Dear sir:

I am returning herewith American Central Insurance Company policy No. 9341 issued to the Houston Negro Hospital covering the hospital building in the sum of \$75,000.00 against loss or damage by fire, for the year beginning December 17th, 1933.

The policy is in standard approved form, but attention is directed to the fact that it contains a co-insurance clause requiring insurance to be maintained of at least 80% of the actual cash value of the property, and in default thereof the hospital will be a proportionate co-insurer to the extent of the deficiency of insurance under the 80% of the cash value.
