

Introduction

With this exhibit, the contents of which are catalogued in the following pages, the Libraries of the University of Houston continue a program which was initiated in 1982, and is designed to feature the research and publication activities of the faculty. The conduct of research and the dissemination of findings are integral components in the life of an institution of higher learning. The University Libraries are pleased to publicly recognize those activities.

The present exhibit focuses on a particular type of publication—books, or monographs—written or edited, wholly or in part, by UH faculty members, and published from 1982 to the present. This limitation of format was imposed by the capacity of space available to display them. Because of this restriction, a large number of works which are equally representative of the creative activity of the faculty could not be included. The Library plans to feature these works in a 1988 exhibit.

As in 1982, we were reluctant to remove featured books from the circulating collections during the duration of the exhibit. Once again the faculty responded to our appeal for books from personal collections and graciously loaned or, when possible, donated books. This spirit of cooperation was particularly helpful in our efforts to mount an effective display without removing materials from our heavily used collections.

The result of our invitation to the faculty to participate in the exhibition of their publishing achievements is chronicled in this catalogue. Included are 165 books written or edited by 119 members of the faculty. Obviously, these figures do not represent a complete record of publishing by the faculty during the designated period. Undoubtedly, due to heavy commitments or other factors, some faculty were unable to take part. We also stress that materials shown in this exhibit represent only one aspect of the scholarly and creative activities of our faculty. During 1988 other aspects of these activities will be highlighted in a second exhibit.

The staff of the University Libraries are pleased to recognize the faculty through this exhibition of their work and are most appreciative of their assistance.
