QUARANTINE PROCLAMATION  
BY THE GOVERNOR  
OF  
THE STATE OF TEXAS.  
-----:O-O:-----

PROCLAMATION OF QUARANTINE is hereby made against NEW YORK CITY and all other places where CHOLERA now prevails, or may hereafter appear.

Persons from any place so ~~affected~~<sup>in</sup> are prohibited from entering the state by land or by sea within a period of ten days after leaving said ~~affected~~<sup>in</sup> place; and should the protection of the public health in the judgment of the Quarantine Inspector require it, even a longer period of detention will be enforced.

All persons entering the state by railway will be required to exhibit to the Inspector properly attested health certificates, or make affidavit that they have not, within the specified period of time, been within any infected place.

No freights or merchandise of any kind will be permitted to be brought into the state until after the expiration of ten days; and conductors of freight trains and express messengers will be required to exhibit to inspectors sworn evidence that this provision has been complied with.

Quarantine Officers, Inspectors and guards will see that these requirements are rigidly enforced. All good citizens are requested to give information of any violation of this proclamation, so as to enable the health authorities to bring the guilty parties to ~~justice~~ punishment as the law directs .

In order to give full time for the adjustment of travel and traffic to these rules, this proclamation shall take effect on and after September 27th, and remain in full force until the disappearance of Cholera justifies its revocation.
