
Dr. Davis mentioned a recent decision of the Foundation not to extend their giving for the present until they can see the outcome of gifts already made.

I have a feeling that in order to make our case an exception to the Foundation's present policy, it will be necessary to approach Mr. Rosenwald personally, and wonder if you have in mind the way of best accomplishing this.

I think we can equip very well for \$10,400, including Mr. Sullivan's estimate of \$4,400. for the laundry, \$1,600. for the chemistry room and \$700. for the domestic science room.

We are now securing prices of furniture, and even if we fail to get help from outside, will proceed to furnish the living quarters.
