Former Oiler stays a step ahead with safety gear

When Carl Mauck speaks, people listen.

Not only does he have an important message, but he also has the uncanny knack of holding your attention once you meet him. Of course, that may have to do with the fact that he's 6'4" and weighs 260 pounds, with a voice like a cannon.


The former center for the Houston Oilers is the subject of a popular poster at the Complex these days. But last week, the football star stepped off the billboard and appeared in person. He wasn't at DPMC to sign autographs, but to promote his message of safety awareness.

Mauck told a large crowd in the South Warehouse that using the proper equipment helped prolong his NFL career. "In 13 years I never had a serious injury. That's because I followed good safety practices, and used the right equipment."

His message was clear: whether you're on a football field, or at a petrochemical complex, you can ensure safety by using the right equipment for the right job. Once you recognize the hazards, you can take the necessary steps to protect yourself.

"You're not very productive when you're injured," Mauck said.

The former Oiler, who will be an offensive line coach for the New Orleans Saints next season, compared Shell with

the NFL. He pointed out that both of them keep injury statistics to try and find ways to minimize accidents on the job.

Besides speaking at the South shops, Mauck also met folks in the North and

South cafeterias and at the gates during shift change. His appearance is only part of an ongoing safety awareness program that will feature other well-known personalities in a variety of settings.

It's automatic . . . with direct deposit payroll

A new direct deposit payroll system that could save you both time and money is now being offered.

Under the Direct Deposit Payroll Plan, your check is sent directly to your bank and automatically deposited in your checking or savings account. A deposit advice form, which details information like withholding taxes and insurance premiums, is mailed to your home on or before payday.

Direct deposit means no more trips to the bank, and having to wait in the long lines once you get there. Even if you're on vacation or out of town, your paycheck will be safely in the bank.

Since your check is transferred electronically, there is no chance of it being lost in the mail. Shell will send your pay through the National Automated Clearing House Network, which is managed by the Federal Reserve System.

Remember, this is your choice; if you don't opt for direct deposit you'll receive your checks as you normally do. If you'd like to participate in the program beginning in July, you must return your authorization form by June 15, but you can join at any time in the future. See your Employee Relations representative for more information.

The Shell Federal Credit Union, which serves many of us at the Complex, is a member of the ACH network.
