Simeon Edward S. Jones, as a foreign volunteer
by the acts of the Convention of Texas
is justly entitled to three hundred, and
twenty acres of land, to be located
within the public domain of the Republic
of Texas.

Done at Nacogdoches
on the 13th day of Sept. 1836.

Houston passed through Nacogdoches
on his return from New Orleans where
he had gone for treatment for wound at ST

Municipality of Mexiqueros

I know all men
by these presents

That I the within named Edward S. Jones have
this day sold unto Charles H. Sims of the town
of Mexiqueros all my right to the within named
three hundred and twenty acres of land and
I do hereby acknowledge to have received of
him one hundred dollars in full compensation
for the same and to enable him to procure title
for the same I have this day given him a Power
of Attorney to take procure title in my name and
to sell and convey the same to any person
he may choose.
