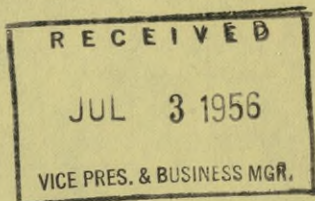

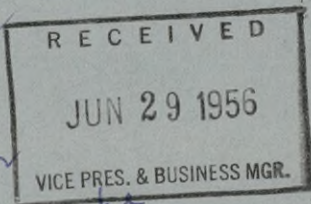

SUBJECT December 14 Debate with Oxford University

Dean Daniels referred the following to this office Wednesday when Dr. Clanton Williams was out of the city:

1. The University has scheduled on December 14 a debate with Oxford University, arranged several months ago through the cooperation of the Institute of International Education.
2. Professor Robert L. Scott (Speech) has just been informed that one of the members of the Oxford debating team is a Jamaican and a Negro. He requests instructions.
3. Dean Daniels points out that University athletic teams have on several occasions played against Negro opponents.
