Flag Pole

In the matter of a flag pole for the above Institution, I have obtained the following costs from West & Jensen to whom has been awarded the General Contract. For a 30' flag pole erected at ground level the cost will be \$55.00. For a 15' flag pole erected on the top of the Pavilion the cost would be \$46.00. In each case this is complete with cables, etc.

I do not think that a flag pole on top of the Pavilion will particularly add to its appearance. I believe the 30' pole to be erected at a point in the gravel walk with possibly a small flower bed around it and outside this a circular walk, would have a better appearance.

Please advise me of your wishes in this matter.
