My dear Governor:

Noting through the press your veto of S.B. 78 providing for construction of public utilities, including hospitals, I am taking the liberty of enclosing copy of a letter dated September 12th addressed to Hon. Oscar Holcombe, Mayor of Houston, and W. H. Ward, County Judge, copies of which were sent to the respective County and City Commissions and others as shown on the letter.

I am prompted to send you this communication on the assumption that in one way or another an attempt will be made later to secure the rights and privileges provided for in this bill, and thus saddle the community with continuing obligations for the maintenance of unnecessary facilities and hospital equipment to the detriment of existing institutions, a position which I believe will be safeguarded by such expert study as is proposed in the above letter.
