SGA Bill Amending the Bylaws so as to Specify the Concerns of each Standing Committee of the Senate

Whereas, The Student Government Association Code is ambiguous when outlining what realm of issues are designated to each Standing Committee.

Therefore, be it enacted by the Senate of the 45th Student Government Association of the University of Houston:

Section 1: that Title 2, Art. 7, Sec. 3, Clause 6 of the Bylaws of the Student Government Association is amended as follows:

Clause 6: ^{to} For each standing committee, the responsibilities shall include those ^{but not limited} matters listed below. The standing committees shall be as follows:

A. Committee on Academic Affairs

1. Faculty and course evaluation
2. Degree requirements and curriculum
3. Academic standards
4. Grading systems and methods of testing
5. Student advising and course selection
6. Academic support services
7. Academic honesty and honor codes
8. Libraries
9. Other academic policies and issues
10. Advice and consent on nominations to academic standing university committees, councils, and boards

B. Committee on Student Life

1. University Center
2. Residence Halls
3. Student publications
4. Student activities, including leadership development and advising
- ~~5. Student Program Board~~
6. Enrollment services

7. Student orientation
8. Student discipline
9. Other student services and student auxiliaries
10. Students' rights and civil liberties
11. Advice and consent on nominations to student affairs standing university committees, councils and boards

C. Committee on Administration and Finance
