OLD BUSINESS:

James Parkhurst moved that the bill concerning the executive appointments be removed from the table. It was seconded by Frank Lupo. Motion passed. The motion concerning the executive appointments failed.

NEW BUSINESS:

James Parkhurst read an amendment for the Student Government Constitution in connection with the election board. James Parkhurst moved the Senate suspend the rules. It was seconded by Rick Herral. Motion to suspend the rules passed. The amendment concerning the election board passed.

Rick Herral read the bill on the reorganization of the Student Government Constitution to the Senate. He moved that the Senate adopt this bill. It was seconded. Joe Chiaromonte moved that the bill be amended to include five student representatives and three faculty members. The students would be selected by a joint executive committee from the Senate and the House of Representatives, and the faculty members by the President of the Student Body. It was seconded. The amendment passed. The bill, as amended, passed. 16-0

Rick Herral presented an amendment to the Cheerleader bill to the Senate. Rick Herral moved that the Senate accept the amendment. It was seconded by Kenneth Mobley. The amendment failed.

Frank Lupo moved that the Senate reconsider Senate bill number ten. It was seconded. Motion to reconsider the bill passed. Kenneth Mobley moved the bill be amended to include that the appointees be introduced to the approving bodies at the first reading. It was seconded by James Parkhurst. The amendment passed. The bill, as amended, failed.

Rick Herral moved that the Outstanding Senator be selected by the Senators. It was seconded. The resolution passed.

Frank Lupo moved that the Senate reconsider the amendment to the cheerleader matter. It was seconded. Motion to reconsider the amendment passed. The amendment passed.

Rick Herral moved that the Senate adjourn. It was seconded. Maury Corp, President of the Senate adjourned the Senate.
