and approved by Mayor Holcombe.

2nd: Mr. C. L. Brock, Park Superintendent, was furnished promptly with copies of the ground plans. Mr. Sullivan, the Architect, also furnished copy of the ground plans to Mr. Herbert Hare of Kansas City, but heard nothing from him with reference to his recommendations.

3rd: Under the original agreement with the City, it is obligated, among other things, to install and provide ground grading, hedges, shrubbery, etc., and maintain such in perpetuity.

4th: The Charter and by-laws of the Hospital, referred to in the original agreement, provide for a white advisory committee.

5th: Paragraph 6 of the agreement between the Houston Negro Hospital and the City of Houston provides:

"First Party and Second Party will enter into a further written agreement providing for the operation and maintenance of said hospital by or before its completion."


I am of the opinion that an appropriate contract should now be entered into between the City and the Hospital Corporation, in accordance with the foregoing, in which
