

STATE OF TENNESSEE--No. 7360

To all to whom these presents shall come... GREETING:

KNOW YE, That, for and in consideration of the sum of *twelve and one half* cent per acre, paid into the office of the Entry-Taker of *Hickman* County, and entered on the *26* day of *August* 1825 pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the General Assembly of said state, passed on the twentysecond day of November, one thousand eight hundred and twentythree, and ~~the acts supplemental thereto~~, by No. *135*

there is granted by the said State of Tennessee, unto *James Walker*

a certain Tract or Parcel of LAND, containing *Eighty acres*

by survey bearing date the *first* day of *November* 1826 lying in said county, *on big Spring*

Creek and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Stake and white oak Twenty poles West of the north east corner of William Edwards lower tract Running thence West ninety two poles crossing a bend of Spring creek to a black oak thence North one hundred fourteen and 2/3 poles to a stake black oak and white oak thence East one hundred and twelve poles to a stake thence South to and with Walkers line one hundred fourteen and three tenth poles to a stake thence West with Edwards line twenty poles to the beginning

With the hereditaments and appurtenances. To **Have** and to **Hold** the said Tract or Parcel of LAND, with its appurtenances, to the said *James Walker* and *his* heirs forever.

In Witness Whereof, SAMUEL HOUSTON, Governor of the State of Tennessee, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed, at Nashville, on the *29* day of *November* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twentyseven, and of the independence of the United States the fiftysecond.
