Referring to yours of the twelfth, I am very glad the check for \$50.00 reached you in ample time to be included in report. In this connection, I believe we are really now over paid on dues \$10.00, according to a statement some few weeks back. However, we can later decide how this additional ten dollars may be applied to our credit.

Your closing paragraph of this letter of the twelfth is appreciated. Mrs. Cunningham is very busy in the field, on the financial part of our work, and this has not yet come to her. However, I can assure you that the \$175.00 still due on Mrs. McClung's tour in Texas will be paid just as soon as we can get the money. And this is just what Mrs. Cunningham is bending all her energies toward at the present time.

In regard to the Certificate of Membership, I attach a crude form, as my past experience, (before entering Suffrage work,) included nothing of this nature and I can find in the files no copy of the one sent last year, although I do find reference to its enclosure. Forgive my apparent stupidity. If this one will not suffice, will you kindly let me have a form which I will fill out and return at once; meanwhile you will have the requested information, at least. I have delayed this length of time hoping each day Mrs. Cunningham would come in to headquarters, as planned and desired by her, but the matter of finances being paramount over all else just at present, she has not been able to do this.
