of Elizabeth Stuart a minor under fourteen years of age

Now if the aforesaid Elizabeth W. Parrat shall well
and truly perform all the duties that are or may be required
of her as such Guardian and Tutor then the above obligation
to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and vir-
-tue this the day and date above written
