truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of our heirs, executors
and administrators firmly by these presents. Sealed with our
seals and dated the 30th of August, in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and forty one.

The condition of this obligation is such, that whereas the above
bound William Primm has been duly appointed Administrator
of the estate of William Dunn deceased; now, therefore, if the a-
bove bound William Primm, shall, well and truly perform all
the duties that are, or may be required of him, as such administrator,
then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full
force and effect.
