OF PERSONNEL ON U.S.S. HOUSTON LOST IN
SUNDRA STRAITS, FEBRUARY 28, 1942

This, the 4th Exchange of Information Sheet is being written as we anxiously await official news of V-J Day.

Within a few weeks, we all should get an official notice concerning the fate of our loved ones. Some will receive good news--"alive and well;" others of us will learn our loved ones perished; and some of us will probably receive what is perhaps the worst news of all--"presumed to have died."

Few of us will be satisfied with the so-called "official news." We will all want details, and those details must come from the Houston men who come back-- only they will have the intimate details we all want so badly. If your Houston man returns, YOU will get the news but will you share it with those loved ones of Houston men who DO NOT RETURN?

My first Exchange Sheet of Jan. 15, 1944, contained about 200 names--this one lists 817 Houston men. Thanks to all of those who cooperated to make this listing possible. In my files are hundreds of letters expressing thanks for the information YOU and I have furnished. I wish I could share all these personal messages with you but that is impossible. I wish I could have personally replied to all the letters I received but that too would be almost impossible.

A few next of kin of Houston men have failed to cooperate--even to the extent of answering my questionnaire covering THEIR Houston man. Perhaps they have questioned my motives, and that is quite understandable. But the war is over now and no Jap can further harm your loved one. Won't you please confirm so this record will be a little more complete?--it will cost you only three cents postage and a little time! It may make you feel better to know that O.N.I. (Office of Naval Intelligence) asked the F.B.I. (Federal Bureau of Investigation) to investigate my activities over a year ago. The local Red Cross also received many inquiries on my work. If this activity had been wrong or dangerous to the war prisoners, it would have been stopped long ago. So -- come on -- join the Houston family and share your news with us all--please!!

My brother, Lt. Ernest D. Hodge, has not been heard from. Neither have over 400 other sons, husbands and brothers who were on the Houston Feb. 28, 1942. But I have verified 232 Houston men as officially listed as prisoners of war. My records (remember they are not accurate--not official) show:

Nike, Thailand -- 115 men have been reported to me as held at Nike. I am informed that Nike is not far from Bangkok, and the prisoners there were probably used to mine wolfram (tungsten ore) for the Japs. The climate is good and food rather plentiful.

Moulmein, Burma -- Most of the men reporting from Nike were first held at Moulmein, Burma--in fact, I am confident the 62 men my records show to be at Burma were long ago sent elsewhere--probably to Nike, Thailand.

Tokyo, Japan -- Only 10 Houston men are reported held at Tokyo camp.

Zentsuji, Japan -- This camp permits the 8 Houston officers held here to write full letters home, but only a few have come through the past year.

Java -- Nothing is known of the fate of the 9 Houston men my cards show held in Java. There have been bad reports indicating some Houston men may have been lost as a result of submarine action on Jap transports transferring prisoners of war from Java.

Hakodate (northern Japan) -- Not much known about this camp. I show 7 Houston men there but believe these men may have been transferred to Tokyo.

Fukuoka, Japan -- There is quite a bit of evidence to support a theory that many of the Houston prisoners from Burma and Thailand were recently transferred to Fukuoka. Only 5 men on my Houston list are so far reported from there but I'll wager lots more are found there.

Other camps -- Borneo, Formosa, Malaya, Philippines and just plain "Unknown Camps" account for the other 20 Houston men my list shows as officially declared Prisoners of War. Obviously, none of the 3 Houston men reported held in the Philippines are still there. If their families know where they were transferred, they have not yet advised me of the change in camps.

Many of you have furnished me with the Prisoner of War numbers of your Houston men. These tell quite a story and a definite pattern is discernible. (If I had all the P.O.W. numbers, I feel I could tell you a lot more). Two definite series of numbers prevail -- the 5000 series and the 10,000 series. The 500 series contain most of the Mariens reported by Lt. Frank Gallagher, and my record has many long runs of consecutive numbers proving that these Houston men were processed together. For example, P.O.W. #5335 to #5344 shows only one break, #5339--(is this your man)? The 10,000 series seem to be headed by Commander Epstein and has several long runs of (nearly) consecutive numbers, particularly from #10,136 through #10,166 and #10,280 through #10,300.

If your Houston man has a P.O.W. number like those above, I know a lot of men who were his fellow prisoners.

I understand that International Red Cross workers were recently allowed to visit the P.O.W. camp at Nike, Thailand. To my personal knowledge, 4 next of kin of Houston men have been advised that their loved one died in this prison camp-- in each instance the man was dead several months before the card he sent from Moulmein, Burma, reached the next of kin. I understand that quite a few other Houston next of kin have been notified of this Red Cross visit (about June, 1945); some alive and in good health, others died such and such a date--Nearly one dead for each two alive and in good health, according to reliable but unconfirmed reports.

It is my intention to try to supply these bereaved next of kin the names and home addresses of those who were in the same prisoner of war camp. Won't you help me by supplying (if you have not already done so) full name, rating, the P.O.W. camp and P.O.W. number of YOUR Houston man?
