I do hereby certify that S. H. Everett has faithfully discharged the duties of mail contractor on route No. 7 between Jefferson and San Augustine from the 25th day of November 1835 to the 25th day of March following, that his pay per annum was at the rate of four hundred dollars, and that for the services rendered he was entitled to receive from the Government of Texas the sum of one hundred & thirty three dollars thirty three cents, of which sum he has received ten dollars, leaving a balance due him by the Government aforesaid the sum of one hundred and twenty three dollars thirty three cents.
