Dear Sir:

In accordance with your instructions, we have prepared an estimate of the cost of furnishing and installing screens in the arched openings of the porches on the north side of the above building.

We propose to build a tile and stucco wall 2'9" high, in the present arched openings and to fit frames and screens into the remaining space in these arches, and to furnish and erect four screen doors in the four arches at the east and west ends of both porches, all to be painted to match other woodwork, for the sum of \$845.00. We will give you a credit of \$30.00 for hanging the three extra screen doors, which were originally specified, and will turn over to the owner the seven doors which were made for the doors opening on the porches.
