A Stupid Foreign Policy Blows Up In American Diplomats' Red Faces

Texas Voters Register Their Strong Disapproval of Government by Goons

In spite of the handicap of a third-term bid, a custom not generally favored by Texans, the State's popular and nationally-prominent Chief Executive, Allan Shivers, won his race for re-election in the August run-off primary by a majority of almost one hundred thousand votes.

Pitted against him in the campaign for control of the State's governing machinery were the political Action Committee of the CIO, Americans for Democratic Action, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, gorillas of the late Sidney Hillman's Garment Workers from New York's Lower East Side, the fading South Texas political boss, George Parr and a ragged remnant of disgruntled Fair Dealers headed by Sam Rayburn of Bonham.

The candidate whose name appeared on the ballot as the standard-bearer of these motley groups was Ralph Yarborough, an Austin attorney, whose campaign was pitched on the smear tactics outlined by his sponsors.

It was the victory of these left-wing forces in the first primary in which Wingate Lucas of Fort Worth and Ken Regan of Midland went down to defeat in their races for re-election to Congress, that alerted the people of Texas to danger and brought out the largest contingent of voters in the history of the State, in the August primary.

The overwhelming victory of Governor Shivers not only reassured the troubled citizens of Texas that Segregation would remain intact in the public schools of the State, but his continued firm hold of the reins of Party leadership in Texas and the South was hailed by national conservative Democrats as a strong potential weapon in the forthcoming fight to wrest control

We Can't Win For Losing

of the party from the machine bosses and subversive minority groups who have dominated it since 1932.

For years American taxpayers have stood still while Washington politicians picked their pockets of billions of dollars. The loot from this legalized highjacking has been sent to the Socialist Countries of Europe with the announced objective of "holding the line against Communism" although there is not a particle of difference in the two ideologies. There is no system of accounting ever devised by human brain which could provide the taxpayers of the United States with any reasonably accurate estimate of the billions of dollars which have been sunk in senseless projects scattered over the four corners of the earth.

Neither can there be restoration of the hundreds of thousands of lives sacrificed by American boys on far-off battle fields in causes having nothing whatever to do with the protection, honor and defense of the country of their birth.

And there can be no Resurrection Morning for a crucified Constitution nailed to the Cross by atheistic conspirators against a nation which was conceived in liberty, baptised in blood and dedicated to the cause of Christian ideals.

Millions of Americans Think It--The Southern Conservative Says It

Senator Charges That England and France Have Their Own Little Private Pacts With Russia

A move to kill off the foreign aid bill and to utilize the money which has accumulated in that fund for building up the American Air Force was made on the floor of the Senate by Senator George Malone of Nebraska on July 30th when that measure was up for consideration. Under his plan, two thousand heavy jet bombers and three thousand jet interceptors would have been added to American Air Force equipment.

Senator Malone made this sound proposal after a lengthy speech to his colleagues in which he offered documented evidence that American taxpayers are being imposed upon and American friendship abused by the recipients of this foreign aid money which totals \$59,000,000,000 since World War II.

This especially applied to Great Britain who, even as Senator Malone was speaking on the floor of the Senate, was sending a mission to Moscow and Red China, the expenses of which could well have been paid out of American funds, and to France who has proved even more adept at double-crossing her American "allies" than her sister nation across the channel.

Senator Malone pointed out that while both England and France are stringing American diplomats along and bleeding American taxpayers for more and more money for defense against Soviet aggression, both of those countries have separate and independent mutual security pacts with Russia. There is a paragraph in each of the pacts, Senator Malone charged, which is practically a duplicate of the North Atlantic Treaty Pact.

"They are signed up with both Russia and the United States" Senator Malone told his colleagues although he had tried to pound this information

For seven years, we pursued the wild and visionary dream of "strength through weakness" by building our security on European defense at the urging of "liberals" in the government, in Congress, in the press, in minority groups and in the White House and channelled untold billions into Europe with the objective of "protecting ourselves through saving the Democracies from Communism" and now we are left holding the empty bag.

The "Democracies" turned out to be just what that word implies and, in a showdown, demonstrated their preference for the slavery of a Socialist State when weighed against the freedoms of a Constitutional Republic.

If, as we have been led to believe by the bird-brains and subversives in Washington, our national existence and security depended on alliances with European powers, then we are sunk for the EDC Pact has been blown to bits and the Kremlin will call the shots in that unhappy continent from now on.

Of course this line of reasoning was wrong, weak and immoral and our national safety did not depend on our coddling of, and cooperation with, Socialist Europe and if the billions of dollars which have been wantonly dissipated in trying to prop up decadent and falling empires had been converted to the building up of our own military defenses, we would still be the proud and invincible nation we once were and invulnerable to attack from any source on earth.

If a comic note can be plucked from tragedy or a smile dredged up from tears, we can be amused in retrospect at the discomfiture of those well-meaning but brainless Americans who so blithely followed the Communist Party line and scornfully branded American patriots as "isolationists", a term they will now probably shy away from as long as they live.

For we are really "isolationists" now and make no mistake about it. We are not isolationists by choice or because we didn't try to buddy up and bed down with every alien people under the sun, but because they have deserted us of their own free will and left us to our own devices in a state of isolationism from which we should have never departed.

We hope it is not too late for us to marshal our forces, evaluate our resources and formulate a new national policy in keeping with that of the great leaders who steered a safe and sane course in the early days of the Republic but there is grave doubt as to whether we have the rugged and robust type of statesmanship necessary to make the adjustment.

It is our fear that only a merciful Providence which tempers the wind to the shorn lamb and safeguards imbeciles against danger and harm, can retrieve us from the folly, stupidity and fumbling errors of those who, either unwittingly or through design, have betrayed the Republic they swore to uphold and defend.

Washington Correspondent Implies That Blackmail Through The Federal Taxing Power Continues as a National Policy

The right of the Federal government to levy taxes against the citizens of these United States was granted by the Constitution for the purpose of raising revenue only, in order to carry on specified and legitimate functions of that government.

Under no condition was this authority ever to be used as a weapon to reward the friends and punish the enemies of any political administration.

This was constantly done by the Roosevelt and Truman administrations as we have so often pointed out editorially, but those who voted for a change in Washington in 1952 fervently hoped and believed that this policy would be discontinued.

Accordingly, it was somewhat of a shock to read in the Congressional Record of Thursday, May 19, 1954, the reproduction of an article appearing in the Arkansas Gazette by one Elizabeth Carpenter, Washington newspaper correspondent, which indicates that this method of reward and punishment is still in effect. The article was inserted in the Record by Rhodes scholar Fulbright who represents a certain segment of the people of that great State.

In this article, carrying a Washington dateline, was an implied threat against reputable citizens of Texas who support Senator Joseph R. McCarthy in his fight on Communism, and if this Pink Lady of the Press writes with the authority which Fulbright ascribes to her, the old Spanish custom of reward and punishment through taxation is still in effect.

"Texas oil men who back Senator Joseph R. McCarthy are being told quietly but emphatically that their support may cost them the income tax privilege they now enjoy" smugly asserts the lady in the opening line of her article.

"Members of the Ways and Means Committee who write the tax bills and so far have warded off repeated attempts to lower or erase the 27½ per cent depletion allowance permitted on oil income, are telling Texas Congressmen that it has got to a point where a vote for the depletion allowance is a vote for McCarthy."

"This turn of events is the result of a buildup of resentment against 'Texas Oil Money', a term which recurs frequently on the cocktail circuit here . . ."

In the plans to form a Southeast Asia Treaty organization, it is proposed to leave out the best friends we have in that area—South Korea, Nationalist China and Japan. More and more, it is becoming plain that the only countries who are able to win consideration from us are those who kick us in the teeth.

"The Texas oil money became the popular theme shortly after the epidemic of national publicity on H. Roy Cullen, H. L. Hunt, Clint Murchison, Sid Richardson, their bank accounts and eccentricities.

"The talk however is significant from the political standpoint—and it may very well pave the way for a reduction in the 27½ per cent depletion allowance . . ."

The 27½ per cent depletion allowance in the current and former Federal tax measures was granted to encourage new ventures in oil production in the interest of the national security, but here is an accredited Washington correspondent expressing the opinion that it may be withdrawn from those who oppose Communism and approve Senator McCarthy's efforts to expose its infiltration in the American governing agencies.

What the gin guzzlers on the Washington "cocktail circuit" say or think is not of the slightest concern to any one except their own breed but when, as in the case of this woman, an implied threat is made against prominent citizens of Texas and attributed to responsible leaders in Washington, something should be done about it.

Indirectly, it infers that members of the Republican-dominated Ways and Means Committee of Congress, with administration approval, are employing blackmail tactics to whip Texas oil men into line who oppose the infiltration of Communists in Washington government agencies.

This Carpenter person should be placed under oath and forced to give the names of the members of the Ways and Means Committee who are threatening members of Congress from Texas. Also she should be compelled to reveal the names of the Texas Congressmen so threatened. The people of Texas are entitled to this information in possession of a Washington correspondent concerning a matter of such vital interest to them and which has been withheld from them.

It is a serious and challenging indictment against the Ways and Means Committee and if it is allowed to pass without denial or refutation, we are perfectly justified in believing that her charges are true and that punishment through the taxing power of government is still our accepted national policy.

If there ever was a bird that will bear watching, it is the character Mendez-France, premier of the country whose name he bears or vice versa. If he is not a plain, straight-out agent of the Soviet, we don't know what one is. He is delivering the goods to his Kremlin masters in a big way.

Counter Intelligence Agent's Work Is Sabotaged

If apathetic Americans could only read even a small part of the shocking testimony available in Washington, there would be a revival of patriotism in this country equal to that which existed in the days when Lexington, Concord and Valley Forge were making the headlines.

There are thousands of cases which make our blood run cold but the testimony of John Lansdale, Jr., in the Atomic Energy hearings last Spring, will give an idea of what we are trying to convey.

Lansdale was in the Counter Intelligence Branch of the Office of Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, War Department General Staff during World War II. On Page 270 of United States Atomic Energy Commission Hearings on Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer in April and May, 1954, Mr. Lansdale testified under oath:

"In the War Department, I was being subjected to pressure from military superiors, from the White House and from every other place because I dared to stop the commissioning of a group of 15 or 20 undoubted Communists. I was being villified, being reviewed and re-reviewed by Boards because of my efforts to get Communists out of the Army and being frustrated by the blind, naive attitude of Mrs. Roosevelt and those around her in the White House, which resulted in serious and extreme damage to this country".

Why the Soviets Regard Us as Fools

Old Fathead Flanders' attack on Senator McCarthy reminded us of nothing so much as a little feist dog snapping at the flanks of a Great Dane.

When he realized that he was too little to reach any vital spot, he gave up the chase and ran away.

Meantime a whole pack was sicked on the Wisconsin senator through the passage of a Senate resolution providing for another investigation to find out if he should be "censured" for departing from the long-established Washington policy of coddling Communists, and cracking down on the dirty skunks.

This indefensible action by the Senate afforded a sickening spectacle to concerned and fearful Americans who can see in the nauseating performance the disconcerting suggestion that the "Twenty Years of Treason" era may not yet have passed.

Down in little Guatemala where Communists were recently ousted from government control, the present administration has passed a law to insure that the Reds do not regain power.

Persons engaged in Communist activities in that country in future will be subject to penalties ranging from a year in prison to death. It is as simple as that.

We recently passed a similar law here too, but it has no teeth in it and Communist Party leaders in New York issued a statement in the press that they would openly defy the new legislation. They boldly asserted that they would continue to publish the Daily Worker, official Communist newspaper, that Communist candidates for office will continue to campaign and that Communist leaders will fulfill public speaking engagements, and they made it plain that we can take it or leave it.

And how do they get away with open defiance like that?

Well, the truth is that our government has as good as officially notified them that it is much more concerned in stopping McCarthy's investigation of Communism than it is in getting rid of Communists.

And any one who thinks that the Soviet conspirators in this country are not going to take advantage of an opening like that is too stupid to merit consideration.

The net effect of the attacks on the Wisconsin senator has been the creation of the widespread belief that the official policy of government is "Joe must go but the Communists can stay".

Another Investigation Halted

The Committee of Congress operating under the chairmanship of Hon. Carol Reece of Tennessee and which was charged with the responsibility of probing into the activities of the large foundations suspected of extending grants to Communist individuals and movements, has suddenly been discontinued.

There was no explanation and deep mystery surrounds the termination of the investigation into a group which has been under almost universal suspicion of financing subversive undertakings in this country for many years.

We do not believe that the blame attaches to Congressman Reece who has given every indication of desiring to probe into the subject thoroughly but who had the organized opposition of powerful pressure groups and individuals.

Next month we will go into some of the activities of the Foundations and it may be that the truth about who stopped the investigation can be developed by that time.

South Will Continue to Practice Segregation

When the Supreme Court first issued its ruling to break down racial safeguards in the South, most thoughtful citizens were numbed to such an extent that it was difficult to take in the enormity of this legalized offense against the rights and dignity of a sovereign people.

Since that time resentment has gradually built up in the South until the boiling point has been reached. As of now, majority opinion is that there will be no change in educational policies in most of the Southern States and that segregation will continue in effect.

Officials of Georgia have announced that they will ignore the ruling altogether and Alabama, Mississippi, South Carolina and other states have indicated a similar determination to invoke their Constitutional privileges of running internal affairs in accordance with the wishes of their own people.

The suspension of Annie Lee Moss from her position with the Signal Corps pending further investigation into charges against her, is another confirmation of Senator McCarthy's accuracy in pinpointing Communists in government jobs.

Annie Lee is the Negress who was identified by Mary Markward, undercover agent for the FBI, who testified under oath that the Moss woman was a dues-paying member of the Communist Party. Miss Markward's testimony was corroborated by the sworn statements of other responsible witnesses.

When Senator McCarthy heard this testimony before his committee and advised that the Negress be relieved of her duties in the important job she held, bedlam broke loose and there was double wailing on the part of the "liberals" and bleeding hearts. Not only did they deplore the expose of a Communist in a sensitive job but the exposed person was colored which added to their anguish.

Senator Stuart Symington of Missouri, a member of the Committee, was especially incensed and after she was suspended from her job as a transmitter of government messages, he invited her to come up and see him sometime and assured her that he would give her a job if she was not taken back into the Army.

Soon after, she was taken back but was put in a non-sensitive position, whereupon the Reds jumped up and down with glee, and pointed this out as one of McCarthy's "mistakes" in which he had accused an "innocent person."

Now the Army has been compelled to suspend her from even the non-sensitive job in view of the evidence piling up against her concerning Communist affiliations.

Another substantiation of the Washington attitude that "Commies may stay but Joe must go!"

World Communist Propaganda Organization Holds Its Convention in Evanston, Illinois

The World Council of Churches which, was permitted to meet in an American City, Evanston, Illinois, recently, is the "Ware Cell" of Protestantism which is working through religious bodies to primarily destroy the American and all other nationalist governments and bring about a Communist World State.

At its first meeting in Amsterdam in 1948, it condemned the American system of government by passing a resolution against it and while they went through the gesture of including Communism in the resolution also, it was only lip service for all of its precepts are based on Communist ideology.

It has come—because of those associated with it and of the things for which it stands—to be recognized by all persons of intelligence and perception as an outright Communist propaganda organization.

At the Amsterdam meeting and joining in with the condemnation of his own system of government was a representative of the Union Theological Seminary of this country, Dr. John C. Bennett who said recently in the Christian Century, left-wing church paper:

"Communism wins power because it has much truth in its teachings, because it speaks to the loyalties and not primarily to the cynical self interests of men. As the Christian studies Communism, he will find many things to approve in it. I refer to the Communist criticism of capitalism and imperialism, the Communist practice as regards racial discrimination, the Communist goal of a classless society and the generous motives that inspire many people to give themselves to Communism with selfless commitment."

Present also at the original meeting was that seasoned old Communist-frontier, Bishop G. Bromley Oxnam who justified the criticism of "Capitalism" on the ground that there is a definite "trend from competitive struggle to cooperative endeavor; from selfish nationalism to sensible internationalism" and all the other fellow travelling preachers of this country who have swarmed to the Karl Marx movement in church circles, and which is of such dimensions that it is fast taking over leading Protestant denominations in the United States.

The World Council of Churches sponsors "co-existence and peaceful

competition" of Communism and Christianity and some of its leaders so stated at its recent meeting.

It also advocates abolishment of all racial safeguards in this country and the promiscuous social mixing of the white and black races.

The group favors international control of all armies and navies; the complete abandonment of "isolationist" policies; strong limitations on national sovereignty; elimination of all tariff restrictions on world trade and a universal system of money although it is difficult to understand why, any of these matters should be of the slightest concern to the ministry.

They have made insistent demands for "freedom of immigration" and repeal or revision of the McCarran-Walter Immigration law to the end that Communist spies and subversive agents from all countries may flood this country with propaganda. Incidentally, this law had to be by-passed for the moment in order that these propagandists in the Council could attend the Evanston meeting.

There has been consternation in many quarters that John Foster Dulles would permit them to be issued visas to come here but that is understandable since Dulles, himself was one of the officials of the old Federal Council of Churches (now the National Council of Churches) which helped set up the World Council, as was Harold Stassen to say nothing of Alger Hiss who also served on that Council.

Even if Mr. Dulles were not personally involved with the outfit, he would have perhaps been helpless to do anything to prevent the alien propagandists composing it from coming here.

After all, this World Council is a strong and vital part of the world conspiracy whose invisible leaders dictate, and are not dictated to, concerning the actions of mere heads of a government.

Even if he had been disposed to bar these Communist agents, he would have been powerless to do so.

The greatest damage to American society from the gathering, of course, lies in the attendance of many ministers of the United States at the convention where they were re-indoctrinated with the Communist ideology and who will spread the contamination among their congregations.

Civil Aeronautics Board Knocks Out Security Rules

One of the various changes made in fundamental and traditional procedure for the protection and security of the United States, and of which the American people generally have been kept in ignorance, is found in revised air regulations.

Up until recently any applicant for a certificate to operate aircraft in the United States was required by the Civil Aeronautics Board to be an American citizen of undisputed loyalty with allegiance to the American Flag.

It's not that way now and such certificates are issued to any international bum of any country regardless of loyalty or allegiance.

On March 23, 1954, Section 21-12 of our Civil Air Regulations was amended in these words:

"21-12 Citizenship. An applicant for a pilot certificate with an airline rating may be a citizen of any country or a person without nationality." All other sections dealing with various types of air transport have been amended in the same identical language.

The action of the Civil Aeronautics Board in opening up this "loophole" to our enemy is pointed out in a bulletin issued by the Closer Up-Don Bell Reports from West Palm Beach, Florida, a research and writing team who have unearthed scores of similar shocking and unbelievable documented performances from government files.

Roy Cohn Is Out but John Adams Remains on the Job

The scant respect which the American people have for Pentagon politicians was not heightened any by the dishonorable manner in which they handled the case of John Adams.

The impression was deliberately left that he would be forced out of his job in the Pentagon as a result of a trade between the Army brass and the leftists on the committee which "investigated" the McCarthy-Stevens affair, whereby Roy Cohn was compelled to resign.

Cohn who was one of the most valuable assistants McCarthy had in tracking down Communists has gone while Adams who is not worth anything to anybody so far as national security is concerned remains on the job.

Georgia Methodists Suspend Minister For Denouncing Communism in Church

The time was not 1692.

The place was not Salem, Massachusetts.

The occasion was not the trial of a few helpless females charged with witchcraft.

The place was Atlanta, Georgia and the time was 1954. The occasion was the trial of a small-town Georgia Methodist preacher and the charge was "imprudent and unministerial conduct".

Rev. Blake Craft of Clayton, Georgia editor of a monthly newspaper called "One Methodist Voice" was being tried on charges preferred by the Annual Conference of his church while thirteen "liberal" preachers of his denomination sat in judgment.

The offense of which the Rev. Craft was admittedly guilty was the bitter denunciation through the columns of his paper of the infiltration of the Methodist Church by Communist ideology and the membership of numerous ministers of that faith in Communist Fronts.

The Ministerial Court, after due deliberation, rendered a verdict in which he was suspended "from the exercise of the functions of his office, effective from this date to continue until the opening date of the Annual Conference of the North Georgia Conference in the year 1955".

In the meantime, the Rev. Craft is prohibited from filling the pulpit in his home town by an edict of this clique of over-fed and under-bred theological hypocrites who have never offered a word of protest as their colleagues have spouted Communist doctrine under the guise of the Gospel, or raised their hand against the subversives who have swarmed into that and other denominations like a plague of seven-year locusts.

Members of Supreme Court Deserve Mass Impeachment

When the Supreme Court issued its unfortunate ruling that Segregation must be abolished, there was a document in the files in Washington available to them which would have made any decent and responsible man, or set of men, hesitate a long time before deliberately placing in the hands of our enemies a weapon which these same enemies openly said would be valuable in enabling them to take over the United States.

The terms 'colonialism' and 'imperialism' must be featured in our propaganda. In America, we will aim for a subtle victory. While inflaming the Negro minority against the whites, we will endeavor to instill in the whites a guilt complex for their exploitation of the Negroes. We will aid the Negroes to rise to prominence in every walk of life, in the professions and in the world of sports and entertainment. With this prestige, the Negroes will be able to inter-marry with the whites and begin a process which will deliver America to our cause."

How thoroughly they planned this program and how effectively they sold it to suckers in this country was forcefully illustrated when the Supreme Court delivered its blow against the pride and dignity of members of both the white and black races in the South.

Some of the members of that Court acted deliberately and with full knowledge of the horrible potentialities involved in their decision; others performed as simple dupes of subtle forces who outranked them in mentality, maneuvering tactics and strategic planning.

And all of them functioned traitorously in behalf of an enemy's announced plan to disrupt the morals of this country as a prelude to taking it over.

Saudi Arabia informed Washington on August 13 to discontinue its foreign aid program in that country. They have an oil income of \$200,000,000 annually and say they can manage their own future affairs. We have a thirty-man mission stationed there and have been spending \$1,632,000 per year in that country. Whether our officials will discontinue the program as requested or insist on continuing to help them even though they don't want it, was not disclosed, but it's a safe bet that we will give up reluctantly, if at all.

Girl Scout Leaders Are Reported to Have Restored Americanism to Their Material

Sometime ago the Illinois American Legion passed a resolution withdrawing support from the Girl Scouts organization because leaders of that group had deleted the American Constitution, Bill of Rights, the United States Flag, and the National Anthem from their literature and had substituted a lot of one-world and United Nations tripe in their material.

The resolution said that the Legion would withdraw all support "until such time as the Girl Scout leaders restore the time-honored American patriotic and historical ideals to their teachings."

Now it has been announced that officials of the Girl Scout movement have corrected this horrible blunder and have included the symbols of America in their published literature.

A regrettable thing about the incident is the statement of Irving Breakstone of Chicago, Commander of the Illinois Legion, who termed the resolution passed by the Legion as "unfortunate" and said it had been passed in a "highly emotional situation."

He is all wet and it certainly was not unfortunate. The Illinois Legion rendered a very definite service by the resolution since it seems to have gotten the job done and caused the Girl Scout leaders to reverse their disgraceful action in eliminating reference to American documents. No apology was called for by Mr. Breakstone, and it was in very bad taste for him to express regret for an action on the part of the Illinois Legion which commanded the respect of all decent Americans.

We are particularly interested in the matter as we were one of the first to come out of the corner fighting when the Girl Scout leaders first started following the Communist Party Line in February, 1953. In the "Girl Scout Leader," official publication of that group of that date, Girl Scouts were advised to read the books of Langston Hughes, Negro Communist, and Dorothy Canfield Fisher, a white one.

The closing paragraph of our editorial said:

"If American parents want their children's views on citizenship influenced by black male Communist Fronters or white female subversives, that seems to be what they are getting, but if they don't, they had better take a good long searching look into what is going on."

Documented Case Gives Tip-Off as to Why Refrain of Top-Bracket Washington Politicians Is 'Joe Must Go'

When the machinery of the Federal government and the facilities of the Senate of the United States are employed to discredit a prominent public figure like Senator Joseph R. McCarthy, there is some deep and underlying reason for their remarkable action.

The reasons in his case are important in the extreme, not only because their revelation would vindicate Senator McCarthy and prove that the animosity he has engendered on the part of his accusers is based on their efforts to cover up the Communists he has sought to expose, but because scores of Americans are frankly baffled by it all and confused in trying to evaluate the matter accurately and with fairness to all.

A book with thousands of pages would be required to outline all the cases never made public in which Communist spies have been identified with governmental operations having to do with the safety and security of the United States, often with the knowledge and protection of responsible officials of government, and of outstanding laymen prominent in national affairs.

For our purposes, one such case will prove the point, and we will take the J. Robert Oppenheimer affair not only because he held one of the most responsible positions in the development of our atomic energy weapons, but because less information about his case has been available to the public than in any other instance of Communist infiltration into strategic posts.

Oppenheimer was Director of the laboratory in New Mexico that perfected the atomic and hydrogen bombs. In this capacity, he had access to various critical activities of the National Security Council, the Department of State, the Department of Defense, the Army, Navy and Air Force, the Central Intelligence Agency and other top-secret units of government.

Several years ago Senator McCarthy came into possession of information indicating that Oppenheimer was a security risk because of his personal association and social contacts with Communists but he was later to learn that this was not the half of it. He went to proper government officials with the information he had and was persuaded by the White House not to pursue the matter "for security reasons" and having his hands full in investigation of subversives in other agencies of government and the Army, McCarthy agreed to leave it for other authorities to handle. But he knew that Oppenheimer was suspect which meant that eventually, if others didn't act, he would. This kind of information in the hands of Joe McCarthy spells danger to those in government who have the same information but don't act on it.

Meantime, let us go way back to 1941 and see what Oppenheimer was doing along about then.

On a night in July of that year, an important and closely guarded meeting was being held at No. 10 Kenilworth Court, Berkeley, California. Participants in the gathering were members of the Special Section of the Communist Party, a division of that Party which is so highly secret that even the persons composing it do not know each other's real names and who hold such strategic positions with the Party that no membership cards are issued to them. Their identity is protected at all costs, and their value to the Kremlin is beyond the power of the Western mind to evaluate.

The occasion for the meeting was that a switch had been made in Communist Party policy in Moscow which had to be transmitted to members of the Special Section in this country and the meeting on that particular night had been called for this purpose.

Later when FBI agents investigated the matter, they found that the home at 10 Kenilworth Court, Berkeley was owned by a member of the faculty of the University of California, but he had nothing to do with the meeting and did not even know that it was being held. He had leased his home for the summer through the Mason-McDuffie Real Estate Company who handled the transaction for him.

The name of the person who leased the home which was in a secluded section of the Berkeley Hills and could only be approached by a circuitous road, was Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer and investigation by the FBI at the utilities company showed that he paid the utility bills throughout the entire summer season.

The man who delivered the lecture at the Special Section session that night to explain in detail the change in Communist Party policy was named Paul Crouch, for seventeen years a top functionary in the inner councils of the Communist Party. He also was a member of the District Bureau, one of the most important party units in the country covering California, Arizona and the Hawaiian Islands.

When Crouch became disillusioned with Communism, he sought to make amends for his connection with this treasonous conspiracy against his country by giving all information in his possession to authorized investigating committees of Congress.

In 1950 he, together with his wife, Sylvia, testified under oath to the above circumstances and identified Dr. J. Robert Oppenheimer as having been present at the session of the Special Section members. Crouch swore that he was taken to the meeting that night by a Kenneth May, educational director of the Communist Party in Alameda County, California, and that the event occurred about one week before the Communist District Meeting in San Francisco. Both Crouch and his wife further testified that later they were at various social gatherings arranged by the Communist Party where Oppenheimer was present.

That testimony was in the hands of Washington authorities from 1950 on, but it was in the Spring of 1954 before action was taken to remove Oppenheimer. Meantime Russia's stockpile of atomic weapons kept pace with our own and some authorities have publicly claimed that it has surpassed that of this country.

Also, in comparison with the affluence and well being of those who have protected Communists in government and have given testimony in behalf of subversives, Paul Crouch is reported, as a result of his testimony, to be without a job and unable to get work. An Associated Press dispatch from Washington sometime ago reported Crouch as claiming that an official of the Department of Justice had ordered him "banished" to Hawaii as the result of the introduction of copies of testimony into the records of the Army-McCarthy hearings. Two fellow traveller newspaper columnists in Washington are also reported in the same Associated Press article as trying to make Crouch pay heavily for his cooperation in exposing Communist Party "methods."

When the Personnel Security Board in Washington finally took up the matter of Oppenheimer's loyalty in April, 1954 and held hearings for many weeks, he was barred from any further secrets in connection with atomic projects but was gratuitously pronounced a "loyal American."

Testimony in those hearings is highly illuminating but since it covers 992 pages, there is not much danger that it will ever be read by the general public.

It will be remembered that Oppenheimer secured his job in the first place partly through the intercession of James B. Conant, former head of Harvard and who was appointed by Eisenhower as High Commissioner in Germany. It was Conant who said: "There are no known Communists on the Harvard staff but if there were, the damage that would be done to the spirit of this academic community by an investigation aimed at finding secret Communists, would be far greater than any conceivable harm such a person (Communist) might do." He also made the brilliant assertion in Houston on his last visit there in a public statement: "Private schools for rich people's children should be abolished. There should be one public school for all." Presumably he wants to concentrate them in one unit so they can be educated in the school of political ideology subscribed to by his friend, Oppenheimer.

Arthur Compton, now Chancellor of Washington University in St. Louis, listed in Appendix IX in Washington files as having been affiliated with such Communist Fronts as American Committee for Democracy and Intellectual Freedom and the National Council of American-Soviet Friendship, was also instrumental in securing the job for Dr. Oppenheimer.

The late Karl T. Compton, national sponsor of the Communist Front National Council for American-Soviet Friendship was another who helped Oppenheimer secure his responsible job in atomic energy projects. Harry Truman and Vannevar Bush, President of Carnegie Institute, had high praise for Oppenheimer and his "service" to his country.

William L. Borden former executive director of the Joint Committee on Atomic Energy of the United States Congress, however, in testimony to the Personnel Security Board Hearing referred to Oppenheimer because of his access to new weapons being developed in this country as "in a position to compromise more vital and detailed information affecting the national defense and security than any other individual in the United States."

"As chairman or an official or unofficial member of more than thirty-five important government committees, panels, study groups, and projects, he has oriented or dominated key policies involving every principal United States security department and agency except the FBI" Borden stated in a communication to the FBI which was placed in the official testimony at the hearings. "This opinion considers the following factors, among others: He was contributing substantial monthly sums to the Communist Party; His ties with Communism had survived the Nazi-Soviet Pact and the Soviet attack upon Finland; His wife and younger brother were Communists; He had no close friends except Communists; He had at least one Communist mistress; He belonged only to Communist organizations, apart from professional affiliations; The people whom he recruited into the early wartime Berkeley atomic project were exclusively Communists; He had been instrumental in securing recruits for the Communist Party; He was in frequent contact with Soviet espionage agents."

And yet he was kept on in top-secret positions in the atomic weapons laboratories until it was impossible to longer ignore his affiliations with enemy agents and even then he was given a pat on the back by the Committee which said: "he was a security risk but a loyal American."

There is reason to believe that there are more Oppenheimers in sensitive defense positions of our government who will not be smoked out until their affiliations can no longer be ignored.

Senator McCarthy probably has access to more confidential information from accurate sources than any other individual in the world and if the contents of his vast files were exposed, it would probably do more damage politically than the explosion of a Russian bomb could cause physically.

Multiply this affair by hundreds and it will be easier to understand why so many highly-placed personalities in government are promoting the idea that "Joe Must Go," and why so many simple-minded persons on the outside who have no more understanding and knowledge of what is going on than a cock-roach, are ready to fall in line and join the chorus.

No, the fight against the Wisconsin senator and the efforts to discredit him emanating from so many sources are not spontaneous bursts of indignation at any action on his part.

They result from a cold, calculated and designed plan to render him ineffective in his investigations of Communism but, above all, to nullify the danger inherent in information he possesses which could conceivably blast many careers to bits.

New Communist Control Bill Gets Horse Laugh

In the closing days of the 83rd Congress a bill to outlaw the Communist Party was passed over strong opposition from the White House but as the measure, as finally passed, would outlaw the Communist Party but let the individuals who belong to it go free, it is regarded a little more than a joke, and especially by the Communists. The boys in the Kremlin must have popped their buttons off laughing at it.

The Fair Dealers jumped into the act too in an effort to make campaign thunder for this fall's election which added more comedy as Fair Deal Democrats want a Communist control bill about like we want a hole in our head. They were in power twenty years hands running and during that time their record on Communism was written and can't be erased so anything they say or do now about the subject is just blowing off steam.

"If it's O.K. to teach Communism in the schools to show its evils, then why shouldn't they also teach safe-cracking, opium smoking, pandhandling, street walking, swindling, guzzling, horse-handicapping and crap-shooting to show how bad they are too" asks New York columnist Lee Mortimer and we defy any addle-brained defender of "academic freedom" to answer that one.

Publicity on the meeting of the American Bar Association in Chicago during August pointed out the address of Earl Warren of the Supreme Court as the high point of the association's 77th annual convention. We wonder what the low point was.

Senator Warns Supreme Court It Has No Power to Enforce Segregation Ruling

The utter absurdity of the Supreme Court decisions on Segregation and its complete inability to enforce it was presented on the floor of the United States Senate by Honorable James O. Eastland of Mississippi.

Pointing out that there are 11,000 segregated school districts in the United States and that each one of the districts would have to be cited in contempt proceedings and a judgment obtained against that particular school, Senator Eastland predicted that any serious effort to enforce de-segregation would result in a "Century of Litigation".

Expressing amazement that many people in the North think that the South will comply with this decision, Senator Eastland said in part:

"The opinion delivered by the Supreme Court will not change public opinion. The Court has merely antagonized the people. A court decree is worthless unless it is supported by public opinion. A court decree to which the vast majority of Southern people are openly hostile will be worse than useless in the South . . . This decision will fall of its own weight because it is opposed by the vast majority of our people. It will take force to bring compliance with the decision of the Court. Where is that force? The Court cannot supply it!

"Here is what would happen: A school official, where the State school laws have been adjudged unconstitutional in a case in which the State was a party, and the judgment was against this particular school district, could be cited for contempt by the Supreme Court, if the school official refused to comply with and resisted the decree of the Court. He could be put in jail until he carried out the Court decree.

"This, however, will not apply to a private citizen. A private citizen, not a party to the suit, would not be in contempt and could not be proceeded against in a contempt action. What will happen, therefore, is that private citizens will not permit racial integration of their schools. They have the means to prevent it, and in my judgment will do so.

Senator Eastland further pointed out that any attempt by the Department of Justice to prosecute private citizens under the Federal Civil Rights statute would be confronted by the fact that the indictment must be returned by a grand jury in the State involved and the accused convicted by a trial jury in the State involved. "For one to think there would be indictments or convictions in most areas of the South is an absurdity" Senator Eastland asserted, and added:

"The police power of the State under our system of Government is supreme and absolute . . . The Governor of a sovereign State can use the force at his command, both police, civil and other, to maintain public order and prevent crime and riots. In fact it is his duty to preserve order and prevent turmoil and strife within the State. Should he fail to perform such duty, he would be subject to impeachment. He is accountable to no one except the legislature and the people of his State. He is the Governor of a sovereign State and the Supreme Court cannot control and direct his actions, under the American system of Government. If the Court could do so we would not have a dual system of government, with its division of powers. The Court could not cite him for contempt and if it did so, he would ignore the summons.

"The only weapon possessed by the Court is the citation for contempt and that is an ineffective weapon. It is an impractical weapon because the Supreme Court cannot operate the schools of the Southern States . . ."

Caryl Chessman, a thief, rapist and all-round hardened criminal was sentenced to die in San Quentin early this year. But he wrote a book and California authorities gave him a stay of execution and his stuff is now running serially in many newspapers. Who said that crime does not pay?

Even though he had nothing to go on but the opinion of nine men whose thinking has been dominated for years by left-wing groups, the Principal of the Hobbs, New Mexico, public school system, Charles L. Mills went right ahead and jumbled up 3600 white children and four hundred negro children on the opening day of school. In one case at least a negro teacher was assigned to teach classes composed partly of white children. Mills took this step even though he was warned there might be violence. It would be interesting to trace his background and learn where he acquired his racial views.

Tut Tut Old Comrades' Just Keep the Change

Just before Congress adjourned, the attention of the Senate was called to the fact that a small error had been made in figuring the total amount of aid to England during the past several years and that the mistake had just come to light.

It seems that in the rush of getting off to a Washington cocktail party, or some other equally important gathering in the national capital, somebody accidentally slipped a little matter of \$4,000,000,000.00 more to England under this program than had been allotted to her or that she had expected to receive.

We read on and on in the Congressional Record which told of it to see what, if anything, was going to be done about it but nothing more was said of the matter.

However, in the same edition of the Record we read of the controversy Mr. Harold Stassen, whose official job is to give away money, was having with some of the countries over there who have informed him that they don't want our money and who have advised him to get lost.

So far, he has refused to take their advice to go home and is still arguing with them that they do, too, want our money and is waving it in their faces to show them how pretty and green it is.
