After further consideration of one point left undetermined yesterday, I am of the opinion that as applied to the crossing of the elevated runway, the most desirable plan would be steps on each side of the runway, such to be the full width of the walk, with low risers, say 4 1/2" to 5"; this to be shown on the ground plan. Following this plan would avoid changing the gate-swings. This walk will largely be used by other than patients, hence there would seem to be no need of providing runways if the above suggestion of low and full width steps is followed.

Another point is, providing for a flagpole (of moderate height); possibly adding such to the top of the pavilion, if thought practical, might meet the requirements.

Please give these points your consideration.
