PROCEEDINGS OF THE NINTH SESSION OF THE STUDENT SENATE

The eighth meeting of the ninth session of the Student Senate of the University of Houston Student Association was called to order at 7:30, p.m., in the World Affairs Room of the University Center by President COLLINS. The minutes were accepted as written.

The following Senators were absent: Senators SLOVACEK, CLAIBORN, KINGSBURY, DELMORE, WHITE, GARRETT, and STUART

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President COLLINS announced that the Senate Resolution urging a traffic light be installed on Calhoun had been presented to City Council. The Resolution on the Lettuce Boycott had been sent out to the various news media. He added that the UC Food Service is using Teamster's Lettuce. President COLLINS then announced that budget requests are now being taken and should be submitted to the President or Vice President. He then made the following appointments: Jack Henry and Madeline Selig to the UC Calendar Board, and C.J. Wheeler to Religion Policy Board.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Rules & Judiciary--announced the appointments of Malinda Wilson, Senator from Education; Nancy Lopez, Religion Center Policy Board; John Rice, Student Publication Committee; and Federick Cefalo, Landscape Committee were being reported out. The appointments of Wayne Babovick, Allen Fisher, and Charles Fisk were being held.

Fiscay & Governmental--announced that the appointments of Maria Jimenez and Jim Schmidt to the Student Services Fee Planning and Allocation Committee were being reported out.

Student Life--no meeting.

OLD BUSINESS

Senator HOWE moved that the Senate accept the appointment of Malinda Wilson as a Senator from Education. WILSON was present and spoke saying that she had nothing to do with Senator Shainock (who she is replacing). She said that there were many people in her College who knew nothing about the Senate and she wanted this to change. The motion passed 12-0.

Senator HOWE then moved to pass out of Old Business to President's Report. The motion carried, and Wilson was sworn in.

Back in Old Business.... Senator HOWE moved the Senate accepted the appointment of John Rice to the Student Publications Committee. Rice was not present, and the motion carried 13-0. Senator HOWE then moved the Senate approve the appointment of Nancy Lopez to the Religion Center Policy Board. LOPEZ said that she was a member of the Newman Club and knew a lot of people associated with the Center. She said that she did not really know much about the Board but would see if it existed and if in fact it did anything. The appointment passed 14-0.

Senator HOWE moved that the Senate accept the appointment of Federick Cefalo to the Landscape Committee. CEFALO said that he had been on the committee last year and that it never met and he did not know who the other members of the Committee were. He felt that he might be able to get things moving this year. His appointment passed 14-0.

Senator SELIG moved that the Senate approve the appointment of Jim Schmidt to the Student Services Fee Planning and Allocation Committee. Schmidt was not present, but Senator SELIG briefly summarized the Committee's interview with him. The motion passed 11-0.

Senator SELIG then moved the Senate accept the appointment of Maria Jimenez to the Student Services Fee Allocation and Planning Committee. The appointment passed 13-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Senator ROGERS introduced Senate Bill 18021, A SENATE BILL TO RE-ESTABLISH SUCCESSION. The bill was referred to Rules & Judiciary.

COMMENTS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Senator LOFTIN wanted to know what the difference was between the Landscape Committee and Facilities Planning Committee. President COLLINS said that he was trying to get a job descriptions of the various committees.

Senator DANBURG then brought up the discussion of refreshments. Senator SELIG requested Lipton's tea; Senator HOWE fruit juice; and Senator DANBURG celery and fruit. Senator GALBRAITH wanted organes and apples with a few cokes, and Senator IKRAMULLAH suggested a salad bowl, Vice President ROGERS requested Lone Star and with that the discussion dissolved.

Senator GALBRAITH moved the meeting adjourn, and the motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00, p.m.
