There will be film clips from both these great films. Mrs. O'Brien will be there in person to accept the award.

Also since 1977 the Fritz Leiber Fantasy Award (established to honor living fantasy writers) has been presented at Fantasy Faire. This year we are honored to have Fritz Leiber himself award this testimony to one of the all-time favorite fantasy authors.

PROGRAMS


Programs include hours of science fiction & fantasy films, slide shows, talks, panels, filksinging, etc.
