

The Killed at San Jacinto.

GALVESTON, August 6.—A sense of duty compels me to point out an error which your types make in the list of the killed at San Jacinto, as given in the letter of "A.; N.," of Austin, in your issue of this date.

The name of "J. C. Hale" is printed thus: "I. C. Hall." With this exception, I believe you have the list exactly correct.

Unless some evidence shall come to hand within one week, proving it not be the true and full one, which is most earnestly desired, the list of all those who fell at the battle of San Jacinto will be cut on the monument in the following alphabetical order, each name spelled as follows:

Benjamin Rice Brigham,
Lemuel S. Blakely,
Mathias Cooper,
Thomas P. Fowle,
J. C. Hale,
George A. Lamb,
Dr. William Motley,
A. R. Stevens,
Olwyn J. Trask.

These names will pass into future history as the "immortal nine."

Now, should the above list not be correct in every particular, this is intended and published as a notice to any and every one throughout the broad limits of the country, who may have any knowledge to the contrary, to speak out, and to produce their evidence within one week from now, or forever afterward to hold their peace. Now is the accepted time to correct the errors in the past histories of Texas.
