Replying to your letter of October 31st, I beg to say, as stated over the telephone this morning, that the colored hospital for which I.M. Terrell is soliciting is a small institution used by the Negro doctors for their hospital patients. It is operated to very good standards, and Dr. Flickwir of the Health Department considers it a useful institution.

My opinion is that this hospital is too small for any very large contribution, unless its whole situation were fully considered. There is distinct need for its kind of institution in Houston.
