### TYPE II POLIO VACCINE TO BE GIVEN SUNDAY, DECEMBER 2

Mark your calendars...Sunday, December 2....from 12-noon until 6:00 p.m. at over 200 stations - mostly schools in the Houston area. This is the third phase in a program started this past summer to blot out polio in our community. Types I and III were offered earlier. The program is being sponsored by the Harris County Medical Society and the Houston Junior Chamber of Commerce, and is being recommended for both adults and children. If you can't get to one of the stations this Sunday, a make-up day is planned the following Sunday....And for a list of the stations nearest you, watch your Houston daily newspapers the next few days.

### SAFETY

A big welcome back to Louie who was "under the weather" a few days last week..... And now that he's all harnessed up and ready to go again, Louie is talking --- you guessed it --- SAFETY. Here are his reminders of the day: Fire hoses are for fighting fires, and should not be used for other purposes. By using the hose for utility purposes, we run the possibility of having defective hose when it is really needed.....Also, use extra care and caution in opening and closing fire hydrants. If a fire hydrant is closed too tightly, the rubber seats of the valves may be damaged. If you have any questions - call a Fire and Safety Inspector.... there's always one available....And one more point....If your fire extinguisher has been used and it needs to be recharged, call the Fire and Safety office immediately...Don't wait for the mail to deliver your request, 'cause you might need that extinguisher in the meantime.....
