Dear Sir & Madam:

The above persons, of which you are one, have been nominated to act as members of an Advisory Committee, the writer being named as the Chairman.

In order that you may understand the aims and ends of this institution, I will mention here that the definite purpose is "Helping the Negro to Help Himself". The building now under construction is located on property provided by the City, bounded by Elgin, Ennis, Holman and Paige Streets. I am enclosing a copy of the contract between the donor and the City of Houston, which in turn includes a pertinent provision from its corporate charter.

It is expected that the building will be completed around June 1st, and that certain exercises will be held on Emancipation Day, June 19th. Accordingly, the first meeting of the Advisory Committee will be called early in May for the purpose of coming to mutual understanding of the work, organizing the Committee, formulating by-laws, and considering the selection of a Board of Directors, as provided for under the Charter.
