Dear Sir:

We are in receipt of your letter dated July 28th with enclosures. Please furnish us, in addition to the other releases, one from the Thomas Moulding Brick Company, and also the two year guarantee called for, to be signed by them and yourselves, on the composition floors. Also sign a guarantee, as called for, against cracking of the terazzo floors. Please note that when the gravel roads are put in shape, which has not been done yet, a three months maintenance bond is to be filed on same. We are, in the meanwhile, proceeding with the preparation of your certificate, and it will be ready for you when these documents are filed.

This will be your authority to proceed with repairing the damage done to the rear of the building by the oil company. Please see that the same red sand is used on the stucco as was used in the first place. Make a separate bill of this to the Fidelity Trust Company presented through this office.
