Dear Sir:-

1st - In reporting estimates of cost under date of July 25, 1926, by Mr. Sullivan to me, copy of which you have in your file, he states that the lighting fixtures, among other items mentioned, were not included, and no contract was let for the lighting fixtures at the time the other contracts were entered into.

2nd - Mr. Sullivan had bids submitted for lighting fixtures, which I reported to you under date of June 14th last, and which you approved letting to Jacobs Brothers under date of June 17th for \$434.38.

3rd - The written record does not disclose that you intended to pay for the lighting fixtures, and this item was not included in the statement furnished you by the Fidelity under date of August 26th, though Mr. Sullivan says it was and is his understanding that you desired to do so.

I am reporting this to you so that you can advise whether you desire to pay for the fixtures or have the Hospital Association, which has some funds assembled for furnishing, pay for such.
