SAN FELIPE DE AUSTIN, 4<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1830

HAVING been received by **S. F. AUSTIN**, as one of the Settlers under his contracts with Government, in conformity with the terms published by him, 20th November 1829;—I promise to pay to said S. F. AUSTIN, or order, the sum of **FIFTY DOLLARS**, in two payments, that is to say: Ten Dollars on receipt of my title for land as a Settler, under said contracts, and Forty Dollars, one year after the date of said title: to bear interest at the customary rates of this Colony, from the time it becomes due until paid: which payment I promise to make without defalcation: and I hereby renounce all the benefits, exemptions, and privileges of the laws, which I might use to retard or evade the prompt payment of said sums; and I execute this note in this language, because I do not understand Spanish.
