Destruction of American Form of Government Is The Aim of Both Major Political Parties

They Said It Couldn't Happen Here; It's Already Happened

The film showing the San Francisco riot in which Soviet agents marshaled scores of college students in that city and led them in a raid on an official hearing conducted by the House Un-American Activities Committee, is being shown in several cities of the United States.

It is the first opportunity the American people have had to see Communism in action here in their own country and those who haven't got the nerve to face up to the stark and frightening fact that the International Communist Conspiracy is firmly entrenched and is flourishing in the United States had better stay away when, and if, the film is brought to their community.

No one but a deep-dyed traitor to the American Republic could witness this film in all its shocking detail without shuddering in horror at the criminal dereliction of our national officials in permitting this deadly enemy of Christian civilization to plant its beachhead on American soil.

Young men and women with features distorted beyond all human resemblance and prodded by brutal, snarling communists including Harry Bridges, led the assault on the Congressional hearing. Bringing up the rear and whipping the evil passions of the howling mob into a frenzy were several disreputable and abandoned old females, a human derelict in the garb of a Protestant minister and assorted scum and dregs of humanity, one of them proudly bearing aloft a picture of their idol, Congressman James Roosevelt of the sovereign State of California, recognized as an outstanding defender of pro-Communist activity in the United States.

In attempts to put down the riot, eight San Francisco policemen were injured, two of them critically and a number of mobsters were hospitalized.

The Un-American Activities Committee of the House of Representatives was set up by the Congress of the United States and is specifically charged with the duty of investigating Communist activities and Soviet espionage in this country and is, therefore, operating under direct legislative authority of the American government. The assault on the Committee by the Communist mob was, accordingly, an attack on a unit of the American government.

Since this film has been released the question is being constantly propounded as to why the U.S. Attorney General's Department which has displayed marked concern in upholding "the law of the land" in certain areas of the country flagrantly abrogated its duty to uphold this particular "law of the land" so arrogantly defied by Soviet agents on the West Coast. So far as is known no Federal action has been taken, or is contemplated, in punishing members or leaders of the mob.

Could it be that this notorious flaw in the administration of justice was due to the fact that Mr. William P. Rogers' alert minions of the law were otherwise engaged and were, perhaps, snooping around in the Deep South trying to collect evidence that some Negro's Civil Rights were being violated?

The internal security of the United States and the survival of the American Republic would seem to be heavily involved in the answer to this vital question.

As it inevitably comes at sometime in the history of a great country, the time has arrived when sovereign citizens must make defiance of tyranny and the preservation of basic governing instruments the first consideration of their existence or meekly stand aside as their beloved Republic is quietly buried in the cemetery of dead nations.

No American with an iota of patriotic devotion to his country, or concern in the preservation of its institutions, could fail to recognize in the recent Democratic and Republican Conventions a bitter contest between the two parties to determine which could more effectively and completely destroy the American governing system. It turned out that the contest between them was a tie and both at Los Angeles and at Chicago it was Old Home Week for the enemies of Constitutional Government. The platforms of both parties add up to an insult and a threat to freedom-loving citizens and no reputable American seriously interested in the survival of the Republic would run for President on either one. When it is considered that millions of unthinking voters will approve and be influenced by these dual assaults on the Constitution, and in view of the further fact that it required less than thirty thousand like-minded revolutionaries to overthrow the Russian government in 1917, we have a pretty grim picture of the future of a nation which was once "the land of the free and the home of the brave."

For more than a quarter of a century the United States, as the only Constitutional Republic left on earth, has been the target of a vicious and relentless World Conspiracy whose objective is to abolish this one remaining stronghold of freedom and add it to the motley collection of Socialist States which represent the only type of government now operating anywhere else on the globe.

The American people have watched with varying reactions, ranging from indifference to heartbreak, as our public servants in Washington who swore on the Bible to uphold the Constitution, have aided and abetted this World Conspiracy by gradually abandoning tested, proved and established American policies of government in favor of vague, hazy and impractical theories spun in the warped and perverted brains of world social planners.

But as the recent Democratic and Republican Conventions fade into history, the indifference of apathetic Americans has been shattered and the heartbreak of patriotic citizens heightened by the realization that the subversive political action of the two parties in officially giving their stamp of approval to Collectivism, means victory for the World Conspiracy through final abandonment of Constitutional Government in the United States by both Democrats and Republicans and the open acceptance of a Socialist Welfare State in its place.

It is true that this subversive political action taken at Los Angeles and at Chicago did not represent the sentiment of the great mass of American citizenship since ninety per cent of the delegations in both cases were composed of low-grade, self-serving local politicians and the solid, substantial and thinking element of the Republic had little voice in the proceedings.

But that is the only system we have for selecting candidates for President of the United States and so the cold-blooded fact is that the voters must peacefully revolt and find some other method of independently selecting an American patriot as Chief Executive in this dark and dangerous period of the nation's history or go ahead and cowardly resign themselves once again to deciding who is the least of two evils — a man proclaiming himself a Democrat or one designated as a Republican and both openly and avowedly committed to Marxism as the accepted policy of the government over which they hope to preside.

THE OLD GAG ABOUT "LEAST OF TWO EVILS" HAS BEEN WORN THREADBARE

Before the election in 1956, after Eisenhower had betrayed Conservatives by turning Socialist during his first term, a flock of propaganda flooded the country in order to gain Conservative support for the second time. And it worked to the extent that he was re-elected.

The propaganda in the late summer of 1956 went about like this: "There is nothing else for us to do except support Eisenhower. We can't vote for Stevenson so we've got to vote Republican because Eisenhower is the least of two evils."

That same propaganda is now being broadcast throughout the land. We've already been approached a dozen times with this malarkey: "We can't vote for Kennedy so we've got to vote Republican because Nixon is the least of two evils."

Well, maybe so, but we're fed up to here with voting for the least of two evils and we are simply not having any. In our opinion, there are no shades or degrees of evil. If something is evil it is evil period and if there is anything more evil than the platform which Nixon railroaded through at Chicago, we can't think what it is.

We know many Conservative Democrats who are going to vote for Nixon on the theory that he is the least of two evils and that's just dandy with us. That's their privilege and one of the few rights which have not yet been taken away from American citizens is that they may still vote for whomsoever they please.

We are going to wait and see what alternative, if any, is offered to two "evils" and if there is none, one can always write in the name of a good American.

To those who hold that this is losing our vote, we counter with the suggestion that it is also losing our vote when we vote for either of two International Socialists and opponents of Constitutional Government.

If standing for principle means losing, then we are perfectly willing to be rated as a "loser."

ANNIVERSARY OF FIRST MAJOR SOCIALIST LEGISLATION CELEBRATED AT HYDE PARK

Ceremonies were held at Hyde Park on Sunday, August 14 to commemorate the official beginning of National Socialism as a policy of the American government.

The occasion marked the 25th anniversary of the passage of the Social Security Act by the Congress of the United States and the adoption of the un-American philosophy that the Federal government owes the citizens a living.

Twenty-five hundred pro-Marxists attended the Hyde Park celebration including Presidential candidate John Kennedy who made a strong pitch from the rostrum for more "cradle to the grave" legislation, specifically in the form of free medical care for the aged along the line of Socialist England's laws on the subject.

No mention was made by any of the speakers of Franklin D. Roosevelt's solemn promise to the Governors of the various states 25 years ago, previous to the passage of the Social Security Act, when he gave the Chief Executives his word of honor that this was mere-

ly "emergency legislation" and that it would be repealed immediately when the "emergency" was over.

His word didn't turn out to be worth the breath he spent in giving it because from that day forward the Social Security Act was accepted as a permanent policy of government and it inspired other Marxist legislation with which the Federal statute book is heavily cluttered.

We happened to be in the Governor's private office at Austin on that day when Roosevelt phoned in to give his phony promise and when the assurance was later repeated to us, we gave a gentle horse laugh because, stupid though we may be, we know enough to realize that no people can be pried out of the public trough after they have once started feeding on government slop.

If there is such a thing as a completely honest politician, Ezra Benson is that. And so the Nixon advisers are telling him to "ditch Benson".

There were thousands of words uttered at Los Angeles and at Chicago and additional thousands written in their respective platforms but not one voice was raised by a leading candidate at either Convention to suggest a return to those basic principles so faithfully adhered to by American statesmen for more than a hundred and fifty years.

And it was the application of these principles, too, which resulted in building up a national economy of such strength and magnitude that we currently are enabled to finance the rotten Socialist governments throughout the world whose degenerate, debased and subversive systems the two successful candidates for President are now demanding that we substitute for our own.

Outside of a few brief references to National Defense, Taxation and Foreign Policy, not a subject was incorporated into the Democratic or Republican platforms which has any proper place in matters legitimately listed on the agenda of American political parties for discussion or whose solution the American government is Constitutionally authorized to consider.

They both dealt with subjects which either fall within the strict jurisdiction of the Sovereign States or else belong in the category of the individual citizen's private business.

No candidate of any political party who is not thoroughly steeped in Marxist philosophy would project such things as farm price supports, crop control, illegal sit-in demonstrations, medical care for the aged, urban renewal, minimum wages, public housing, slum clearance, Federal aid to education, employment practices, right to work, civil rights or other non-government issues as proper subjects for legislative action or as problems whose solution should be saddled on to the sore backs of the tax-ridden people of the United States.

The platform writers who spent the major portion of their time, thought and attention on these irrelevant subjects in a supreme attempt to corral the votes of partisan blocs and minority groups, and the candidates who emphasize them during the campaign, know in their hearts that these planks were taken almost in their entirety out of the platforms of Norman Thomas and Earl Browder when the latter were candidates for President of the United States on the Socialist and Communist tickets, respectively.

At any rate, we have come to the point where both major political parties have abandoned Constitutional Government and both candidates for President are openly committed to Marxism as a form of government and a way of life.

There is no sense in saying that nothing can be done because the American people are Sovereign and, united, they can do anything they want to do. The time is short before the election but in the meantime miracles could be wrought if the public temper is at white heat which it should be, and which it is reported to be. Any of several courses could be followed:

There could be a quick nation-wide campaign to blitz the people into action and which would call for the write-in of the name of an American patriot dedicated to American principles of government to replace the two major candidates who have repudiated these principles.

Another plan would be for good Americans to stay away from the polls and let either one of the two candidates be elected — it does not

make any difference which one as their political philosophy is identical — and concentrate on the election of candidates for Congress which, after all, holds the balance of power.

All members of the House will be up for re-election and where there is no opposition, a name could be written in in the case of those who have betrayed their constituents.

By thinning out the ranks of political thieves and looters in even one branch of Congress, (which would have its shock value and frighten those who are re-elected,) the evil influence of a Socialist administration could be halted, or greatly curtailed, for four years when, let us hope, the American people will have come to their senses.

The South could of course, be of fabulous help in rescuing the Republic from the threat of total Socialism by uniting for uninstructed electors but that section is in the tight vise of powerful politicians who had rather see the country given back to the Indians than take a chance on losing their committee chairmanships in Congress.

A few Southern States may be depended on to take action but, by and large, the leaders will herd the people like sheep into the Democratic fold with the possible exception of several which may go Republican but that, of course, is no solution.

The only other alternative is just to sit back, accept the inevitable, watch the American Republic follow the example of all other nations who have gradually sunk into the morass of human slavery and subscribe to the theory that freedom is a lost cause.

But if this happens, let us not place the blame on power-mad and unscrupulous politicians but on ourselves in whom was vested the responsibility of preserving the Republic which early American patriots so carefully constructed and entrusted to our keeping.

In this connection, we call attention to a drop-head over our lead editorial in the October, 1956, edition of the Southern Conservative titled "American People Are Paying the Penalty For Surrendering Their Inherent Rights" and which, in view of the threatened collapse and disruption of the American governing system seems tragically prophetic at this time:

It is the inexorable law of nature that individuals must pay in full measure for their sins, errors of judgment, and wilful transgression of the restraints which society has prescribed for the social behavior of man. By the same token, it is the inflexible rule of an orderly governing system that the people of a nation must suffer penalty when they evade their responsibility as citizens, grow remiss in their duty as sovereigns and fail to exercise watchful stewardship over those elected to represent them. For almost a quarter century, the people of the United States have stepped aside and permitted national leaders to overturn age-old precedents and honored traditions; repudiate sacred covenants between the government and its people; and to violate the organic law on which such government rests. The debt-burdened, tax-ridden and unstable State of the Union in our time stems from our apathetic indifference concerning the preservation of our country and its institutions while showing anxious concern in setting up a New World Order; our renunciation of national patriotism in favor of Global Allegiance; and our willingness to give up our safe, solid and secure status as Sovereign Citizens of a Constitutional Republic in return for Squatter's Rights in an International Utopian Paradise.

SOME OBSERVATIONS ON A FORM OF HUMAN MADNESS BETTER KNOWN AS DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN PARTY CONVENTIONS

In moments of stress, all delegates to national political conventions are afflicted with a mild form of mass insanity. Instead of careful deliberation and calm behavior, a spirit of mob hysteria governs the proceedings and men and women mill aimlessly around like cattle before a thunderstorm. Treading endlessly up and down the aisles, they don't know where they're going nor why; neither do they know what they are going to do or say when they get there. They are only sure of one thing and that is that they must maintain perpetual motion. It is in such an atmosphere that a President of the American Republic is chosen which might possibly account for the confused and addled-brained type of leadership so often thrust upon us. Surely there must be a better way to get the job done.

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Keynote speeches are usually composed equally of bull, buncombe and baloney and this year was no exception. Walter Judd made a brilliant talk at Chicago except that none of it was true. Obviously he was laying down sound Republican principles which once prevailed, but which Eisenhower has smashed into smithereens. Frank Church at Los Angeles said nothing that Karl Marx hasn't said a hundred times before; and a hundred years earlier.

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The solid, substantial citizenship of the United States had no representation whatever either at the Democratic Convention in Los Angeles or the Republican Convention in Chicago. Both were assemblies composed mainly of scrub politicians of the local level totally submissive to their Washington masters who are betraying the American people every hour on the hour. Some few Southerners made token gestures of protest at the degenerate and debasing platforms of both Conventions but, with a few exceptions, in the end capitulated, tucked their tails and knuckled under to the subversive elements in control when the whip was cracked. Both Nixon's and Kennedy's nominations were accomplished by default on the part of responsible American taxpayers.

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Many considerations are known to have influenced the selection of candidates in both cases. Lodge and Kennedy were intended to lend an aura of glamor to their respective tickets because of their social positions and because they are from the right side of the railroad tracks. Nixon and Johnson, on the other hand, provide the earthy, horny-handed and self-made element, both of them having fought, hammered and clawed their way to the top. No attempt was made to toss in an American patriot or two to balance off the Welfare Staters and give Constitutional Government a fifty-fifty chance. That consideration didn't enter the picture at any point.

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Most politicians usually wait until they are safely in office to

double-cross and betray the people who elected them but Richard Nixon is an exception. Being a progressive and up-and-coming young man, he didn't wait until he was elected, or even nominated, but jumped the gun and sold out to Rockefeller before his selection as the Republican candidate was cinched. If there ever was a case of double-dyed treachery to Conservatives, that was it.

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It is rumored that in the event Kennedy should win the election, he will name Adlai Stevenson as Secretary of State. It is our private opinion, publicly expressed, that if this tragic prediction should be realized, it would be the equivalent of a gilt-edged invitation to Khrushchev to come over here and help himself.

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An amusing feature of the Los Angeles Convention was provided in the "gallery delegates" who voted right along with those legally elected to perform this function when a voice vote was substituted for a roll call. Paul Ziffren, Democratic big shot in Los Angeles whom the leaders of the party will probably play down during the campaign because of recent publicity about his "connections," is said to have combed the underworld in his search for material for the "cheer section" of the auditorium.

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In our opinion this country lost a potentially valuable public servant on that day when Jack Kennedy decided, or was persuaded, that it was politically wise to throw in his lot with the enemies of Constitutional American Government. With his looks, his personality and his family background of culture, education and wealth there are no heights to which he might not have gone if he had only been a sound, right-thinking American instead of a dedicated disciple of Karl Marx.

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Not a chirp was heard from Texans at the Los Angeles Convention all of whom remained tongue-tied when the contemptible Civil Rights plank was being railroaded through even though the people of Texas had voted almost four to one in a State election against the things which this plank demanded.

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Roosevelts were present at both conventions. John, often referred to as the "respectable" member of the family probably because he has kept out of the headlines, seconded the nomination of Nixon at Chicago; Eleanor and James held forth at Los Angeles while Elliott was said to be lurking in the background there. Incidentally, it is the first time in her experience that the "First Lady of the World" ever left a National Democratic Convention with her tail feathers dragging the ground. Still "madly for Adlai" until the bitter end, she flounced out of Los Angeles when Kennedy whom she despises was picked as the standard bearer and firmly re-

fused to stay and take part in the final whoopee.

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Not only did Lyndon Johnson never have a ghost of a chance to be placed at the head of the ticket, but he was not even nominated officially for second place. Those who were maneuvering to bring this about didn't dare put it to a vote by States because they knew he would be defeated even for the job on the tail end of the ticket, so they decided to handle it by "acclamation." The "noes" were so much stronger than the "ayes," even with Ziffren's gallery delegates joining in, that there was a gasp when the "impartial" chairman, LeRoy Collins, gavelled Johnson into the job. This overwhelming opposition to Johnson must have been disconcerting to Kennedy but Johnson took it in stride. After all, he is not exactly inexperienced at achieving office through devious methods.

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Mr. Sam Rayburn, venerable career politician who has spent practically all his adult life on either a State or Federal payroll was also a casualty of the Los Angeles Convention along with Eleanor Roosevelt, Harry Truman and other senior citizens of the party. The wet-behind-the-ears Welfare Staters who are now second in command to Negroes in directing Democratic Party affairs gave him a great big hand to show their affection but they also gave him the boot when they got ready to name their candidate.

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We've got to give Kennedy credit for one thing if for nothing else. At least so far, he has not compelled his wife to hobnob socially with Negro washerwomen to influence the colored vote.

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The biggest hoax of either convention was the illusion that Nelson Rockefeller was a powerful factor to be reckoned with when as a matter of fact, he is only a political gadfly with nuisance value. Until Nixon struck out in the middle of the night to trade and traffic with him and to barter principle for the billionaire Socialist's nonexistent influence, nobody paid any attention to him. At the convention he was a regular One-Eyed Connally gate-crashing his way into every conference and gathering and he never missed a bet at poking his pan into every available television camera.

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The ubiquitous Perle Mesta who is convinced that there is no domestic or foreign problem which can't be quickly solved over a plate of hors d'oeuvres or a tray of cocktails was at Los Angeles and threw her inevitable party which was so exclusive that nobody but the general public attended. She had impartially announced that she would do likewise at the Chicago convention but somebody must have talked her out of it. The Republicans already had troubles enough. What with smouldering Conservative sentiment threatening to break out

at any moment and mess up Nixon's liberal platform, the situation was ridiculous enough without the "hostess with the mostest" adding to the general comedy. Someday it is to be hoped that this well-meaning and harmless lady may find a better way to spend her millions than in trying to stoke up freeloaders at parties and political conventions.

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It is widely believed, from the demonstration for Barry Goldwater at Chicago, that if the delegates had not been hog-tied before they left home, the Arizona senator would have been the nominee of the Republican Party. His refusal, however, to lend any encouragement to the strong nationwide movement in his behalf has caused mixed reactions among Conservatives. Many believe he played it smart and that he has some well-laid plans to develop a strong movement within the party for uniting Conservative forces. But what is perhaps a majority of his erstwhile followers, feel that he betrayed them in choking off the demonstration and asking them to support Nixon. Perhaps this viewpoint was best expressed by a prominent person whose activity, both financial and otherwise, contributed largely to the vast demonstration of Goldwater sympathy at Chicago, and who later said to us in a personal letter: "In all reverence, I can understand how Jesus our Lord must have felt when one of His own group betrayed Him. That is what I consider Barry Goldwater did to his Conservative supporters. He accepted their acclaim and adulation and then withdrew his name without allowing a vote to be taken which would have shown his supporters how much or how little they had accomplished. To add to this ignominy, he then begged them to throw their support to Nixon. He could not have offered us a greater insult."

But, regardless of what Senator Goldwater did or did not do or say at Chicago, and regardless of any one's personal views of the course he chose to pursue, the indisputable fact remains that if, during the past eight years, we had had a couple of dozen leaders in the Senate of the Arizona lawmaker's stature and with his voting record, Socialism would not today be the dominating policy of the American government. All honest citizens must concur in that inescapable conclusion.

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Not only did both political parties at their respective conventions make a deadly assault on the Constitution through the adoption of Socialist policies of government, but they openly went on record as favoring mob violence and civil disobedience to law and order through the adoption of planks bidding for the support of defiant, unruly and irresponsible young ruffians.

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Both platforms were constructed on the thesis that the changing world in which we live calls for a

Once Marines Could Have Handled Castro In 24 Hours

When the American State Department was wining and dining bully boy Castro, we said editorially that Cuba had gone Communist, and deplored the recognition by Washington of the new regime.

Now the State Department has come out officially with the announcement that the "Cuban government is now in open league with the Soviet Union and Communist China." We thank Mr. Herter for making our editorial charge valid but he is not telling us anything we didn't know and say months ago.

The State Department's pronouncement on Castro's affiliation with Moscow and Peiping came following the seizure of \$270,000,000.00 worth of United States property by puppet Castro in Havana.

Twenty-five or thirty years ago, or before the shrinking of the American government into a cringing, sniveling Welfare State, we would have sent a company of Marines to Cuba to take care of the Cuban beatnik and the matter would have been settled in twenty-four hours.

Now Washington leaders hesitate, counsel and confer and are eagerly seeking for some organization, group or power who can take the job off our hands and cut this dirty little Latin-American tramp down to size.

Any American who is able financially to send his children to a private school and yet allows them to go to a public integrated school for political reasons is the lowest possible specimen of humanity.

SOME "EXALTED OBJECTIVES" TO WHICH FOREIGN AID PROGRAM IS DEDICATED

A Commission of Inquiry which was created in July by the Belgian government and which is composed of high judges of the Belgian Courts has issued a preliminary report on the horrible atrocities by Congolese troops in Leopoldville and surrounding areas which details in terrifying clarity the brutal attacks on white residents there.

The Commission which reported only on cases that could be documented told of the raping of hundreds of women including Protestant missionaries and Catholic nuns, many of whom were assaulted over and over again. The Commission pointed out that 291 Belgian women gave their testimony in hearings conducted by the group.

Following the release of this report the American State Department came into the picture and persons with weak stomachs will probably find it hard to accept without nausea the reaction of that agency to the beastly situation.

Representatives of the Department appeared before the Congress of the United States and asked for an extra appropriation of \$100,000,000 to send to that same African government "and possibly other new African States."

The American people have frequently been given glimpses into the horrifying corruption which attends the administration of the Foreign Aid Program, including the diversion of millions of dollars into channels not even remotely related to the announced purpose of "containing Communism" but this latest implication that these funds are practically to be used in subsidizing black African rapists in their expeditions of carnage, lust and murder just about wraps it up.

Until now, perhaps the nearest approach to this latest perversion of the Foreign Aid Program occurred in 1955 when it was revealed that the recipient government of Vietnam was using their "Aid" money in encouraging the advancement of the world's oldest profession.

In the May, 1955, edition of the Southern Conservative, we said in part:

We have seen the recipients of this money (Foreign Aid) put it to practically every conceivable use under the sun from building atomic weapons which may someday be turned against us to setting up tap-dancing classes for retired Himalayan camel drivers but we believe the South Vietnam government has converted a share of its Foreign Aid into a channel which even the weasel-brained reformers and do-gooders who initiated the program had not anticipated.

We learn from the New York Times that authorities of Vietnam's government may have utilized part of its Foreign Aid money and the prefabricated houses we sent them to reorganize, rehabilitate and modernize their local prostitution industry and put it on an up-to-date and paying basis. "The rumor persists that part of Saigon's massive bordello was constructed with American aid dollars and prefabricated housing," writes C. L. Sulzberger in the Times.

We bow gracefully to the superior wisdom of those who shape our foreign policy and whose irrevocable decisions commit us to the responsibility of advancing the economic, social and cultural progress of under-privileged countries of the world but we timidly rise from the rear and respectfully protest that the appropriation of American tax money to subsidize a South Pacific assignment house is hardly a proper method of achieving this worthy end.

If the sponsors of the foreign aid program will have their research department give close study to the subject, we believe they will decide that this particular grant was unnecessary since the industry they may be propping up in Vietnam is an especially hardy perennial among human enterprises and one which will unquestionably survive and flourish without benefit of government support.

We are also convinced that they will find that this was a thriving business in the island long before the Marshall Plan was put into effect and before prefabricated houses were invented and when those engaged in it had to carry on their transactions in tumble-down shacks and dilapidated bamboo huts and, in a pinch, under the protecting branches of a spreading banyan tree.

The use to which Foreign Aid has been put in these instances, however, is no more immoral than the program itself which is based on robbery and extortion of the American people for the benefit of corrupt and depraved officials of alien governments.

Those of our public servants who vote for the Foreign Aid program and appropriate money to carry it out are not only guilty of aborting the intents of the American Constitution but of criminal extortion and illegal confiscation of the money of the constituents who elect them.

Chester Bowles, darling of the ADA, UNESCO and practically all other groups in the category of left-wing and anti-American activities, has announced that he will not run for re-election as Congressman from Connecticut in order to give his full time to the election of the Kennedy-Johnson Socialist ticket. The real reason he is not going to run, according to informed sources, is because he knew he would get clobbered at the Connecticut polls.

Because of his recent birthday, newspapers are featuring the fact that Mr. Bernard Baruch "has been adviser to Presidents since Woodrow Wilson" as if that were something to be proud of. According to press reports, old Joe Kennedy has been sent to Europe to remain during the Presidential campaign because his son does not want to be "embarrassed" by echoes of the Conservative political views of his father.

Now isn't that just too bad? If that young sprout isn't embarrassed by his own subversive political views, he has hide like a rhinoceros and is past all possibility of embarrassment.

AS OUR GREAT PRESIDENT ONCE SAID, "IT WAS PLANNED THAT WAY"

The great majority of the American people must have wondered why so much stress was placed on Civil Rights at the two recent political conventions and why this subject was the recipient of so much attention both at Los Angeles and at Chicago while vital matters affecting the security and survival of the Republic were slighted or given scant consideration.

Perhaps those who labored with these Civil Rights planks did not themselves know the answer but only realized that vast pressure was behind the demand for them, and felt that the success of their respective parties depended largely on how they treated that portion of their platforms.

There are perhaps a hundred pronouncements on the subject which could be quoted to show where this pressure is coming from and who originated the demand for all the racial agitation and strife which has divided the people of the United States in recent years, and caused politicians to bend over backwards in catering to organized integration groups.

However, only one quotation will suffice. That is a statement by William Z. Foster, long time head of the American Communist Party who outlined the action his party was taking in the matter and which appears on page 93 of the Public Hearings of the State of Louisiana Joint Legislative Committee in Baton Rouge, March 6-9, 1957.

Mr. Foster's statement was taken from documents written by him and which were put out by International Publishers, and his reference to

Southern Negroes said:

"The Communist Party, alone of all political parties, fights for liberation of the Negro, both in the present day struggle and as an ultimate goal. The American Soviet Government, immediately after it takes form, will be a shattering blow to the whole monstrous Jim Crowism. To destroy it ruthlessly will be one of the real joys of the victorious proletarian revolution. Every remnant of slavery will be abolished. In a Soviet system, the Negro will have the most complete equality, economically, politically, socially. The doors to every occupation, to every social activity will be wide open to him. He will have ample land confiscated from the great white landlords. He will be free to do and go as any other citizen, without lack or hindrance. Attempts to maintain the capitalist white favoritism and ostracism of the Negroes will be punished as a serious crime against society. . . . Accordingly the right of self-determination will apply to Negroes in the American Soviet System. In the so-called 'black belt' of the South where the Negroes are in the majority, they will have the fullest right to govern themselves and also to govern such white minority as may live in this section. . . ."

The Communist Party in America no longer puts out candidates to push this program. They long ago decided it was no longer necessary. The Democrats and Republicans are doing it for them.

Threat of Black Dominion Now Looms Large Over the World

One of the real but unannounced objectives of the Bandung, Indonesia, Conference in April, 1955, which was to initiate plans for the domination of the world by the colored races, is now being realized in Africa where black men out of the jungle are engaged in an orgy of savage crimes against white people which defies human imagination.

Visitors to this country from that area of the world tell of atrocities committed by black savages who have recently received "independence" and whose conception of freedom means the right to indulge in an orgy of arson, rape and murder which is without parallel in human history.

It all started with white fools and do-gooders who, under Communist inspiration, plugged for the abolishment of "Colonization" and for brutal savages to be given the right to govern themselves, which they are no more capable of doing than they are of making a flight to the moon. As long as the Belgians had control in the Congo, law and order was maintained and the world heard nothing of diabolic crimes on the part of uncivilized natives which now occur around the clock.

Negro psychology is the same all over the world. To them liberty means license and brute force is the only law they understand. The world is learning this fundamental fact now that it is too late and the terrifying situation in Africa is brewing trouble that could mean World War III.

Negroes now dominate the White House, the Supreme Court and the Congress and not one of the three branches of government would dare to take official action not approved by the NAACP.

Negroes dominate both the Democratic and Republican Parties and dictated major planks in both platforms at recent national conventions.

Negroes also control the election machinery of the Sovereign States through provisions in Civil Rights legislation and no American white citizen can any longer vote his conviction at the ballot box and have it stand up against an adverse ruling of a Negro-conscious Federal judge.

How normal, decent and self-respecting white persons can aid and abet a movement designed to project a people not long out of Cannibalism to a position of dominance over the white races of the earth is beyond human understanding and can only be ascribed to the global lunacy now permeating all sections of the world.

Dash gained prominence by appearing in a Broadway production written by Langston Hughes, notorious Negro atheist and Communist partisan whose blasphemous writings against the Christian religion were widely publicized by the American Communist Party some years ago.

Don't tell us television programs don't have their educational value to the young generation. A fourteen-year-old Houston lad invented a gun in which he used unchewed bubble-gum for bullets. He tried out the contraption by shooting a companion in the stomach. The victim was rushed to the hospital where the flow of blood was staunched and the wound treated.

NLRB Strikes Blow Against American Free Enterprise

In keeping with a policy of favoritism to labor unions and antagonism for industry and the American free enterprise system, the National Labor Relations Board hit out at the strike-ridden Kohler Company in Wisconsin recently and made a ruling that would not have been tolerated when this country was a Free Republic.

Under this ruling the Kohler Company was "ordered" to rehire approximately 1,700 workers who were fired by the company six years ago during a strike called by Reuther's United Auto Workers and which is still in effect.

The Kohler Company, according to the press, plans to appeal the order through a court suit in Chicago.

We presume that the "order" of the NLRB means that the Kohler Company will be made to pay salaries of men who wilfully quit their jobs and who have been harassing the company and engaging in acts of violence during the six years they were not working.

One by one the blows are raining down on Constitutional Government and on the freedom which the American people once enjoyed, and the people are doing little, if anything, about it.

Since we insist on having "cultural relations" with the Soviet, we favor sending pianist Van Cliburn to Moscow as a gift to the Russian people to keep permanently.

SOME UNHAPPY BUT UNDENIABLE FACTS ABOUT WHAT IS HAPPENING TO US

It may be inconceivable and incredible to the average American but they had just as well face up to the fact that in the Congress there are traitors to this country who are lying in wait for a chance to betray us into slavery by surrendering American sovereignty to the World Court.

Maybe these enemies of America have been brainwashed to the point where they do not realize the enormity of their acts and have actually been led to believe that this course is desirable but any way, there it is.

Early in 1960 they had their plans all set to pass a bill through the Senate which would repeal the Connally Amendment to the legislation which accepted jurisdiction of the World Court in the settlement of world problems. The Connally Amendment which was inserted over the vigorous protest of these anti-American politicians in 1946 provided that in accepting jurisdiction of the World Court, it would be left to the United States to determine what were domestic problems and, therefore, not subject to jurisdiction by the Court.

The proposed measure which they had all set to slip by the Senate early this year would have repealed the Connally amendment and left it to the World Court to say which were and which were not domestic problems.

Patriotic publications and groups got to work and informed as many people as possible of the legislation and what it would do in enslaving the American Republic and make the security of the United States amenable to the will of the World Court composed of aliens, including Communists.

Houston Citizens Are Victims of Frame-Up

The people of Houston were recently the victims of a frame-up on the part of chain stores operating in the former city, most of which are New York-owned.

In collaboration with Houston newspapers, television and radio channels who are the beneficiaries of the extensive advertising which these "foreign-owned" establishments control, a conspiracy of silence in regard to a very nauseous phase of integration was accomplished "without incident" as liberal newsmen are so fond of saying.

Eight of these local chain store managers plotted with the above-mentioned news mediums and got them to agree not to mention the fact that many lunch counters in Houston were to be opened to Negroes. The silence was maintained until the action had already been taken, and this policy put into effect.

There is nothing new about this procedure. It is established Communist policy and in its literature, the Party advises that secrecy be maintained about such a proposed venture until it is accomplished and those experienced in Soviet propaganda claim that it works ninety nine per cent of the time.

If there are enough decent people in Houston, their foreign-owned

One would think, off-hand, that Houston newspapers at least, would have felt enough gratitude to responsible citizens there who have sustained them throughout the years, to acquaint them with such proposed radical change in local customs, to say nothing of the violation of journalistic ethics which calls for the publishing of important news for the benefit of the reading public.

Suppression of the news is something usually associated with Russia and other countries behind the Iron Curtain and not with the United States where freedom of the press has usually been taken for granted.

Louisiana Governor Seeks End Of Despotic Federal Control

President Is Unfortunate In His Choice of Words

During the Republican Convention at Chicago, the President was quoted by the Associated Press as having said in an interview to newsmen that he would advise all Republican candidates, during the coming campaign, to "follow the great middle road and ignore the gutter, left or right."

We believe the President is just a little bit late with this advice for it is the opinion of a surprising number of thinking Americans that those politicians who, in the past seven or eight years have so squandered the national resources and run up almost \$300,000,000,000.00 in indebtedness for unborn generations to pay, were operating in subterranean channels of such depth that it would require a tall stepladder for them to even climb up to the "gutter."

And there are those who consider that "gutter" ethics alone dictated the invitation to the Communist butcher Khrushchev to come to the United States and be royally entertained in establishments whose doors, only a few short years ago, were closed to true-blue American patriots who vainly tried to warn Washington politicians of Khrushchev's burial plans for the American people.

And even "gutter politics" is inadequate to explain the repeated robbery of the taxpayers in the name of Foreign Aid to alien countries including Communist satellites; for the constant abrogation of the rights and freedoms of the American people, the abolishment of States Rights and the restriction of the God-given liberty of the citizens up to the point where a bayonet could be rammed in their backs for exercising the sovereignty granted them in the Constitution.

In fact, speaking of "gutters," there is strong crystallized sentiment in this country to the effect that the "gutter" has been the ceiling in much of the executive, judicial and legislative performance of recent years.

Southern newspapers are emphasizing the waning popularity of Senator Lyndon Johnson which they claim is falling like a barometer before a storm. Perhaps his record of playing both ends against the middle and two-timing both sides is just catching up with him.

More and more the charges are being made that "best seller" books, stage shows and motion pictures are sinking farther down into the mire of obscenity, filth and slime and that is true. But there is one thing certain — if people did not read these obscene books or attend the filthy and slimy stage shows and motion pictures, they would soon dry up. Which is further evidence that the responsibility for all forms of corruption is the fault of the citizenship. There is not much wrong with this great country, as a matter of fact, that the people themselves could not take care of if they really wanted to.

The action of Governor Jimmie H. Davis of Louisiana in interposing the prior authority of that State in public school matters over that of the Federal government will be hailed by every right-thinking American as a step that is over-due in halting the increasing encroachment of Washington on the Rights of the States.

In August, the Louisiana governor took over the administration of the public schools of New Orleans under a Louisiana law which permits him to supersede parish school boards to prevent racial integration of their educational system.

Louisiana law further empowers the governor to close all public schools of that State in the event even one is integrated.

Hanging like a black cloud over the situation, of course, is a Federal judge imbued with the grandiose idea of an all-powerful centralized government in Washington whose dictatorial and un-Constitutional edicts he will move heaven and earth trying to carry out.

The courageous and statesmanly action of Governor Davis should be supplemented and strengthened by that of every other Southern governor to the end that the despotic rule of Federal bigots over matters which belong strictly to the States may forever be put down.

Editor's note: As we go to press, a three judge Federal court has "ordered" that Governor Davis return the schools to the local school board and that the school board open New Orleans schools on an integrated basis. Governor Davis' next action has not yet been decided but on the outcome largely depends whether Southern States are actually Sovereign or whether they are dependencies of a powerful centralized government, or dictatorship, in Washington.

A book, "Workshop for College Psychology" by Mount, Helmick, Bugenthal and Maltzman, was the source of a questionnaire used in the Ganesha High School in Pomona, California, recently which shocked and infuriated parents of students in that area. Such questions were asked as: "How much money would you want to spit on a crucifix; eat a pound of human flesh; drink enough to become thoroughly intoxicated; choke a stray cat to death; slit a pig's throat?" A teacher decided on his own responsibility to use the questionnaire in his class but the name of this degenerate and depraved educator was not given in the press dispatch in the Los Angeles Examiner which told of the incident.

Here are a few examples of the flood of foreign products produced by low-wage foreign labor which is displacing much of our own production, according to For America: Radio sets by the millions; 4.4 million tons of steel products; 625,000 foreign cars with a loss of 172,000 jobs to Americans; 1,229,000 sewing machines; jewelry, tile, pottery, plywood, textiles, optical instruments, and gloves—all at prices far below those in this country.

Does Jimmy Roosevelt Reflect The Official Sentiment of Congress On Soviet Sabotage?

Some years ago when the great Senator Joseph R. McCarthy of Wisconsin was relentlessly fighting Communist infiltration of the government and the army, he was believed to have come so near to striking pay dirt in high places, that a campaign to "get him" was set in motion by powerful persons in Washington.

All Americans remember the disgraceful action of members of the Senate who joined in the Communist-inspired plot against him which resulted in a smear and censure by the Senate which preceded his death under mysterious circumstances only a short time later.

In direct contrast to Senator McCarthy's dedicated loyalty to his country and his opposition to its deadliest enemy, we have Representative Jimmy Roosevelt in the other House of Congress who, is turning heaven and earth to get all investigation into Soviet sabotage against this country halted.

He is demanding in season and out that the House Un-American Activities Committee be disbanded and that the probes into the activities of Communist agents who are operating in droves in the United States be stopped and sabotage in this country be allowed to proceed without interruption.

We realize that Mr. Roosevelt's pro-Communist proclivities are inherited and that it is perhaps difficult for him to restrain them. His father's record along this line is written in the official accounts of treaties, executive agreements and legislation for all to read. But, at the same time, it seems to us rather peculiar that a member of the Congress of the United States—whose citizens the Communists have sworn to "bury"—should be allowed to operate right on the floor of the House as the spokesman for the Soviet undertakers and to oppose all efforts of loyal Americans to thwart their plans for our interment.

By doing nothing to discourage or check Mr. Roosevelt's subversive activities, does the Congress actually mean to proclaim to the world that when one of its members actively opposes Soviet sabotage against the United States, he will be smeared, censured and hounded to his death but if he openly champions the right of Communists to infiltrate the American government without hindrance, he will be allowed to maintain his membership in that body in good standing?

If this is the official policy of the Congress of the United States, it is high time the taxpayers who pay their salaries were informed of that fact.

Trujillo Is Anti-Communist So We Sever Relations With Dominican Republic!

The Dominican Republic is about the last stronghold of Anti-Communism in the Latin American states, and its fight on this scourge is relentless and unremitting.

So the American State Department in Washington announces that this country has broken off diplomatic relations with the Dominican Republic, a type of action we have not taken with any other country almost within memory.

Private Property and Due Process of Law

Indirectly the 1960 Democratic platform gives its blessing to the widespread sit-in racial demonstrations at lunch counters.

As the "party of Jefferson" the Democrats contend that "the peaceful demonstrations for first class citizenship which have recently taken place in many parts of this country are a sign to all of us to make good at long last the guarantees of our constitution.

WILL PHONY STRUCTURE OF "HUMAN BROTHERHOOD" COME TUMBLING DOWN?

Even though it is generally believed that the national election will be close, we are going to stick our neck out and predict the outcome. Our assumption is not based on any political consideration but on human prejudice, about which we've heard so much in recent years.

We predict that Kennedy will lose not for the justifiable reason that he is a Socialist but for the immaterial reason of his religious faith.

As a non-Catholic, we have observed over the years that there is more prejudice in attitudes toward Catholicism than attends any other subject on the face of the earth. And no segment of the population is more permeated with prejudice of this type than members of the clergy who thunder from the pulpit against "prejudice" insofar as it affects Negroes and the social mixing of the races, but are almost totally devoid of this quality as it relates to the manner in which a man makes his prayer.

Some years ago the public press was all cluttered up with accounts of the setting up of certain "National Councils" dedicated to "Human Brotherhood" accompanied by pictures showing leaders of three different religious faiths with their arms intertwined and oozing "Brotherhood" all over the place.

Being an avid student of subversive propaganda, we recognized this movement for just that and said so. It was the beginning of the heavy drive for integration of Whites and Negroes in schools, churches and other institutions and was intended to eliminate "prejudice" so far as Negroes were concerned but had no bearing on "prejudice" against white Christians.

In the Southern Conservative for March, 1955, we said, in part, concerning this subject:

"All right, let's see how this new 'Brotherhood' scheme would work in a matter of practical and realistic politics.

"Let us suppose, for example, that one of the major political parties should take the Constitution at its word and assume that complete religious freedom prevails in this country. Let's say that one of those two major parties at its convention nominates a man who happens to be a Catholic.

"Under those circumstances, how long does any one think that the 'Brotherhood' racket would hold together and 'prejudice' remain buried.

"The welkins would ring with denunciations, charges and countercharges as Protestant preachers warned all who would listen that the Pope was preparing to pull up stakes in Rome and move into the White House. 'Tolerance' would fly out the window and 'prejudice' would be back on the throne again and especially within the circles of those pious clergymen now shouting the loudest for 'Universal Brotherhood' and for the elimination of prejudice and intolerance in human relations."

It was five years ago when we wrote the above but we are convinced that, in the meantime, there has been no diminution of "prejudice" on the part of the Protestant clergy except as it relates to the social mixing of Negroes and whites, and that their intolerance of non-Protestants is still intact in all its fervid bitterness.

So, come election day, we are anticipating that the good Baptist, Methodist and other Protestant brethren will come crawling out of the woodwork and line up for the fray. Their fight won't be against Kennedy on account of his being a Socialist because most of them are Socialists themselves; their massed assault will be on the "Pope of Rome."

We are not betting on Kennedy losing; we are merely betting on "prejudice" winning.

Since we are not a Catholic and since we do not intend to vote for either of the candidates for President, we cannot be accused of bias or "prejudice" in our observations.

We are merely reporting a situation as we believe it to exist and we could be right or we could be one hundred per cent wrong. Only time will tell.

A woman reader in Detroit writes us: "If I knew as much as you do about what is going on in Washington and could put words together like you can to express my opinion of it all, I would be the happiest person in the world." The lady is very much mistaken. If she knew as much about the double-crossing, betrayal and downright treason on the part of those trusted as custodians of the Republic as we are compelled to know from constant reading and study of the record, she would be the most unhappy person in the world. Majority of Tennesseans Have Lost Right to Complain

One of the most forceful examples that the American Republic and Constitutional Government are being destroyed from within was afforded in the recent election in Tennessee.

Estes Kefauver, running for reelection to the Senate from the Volunteer State has one of the worst voting records of any member of that body, according to the ACA INDEX so far as supporting Constitutional principles of the American Republic is concerned. During the past five years, he has voted against Constitutional Government 94 per cent of the time, and against Socialistic measures only 6 per cent.

He is universally recognized as one of the willing tools of Internationalists and One-Worlders and of Labor Unions and has consistently voted against the interests of the industrial and business concerns of his own State.

And yet the people of Tennessee overwhelmingly reelected him thereby putting the stamp of approval on the record which he has set up in the Upper House of Congress as a devotee of Karl Marx and champion of National Socialism.

The citizens of Tennessee had a perfect right to do this as they have not yet been completely disfranchised, but by their majority action in the matter, they have lost their right to complain of the frightening advance of the World Conspiracy in its campaign to take over the United States.

FEDERAL DICTATORSHIP OR STATES RIGHTS MAY COME TO SHOWDOWN

How long the Federal judiciary can continue to ride roughshod over the rights of the Sovereign States may be coming to a showdown in Alabama where there is a legal stalemate between State Circuit Judge Walter B. Jones, and U. S. District Judge Frank M. Johnson.

The Board of Registrars in Montgomery, very properly, refused to surrender voting records to Attorney General William P. Rogers who wanted to do a little plain and fancy snooping around the Montgomery Court House to see if, by some chance, some Negro had been deprived of his right to vote.

Judge Jones issued an injunction prohibiting Federal agents from inspecting the records in Montgomery or any other Alabama County.

Like a bull crashing into a china shop, Federal Judge Johnson barged in and ordered the Montgomery records turned over to Federal snoopers, and there the matter stands.

The outcome depends, of course, on whether the Constitution stands up and the various States can maintain the right to operate their own election machinery or whether a complete Federal dictatorship is already in operation with total and complete authority to cancel laws passed by the Legislatures of the several States, thereby making the Tenth Amendment to the American Constitution wholly inoperative without taking the trouble to repeal it.
