The humble petition of *Thomas Dillard*

would respectfully represent to your Honor, that *Winford Bailey* of the
County aforesaid is justly indebted to your petitioner — in the
sum of *two hundred & twenty* Dollars and *thirty seven* Cents,
on a plain note — of hand, signed by the said *Bailey*
with his own proper hand, and dated the *twelfth*
day of *February* in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight hundred and
thirty *Eight* by which said note — the said *Bailey* —
promised to pay to *Thomas*
Dillard or bearer one day
after the date thereof *two hundred & twenty* Dollars
and *thirty seven* Cents, for value received

a copy of which said note is herewith appended, and which your petitioner prays
may be made a part of this process. And your petitioner further represents that al-
though the said note *has* long since been due and payable, the said *Winford*
Bailey has hitherto
refused and neglected to pay the same, or any part thereof, and still neglects and refuses
to pay the same, to the great damage of your petitioner. Your petitioner therefore
prays your Honor, to grant a process to be directed to the said *Winford*
Bailey requiring him to be and
appear at the next term of your Honorable Court, to be holden for the County aforesaid,
to answer to the charge of your petitioner. Your petitioner further prays
for judgment for the amount of said *note* — together with interest
that has accrued thereon, and for all costs and damages sustained in and about the pro-
secuting of this suit, and for such other and further relief as to your Honorable Court may
seem meet and just, and as in duty bound will ever pray.
