My dear Friend:

I very much appreciate your telegram of February 18th.

Before I left for Washington I instructed the Industrial Commission to make a thorough investigation of the situation over there. The Public Safety Department has also been studying it carefully.

Under the circumstances existing at the present time I do not feel I have the authority to send additional Rangers over there. As I advised some of the officials in that city, however, they have the right of injunction in the courts.

I shall continue to watch this closely.
