

STATE CHAIRMAN OF LOAN MAKES REPORT

MRS. MINNIE FISHER CUNNINGHAM GIVES WOMEN'S TOTAL FOR 114 COUNTIES.

The report received by Mrs. Minnie Fisher Cunningham, chairman of the woman's liberty loan committee in Texas, at the end of the second week of the fourth liberty loan drive shows a total of \$14,868,180 subscribed through the woman's liberty loan committee in 114 Texas counties. Women's committees were organized to work in practically every county in the state.

"Although the report is a partial one," said Mrs. Edith Hinkle League, secretary to Mrs. Cunningham, "we are gratified by the work done in those counties from which we have heard."

Especially encouraging reports were received from the drouth-stricken districts, Mrs. League said, the people in that section of the state having made a great effort to buy bonds. Many cheerful and inspiring letters were received from the women of these counties, she said.

Only fifty-six reports were received at Mrs. Cunningham's office for the first week, and in these counties \$3,009,335 worth of bonds were sold through the women's committees.
