## Trojan Horses on the Supreme Court Are Kicking Down Constitutional Safeguards

### If We Are Going to Eliminate Pests Lets Start in Washington

A bill before Congress, introduced by the Honorable Lee Metcalf of Montana, seeks to eliminate pests in the fields and forests of America and would appropriate millions of dollars of taxpayers' money for this purpose.

The idea is sound all right but first things should come first.

We must all concede that mosquitoes, cockroaches, flies, ants, boll weevils, Egyptian moths and such do a lot of damage and should be eliminated.

But the damage they do is mild compared to that of the human pests who are destroying the Republic and before we go all out for the Montana statesman's suggestions, we think that the helicopters and planes loaded with DDT which his bill calls for, should fly over Washington and squirt the stuff on members of Congress, Presidential advisers in the White House and Justices of the Supreme Court.

If we are going to fumigate and get rid of pests, let's do the job up right and start at the source of infection.

If we first kill the termites who are eating away at the foundations of government, the job of exterminating minor insects should be comparatively easy.

### 'Operation Spider' Is the Latest Aberration of Mental Scientists

Our natural inclination is to say "now we've heard everything" but we would probably be mistaken because nuttier things bob up every day.

In the latest, but probably not the last, in a series of cockeyed experiments by "mental engineers," we learn that spiders are being "driven crazy in the interest of science."

Dr. Nicholas A. Bercel of the University of Southern California, in a chemical approach to the problem of schizophrenia, is conducting these tests according to Seymour Korman, Los Angeles correspondent of the Chicago Tribune.

It seems that Bercel lines up a slew of Indian spiders which he has first selected because they are "conformists" and spin their webs in identical patterns. He then takes serum from the blood of human mental patients and pumps it in the spiders with startling results.

The spiders immediately are transformed into "non-conformists" and start spinning webs of an individual pattern rather than following the group plan of uniform behavior. This example of individuality and original thinking is, in the view of political scientists such as Dr. Bercel, conclusive proof of insanity.

The problem over which Dr. Bercel is now tearing his hair—if he is not already baldheaded—is how to develop a serum which will restore these spiders back to normalcy and compel them to perform as a uniform group.

If he is able to do this, he's got it made. He and his fellow scientists can then take any recalcitrant human being who dares to oppose World Government and International Communism and shoot him full of the serum after which the juice-happy victim will whip into line and start beating the drum for peaceful co-existence, international brotherhood, U. S. recognition of Red China and the passage of the Civil Rights bill.

In the back of our mind is a nudging reminder that we recently heard something else about another of this Bercel creature's outlandish experiments but we're not going to concentrate too hard because we might remember what it was and at this point with "operation spider" fresh in our memory, we couldn't take it.

Like atomic bombs, and equally dangerous, decisions of the Supreme Court continue to be dropped on the American people causing destruction of the Rights of the States and freedoms of the citizen and paralyzing committees of Congress and other agencies empowered to expose and halt Communist invasion of the United States. Unless the dedicated enemies of the American Constitution now sitting on the Nation's highest Bench are forcibly removed or shorn of their usurped power to demolish the Republic, Communist conquest of this country will be achieved without the loss of a life or the firing of a shot by the Soviet forces in the Kremlin.

At the beginning of the Supreme Court's defection to International Communism some years ago when it first started feeling out the temper of the people by tossing out a ruling favorable to subversives now and then, there was audible opposition only from a few of us "die-hards" and "reactionaries" who were generally believed to be on the look-out for something to squawk about any way.

In popular opinion, the Court was merely operating within that margin of error universally conceded to bodies of human make-up and it was widely believed that, after one or two excursions into the field of psychology and sociology, the Justices would once again look to the Constitution and the law as the authority for their rulings.

There are a lot of sadder but wiser people now and lamentation, wailing and gnashing of teeth over the Court's undeviating concessions to subversives is nation-wide.

Only Communists, Negroes and liberal minority group members have a look of content on their faces like that of the cat who has just lapped up a saucer of cream or spent the night out on the town.

From the first faint sound of small voices crying in the wilderness in protest against the Court's Communist-biased decisions, bitter denunciation of that body has burgeoned into a mounting crescendo which is reverberating from coast to coast.

In recent weeks the Court has been the recipient of the bitterest criticism ever directed toward an agency of the American government and resolutions of censure and verbal condemnation have emanated from all sections of the country and from vast segments of the people including bar associations and individual members of the legal profession, members of Congress, professional and civic groups, columnists and editorial writers in the nation's press and for the first time in history, there is serious talk of impeachment charges being brought against the Justices in our highest tribunal which was once universally looked upon with reverence and awe.

So diametrically opposed to the interests and internal security of the Republic have some of the decisions been that one of the Court's own members who trailed along with the ruling on Segregation, apparently became conscience-stricken, threw up his hands in horror and openly rebelled when his colleagues on the Bench opened jail doors to Communist prisoners and the files of the Department of Justice to criminals of the underworld.

Even the White House became alarmed when public outrage reached the boiling point and the President is reported in the press to have warned his staff not to take part in the controversy raging around the heads of the Justices whose ring-leaders are his own appointees.

Some of the rulings which have stirred national indignation to its highest pitch and which a great American journalist has described as "treason's greatest victory" concerned what the Court is pleased to designate as "civil liberties", ignoring the palpable fact that in guarding the "civil liberties" of a favored group, they were destroying not only

## Washington Schools Are Proving A 'Horrible Example' to the Nation

Washington is the city which the President of the United States held up sometime ago as one where schools should be an example to the nation in the matter of integration. They have, all right, but it is a "horrible example" which they are setting for others to follow.

On Friday, June 21, The Washington Daily News carried a two-column headline which read "Pregnancy Increasing in Schools", and said in part: "Dr. John R. Pate, chief of the District's Bureau of Disease Control today warned that the increasing number of pregnant school children threatens the city with 'an enormous moral and economic catastrophe'.

"He said records of children reporting to the Southwest Health Center show a number of teenage girls have become pregnant to stop school". An increasing number of abortions among these "junior mothers" in the past few months present an alarming medical problem, he added.

Dr. Pate said that eight pregnancies were reported at the Southwest Clinic among elemen-

tary school children — one ten-year old and seven 11-year olds.

The article added that when statistics were released a year ago, they revealed that 100 junior high school girls were "excused" from classes every year because they were pregnant. Most of them were colored, the report said, but it appears that an increasing number of white girls are becoming involved.

Integration is proving to be an example but we are sure it is of a different type from that which the President had in mind when, in his complete ignorance of the subject, he predicted such glowing success for the integrated Washington schools.

*"Red Monday, presumably, will not come again until the Supreme Court resumes its regular sittings in the Fall," says Lynn Landrum, Dallas Morning News columnist. "But the Red Mondays of June 10 and June 17 have so encouraged the Communists of the United States that they are crawling out from underground like tumblebugs in the sun."*

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the inalienable rights and freedoms of the American people as a whole, but endangering the structure of national security as well.

Wholesale embezzlement of authority on the part of the Court began with the Segregation ruling as all responsible and reasonable Americans now concede.

Openly repudiating the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution which says that "The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively", the Court invaded the field of State education and arrogated to itself authority to dictate the procedure under which the public school systems of the several States should operate.

With utter contempt for the rights, views and opinions of local citizens of the various States of the Union, the Court flung out the insulting information that it based its action on the recommendations of a Swedish Marxist in Stockholm and his staff of black and white Communist frontiers in the United States who had written a book on the subject.

Next the Court launched an all-out attack on our national security program which domestic Communists had long opposed because it was set up to prevent Communist infiltration into the various agencies of the Federal government. Under the Court's ruling on this program, a Communist can no longer be fired from a government job as a security risk unless the position he holds is a "sensitive" one and the matter of who decides on the question of "sensitivity" is anybody's guess.

In a sweeping attempt to prevent Congressional investigation of Communists in future, the Court reversed the conviction of a labor leader who had been identified by witnesses as a Communist and, at the same time, Earl Warren in handing down the decision clearing him, delivered a stinging denunciation of Congressional committees who investigate Communists. Hundreds of witnesses have impudently defied Congressional committees in the past and, as a result of the Court's decision in this instance, it is believed that all Communists in future can safely refuse to answer any question relating to their subversive activities, thanks to Warren who was apparently planted on the Court to do what he is doing now.

In setting aside the conviction of an alleged Communist on the ground that the defendant had not been permitted to see the government's material containing information against him, the Court made it imperative that, hereafter, Department of Justice files must be given to persons on trial. As a result, Communists, murderers, rapists, dope peddlers and all other types of criminals are now demanding to be allowed to see the files concerning evidence against them. In this way, their attorneys can build up the case favoring the criminal in such a way as to make it difficult, if not impossible, for the prosecution to secure a conviction.

The High Court threw out a conviction of a Communist who had been given twenty years by a Pennsylvania State Court after a trial for sedition. "The States have no right to try Communists on charges of sedition," the Court's ruling said and added that the Federal government will take care of that. Which appears to be another way of saying the Supreme Court will free such seditionists.

## Let Us Remember Mr. Knowland

There is little enough to be said of yesterday's vote in the House of Representatives on the so-called Civil Rights Bill. The bill is an insult to the South; it does grave violence to old principles of jurisprudence; it invites incredible new friction and animosity in an area where bitterness already lies deep. The South henceforth can remember June 18, 1957, as we remember May 17, 1954, each a black day for the Republic.

The bill goes to the Senate, where lobbyists of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People established their camp last night.

Special attention may now be directed toward the activities of one man, Senator William Knowland of California, who has assumed leadership for NAACP forces in the upper chamber.

Mr. Knowland, in his eagerness to ram this bill down the throat of the South, is moving heaven and earth—taking advantage of every parliamentary device he can find—to force immediate consideration of the bill. He can't wait. Bidding for the support of powerful Negro blocs in the next Republican National Convention, Senator Knowland has turned his back on friends in the South.

Very well. We have long memories down here. And when Mr. Knowland, having retired from the United States Senate, seeks the presidency of the United States three years hence, some of us will still be around to recall the Bill Knowland of June, 1957.

The Senator has chosen to lie down with Tricky Dick Nixon, with Clarence Mitchell of the NAACP, with every left-wing protagonist of race-mixing and judicial tyranny.

See you in '60, Mr. Knowland! Come South and tell us how much you love States' rights.

With further eye to the protection of the rights of Communists and ex-Communists the Court set aside the conviction of three residents of California who had been convicted and sentenced for harboring a Communist known to have advocated the overthrow of the American government.

Perhaps the most astounding display of favoritism toward the Soviets by the Court was its action in handing down a decision which knocked out the conviction of fourteen Communists who had been indicted, tried and found guilty of openly advocating the overthrow of the American government. The ruling was based on technicalities and pointed out that in prosecuting Communists it must be shown that such Communists not merely advocated the overthrow of the government but that they must "have incited people to action". In other words, it seems clear from this decision that a Communist cannot be prosecuted in connection with attempts to overthrow the American government until after it has been overthrown.

There are numerous other cases which the court has disposed of in similar manner which, in the aggregate, have contributed to the floodtide of fury that has engulfed the nation. Among these was the release of a Negro rapist who had been given the death penalty for a beastly attack on a white housewife in Washington, D.C. and whom the Court freed on the ground that he "had been held too long without arraignment". The prosecution was unwilling to submit the housewife to the horror and emotional strain of another trial and so the Negro will probably be turned loose to commit similar crimes.

Narcotics peddlers have also been given their freedom by the Court on the ground that their accusers had not been properly identified, a sort of Emily Post touch, so to speak, where proper introductions must be made between the buyer and the seller.

To cap it all, William J. Brennan, Jr., one of the Court's so-called Justices, addressed a regional meeting of the American Bar Association in Denver on May 9 and made the dumbfounding proposal that, in the administration of justice, there should be "centralized supervision under a single head". He added that "hodge-podge judicial systems should be replaced by an integrated judicial structure administered by modern methods". (Like a sausage factory turning out frankfurters, no doubt.) Some one man, he said, must be in charge of the judiciary system just as an efficiency expert directs the operation of a business.

So there we have it right off the bat from an official of the highest Court in the land — a proposal for a "Legal Czar" to administer justice to the citizens of the United States and who could, in this capacity, tell the Courts which cases to speed up, which ones to drop and who could eventually move into the substantive field, as one Constitutional lawyer suggests, and tell the judges how to decide the cases.

Meantime, it will be interesting for cynical students of the history of the rise and fall of nations to sit around and make bets as to the length of time this Republic can survive—in view of the Trojan Horses now stabled in the Supreme Court Building in Washington and who are kicking down our Constitutional safeguards, one by one.

## 'Hello Suckers' Would Be Fitting Way to Salute American Taxpayers

We warned last month that the "economy wave" in Congress would turn out to be a blast of hot air and that is exactly the case.

After blowing off steam in the press and making headlines for the benefit of the folks back home, Senate Committees are restoring most of the items cut out in the House and Eisenhower's padded budget will probably finally emerge intact.

It might have been better if his program for a spending spree unequalled in all history had been accepted without protest in the first place since additional millions have been spent in publishing the record of all the yak yak by supposed dissenters who knew all the time they would fall in line in the end.

In this connection, the Committee on Government Operations of the House of Representatives issued last May 15th, a report which shows that members of Congress who vote billions for foreign aid have no more idea of where this money goes, or how it is spent than a baboon has of the theory of relativity.

All they know is that the taxpayers of the United States are keeping up sixty foreign countries and that they must vote an appropriation in a lump sum to meet this obligation. Appropriations for agencies of the Federal government are usually made for specific purposes and it is possible for members of Congress to have some idea of what they are doing when they vote appropriations for the American government.

But when it comes to foreign aid, they are flying blind and shooting wild and all they know about what the money they are so generously giving away is being spent for is what the International Cooperation Administration tells them and that is less than nothing. The Chief function of this International Cooperation Committee is to bleed American suckers for the benefit of the sixty foreign countries and the only role Congressmen play in the picture is that of puppets performing in response to strings pulled by ICA internationalists.

Ask an average member of the Lower House of Congress, where all legislation appropriating money must originate, to explain where and for what purpose the \$60,000,000,000.00 which has been fluffed off during the past ten years under the "Mutual Security Program", has been spent, and he would stutter like Porky Pig and change the subject. "His not to reason why; his just to vote this pie in the sky."

Ostensibly this "foreign aid" or "mutual security" program is to stave off Communism. Actually it is part and parcel of the Conspiracy of International Communism to bankrupt the United States and hasten our entrance into a one-world Communist government, and most all Americans are coming to realize that except members of Congress who hold the purse strings.

The report of the Committee on Government Operations says that estimates for aid sent to each of the sixty countries are based merely on requests from such countries for aid and that such requests are not challenged or screened by American governing officials. Concerning the matter, the report says:

"Prior to submitting a request for

aid from the United States for any . . . purpose, it is . . . natural to expect that our aid officials would challenge and screen such requests for aid and the facts and reasoning on which they are founded. It should not be necessary for our officials to explain, but if it is, it should not be beyond the comprehension of foreign governments to understand that the expenditure of funds for which the American people are taxed must be justified to the representatives of the American people, the Congress . . . We find it hard to believe that American diplomatic personnel are so inept at negotiation that they could not explore proposals a good deal more than is now done . . ."

The truth of the matter is that this ICA makes requests for lump sums and then works out its program afterwards and decides where the funds will go. In some cases, our brilliant diplomats have found it difficult to give the money away as there are a few countries left in the world whose leaders are possessed of integrity and they don't want our help and say so. When Harold Stassen was running the foreign aid show, he ran up against this situation in the case of a Middle East country which told him frankly they didn't want our money and all but advised him to drop dead. He ran around like a chicken with its head off for weeks until he found a country which would accept the dough.

When the Committee on Government Operations asked a lame-brain Deputy Director of ICA why there was no record of why each country was allotted a certain amount and for what purpose, the dim-wit replied that he did not believe that "having a record would serve a sufficiently useful purpose to justify the work that would be involved."

The ICA does condescend to furnish some general headings describing the purposes for which foreign aid is intended the most astounding of which is the one titled "to balance the recipient country's budget." Why, in Heaven's name, are we required to balance other countries' budgets when we can't balance our own?

In commenting on this item, the report of the Committee on Government Operations says: "The statement that a given sum is required to 'balance the recipient country's budget' is an explanation of sorts, of the use intended, but it does not explain why this particular amount of money is required rather than some other amount, how long this process must go on, what United States Security or policy objectives are furthered by the activity, or what the alternatives are to proceeding as proposed."

One statement in the report floored us and we believe it will also throw any American who reads it. It is a description of ICA's "highly classified printed presentation in 4 or 5 volumes, setting forth in more than a thousand pages of charts, graphs, schedules and narrative, the Administration expression of how the funds requested might be used." This material, according to the report, is brought into the House "under military guard" and exhibited to four Committees of Congress.

Why the "military guard"? Are we at war or something and who are

## Bishop Appoints Negro Pastor White Congregation Walks Out

Whoever said that Los Angeles had succumbed to the Black Plague didn't know what they were talking about.

In that great city, just as in the South and all over the country, there are hundreds of thousands of self-respecting Americans who are suffering the tortures of the damned because of the contemptible behavior of cheap-skate politicians in the three branches of the Federal government who are determined to subject them to unspeakable indignity in order to capture the colored vote.

In the City of the Angels early this month the entire membership of a Protestant church — and a Methodist church at that — resigned in a body along with its trustees in protest against the action of Bishop Gerald H. Kennedy, member of the Executive Committee of the National Council of Churches, in appointing a Negro pastor over the congregation of the Normandie Avenue church of that denomination.

Not only did the entire membership resign, according to an Associated Press release, but they also removed all furniture and memorials from the church and sent them to their former pastor who now presides over a church at suburban El Monte.

Board Chairman J. H. Seal said: "We do not believe it is good policy to mix races or to force one race upon another. Don't get the idea we are anti-Negro. We are not but we had a white church and we wanted to keep it that way."

This was not in the Deep South, remember, but out on the West Coast where it is often said that in that area, if a white man behaves himself, he is regarded almost as good as a Negro.

There should be some way to honor this congregation of good Methodists for this fine exhibition of mass courage and open defiance

He is reported as having been connected with Methodist Federation for Social Action, described by the Internal Security Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee, 1956, in this manner: "With an eye to religious groups, the Communists have formed religious fronts such as the Methodist Federation for Social Action", and by the California Committee on Un-American Activities, 1948, as "Among the more conspicuous fronts for Communist activity in the field of relief, assistance and welfare work".

## Southern Conservative Editorial Carried in South African Paper

Two events have occurred within the past two weeks which have given us quite a lift, because they indicate how the Southern Conservative gets around.

One was the publication of our lead editorial for April in its entirety in the South African Observer published in Cape Town, South Africa.

The title of the editorial which the Observer reproduced was "If You're a Good Conservative American Patriot . . . Let's Face It . . . You're Nuts". In reproducing the editorial, editor S. E. D. Brown refers to our paper as "The Southern Conservative, Fort Worth, Texas, U.S.A. — the newspaper that has the ability to express what millions of Americans are thinking".

In South Africa they have a problem which parallels ours in the United States — Communists who constantly agitate for integration of the races, aided by lame-brain liberals and do-gooders who are constantly trying to do something but don't know what. They may even have a South African counterpart of Eleanor Roosevelt who sashays around in the jungles stirring the Negroes up, for all we know.

The other matter that surprised and pleased us was receipt of a letter from a member of European nobility — who must be nameless — who praised our paper highly and indicated approval of our work in a very substantial manner.

It is such things as these which make life interesting for the editor of a publication like ours, and which help to mitigate the disheartening instances when we seriously doubt if we—and others like us—are doing any good, and if anybody is paying any attention to what we say.

## How 'Liberal' Can They Be and Still Rank as 'Conservatives'?

We can take most of the claptrap associated with the great game of politics in our stride and without wincing, but we rise to the boiling point when some ill-informed character tries to sell us on the idea that William E. Knowland and/or Richard M. Nixon are Conservatives. That observation is an insult to our intelligence.

Perhaps, in the regular order of things, both of them would have preferred to pitch their public careers on a basis of conservatism for both, at times, have risen to great heights of statesmanship which makes their ultimate defection to Modern Republicanism all the more tragic.

It was when the mongrelization

epidemic broke out like the seven year itch and the non-existent "Negro problem" became paramount to all others that both capitulated and fell like a ton of bricks.

They are entitled to their opinion, of course, but we don't propose to listen to any one call them "Conservatives" without putting up a terrific argument. No Conservative worthy of the name is willing to surrender fundamental American rights, such as trial by jury, in order to garner minority votes.

We can think of a lot of things to call both of them but the term "Conservative" would not be among them.

## Northern Republican Makes Powerful States Rights Plea

We have always held that the depraved rulings of the Supreme Court in flagrantly overthrowing the Constitution would bring resentment and protest from other States than the South since their vicious decisions threaten the rights and freedoms of all Americans alike.

During the debate in the House of Representatives over the Civil Rights issue, the Honorable Noah Mason, Republican of Illinois, made one of the most forceful denunciations of the Court's recent rulings that was heard in that body.

Step by step he told of the degeneration of the Court beginning with Roosevelt who sought a Court which would reflect his own Sociological views rather than the law of the land, and continuing down to and including Eisenhower who, in naming appointees to that post, has the same end in view.

"For over 150 years the American people lived with and under the Federal Constitution—as drafted by the Founding Fathers" Congressman Mason said: "During that time, they were a happy, contented and a prosperous people . . . Then came our New Dealers and our Modern Republicans with ideas and proposals to change our Constitutional form of government into a welfare state, a centralized Socialist-Labor government, with our sovereign States relegated to a subservient position, exercising only those powers and duties that might be assigned them by an all-powerful, arrogant, dictatorial, centralized Federal government—divorced from those powers, duties and privileges guaranteed to the States by our Federal Constitution."

Congressman Mason attributed the freeing of Communists by Supreme Court decisions, the segregation ruling, the bus segregation case, the Michigan "dirty books" case, the Girard College case and other rulings in which the Court exceeded its authority to the fact that the present Justices are "socially, economically and politically minded instead of being legally experienced and judicially inclined."

He quoted President Eisenhower as having said in a speech during his campaign for the Presidency at Des Moines in 1952:

"The Federal Government did not create the States of this Republic. The States created the Federal Government. The creation should not supersede the creator. For if the States lose their meaning, our entire system of government loses its meaning and the next step is the rise of the centralized national state in which the seeds of autocracy can take root and grow."

"In the words of President Eisenhower himself, therefore, the destruction of Constitutional States Rights will 'sow the seeds of autocracy' and bring about in America 'some other form of government' and force us to establish a 'dictatorship'" Congressman Mason said.

He told of the disastrous experience with Federal Civil Rights legislation following the Civil War when there was "unspeakable corruption on every side" all in the name of Civil Rights.

## Bedroom Phase of Integration Is Being Pushed by the Reds

A striking example of the general depravity and lax morals of the public is given in the announcement that in the East the moving picture "Island in the Sun" is proving one of the most popular films released in recent years.

"Island in the Sun" makes an indirect plea for intermarriage of white and black people and in its cast are Negro half-breeds and jaded White females whose fading careers in legitimate pictures caused them to jump at a chance to appear in this lewd offering.

Almost any hour of the day, one can turn on the radio and hear songs from this production in which plaintive love lyrics are sung by male mulattoes to complaisant White women. "Island in the Sun" is mongrelization propaganda, set to music. Somebody is pushing the picture very hard, indeed.

The producer of the show is Robert Rossen, an admitted former member of the Communist Party. Among the organizations officially declared by the Attorney General of the United States, Committee on Un-American Activities of Congress, and report of Un-American Activities in California as being Communist and subversive to which Rossen is shown as having formerly belonged are: Artists Front to Win the War, League of American Writers, Hollywood Writers Mobilization, American Russian Institute, Hollywood Democratic Committee, Independent Citizens Committee of the Arts Sciences and Professions and Los Angeles Emergency Committee to Aid the Strikers.

When Rossen was subpoenaed by the Committee on Un-American Activities in 1951, he took the fifth amendment and refused to answer questions concerning his Communist activities. The Senate Fact-Finding Committee of the California Senate said in their 1955 Report: "Robert Rossen who for several years played a dominant role in the Hollywood Writers Mobilization and masqueraded as a sincere liberal and not a Communist, finally admitted that he had been, during all of his tenure as an officer of the Mobilization, an active Communist Party member."

In 1953, Rossen voluntarily appeared before the Un-American Activities Committee in Washington and was a cooperative witness, admitting his membership in the Communist Party from 1937 to 1947. He gave the Committee the names of others who had been Communists and indicated that he was through with such affiliation.

However, if he had surrendered all his Communist beliefs, he would not have produced this Mongrelization propaganda picture to be viewed by and no doubt to influence Americans of weak character and unstable morals.

## Florida PTA Goes on Record Against Christian Prayer

Down in Miami, Florida, according to the Miami Herald of May 23, officials of the local PTA, backed up by the executive council of the county PTA, ordered a Protestant minister's wife to stop using the name of Jesus in the prayers she offered at meetings of the group or face expulsion from that organization.

The incident set off such a wave of indignation that two local church organizations, the Greater Miami Ministerial Association and the Greater Miami Council of Churches passed a joint resolution condemning such action.

The Red complexion of the National Parent Teacher Organization is generally recognized by the list of subversive speakers constantly invited to address its conventions and by its alignment with left-wing causes.

But when it comes to the point where a local group of parents and teachers of children make threats against a member for praying in the name of Jesus, it is high time for the American people who are not under the domination of a powerfully organized anti-Christian group out to destroy Christianity in the United States, to take over and clean the filthy subversives out of local Parent-Teacher groups.

## Constitution Day Convention to Be Held Again This Year in Chicago

### Vicious Lobby Which Should Be Investigated

One of the most corrupt lobbies in Washington and one which should be thoroughly investigated but never will be, is that of the National Education Association.

According to a statement by Congressman Albert H. Bosch of New York in the Congressional Record of June 13, this lobby has \$3.8 million, most of which is spent in an effort to bring about Federal intervention in the public schools of the United States.

A fair sample of the dishonesty of NEA is its published statement in October, 1956, that Congress "should carry out the mandate of the (White House) conference report and enact legislation which will provide substantial Federal funds for emergency school construction purposes".

Any American who is half way informed about the "White House Conference on Education" in December of 1955, knows it was rigged by NEA politicians and that the various delegations to the Conference were not permitted to vote on Federal Aid or anything else. The overwhelming sentiment of those attending was against Federal Aid, but the smart boys and girls of NEA juggled the thing by getting their own kind named chairmen of each division and accordingly made a report in line with what they had decided on before they went to the Conference.

If NEA officials had all the sense they should have, they would know that there is no such thing as "Federal Aid" and that money appropriated as such was first taken from the States through force.

But there will be no investigation of this vicious lobby because of the supposed voting strength of the 666,000 members which the outfit claims.

*Francis O. Wilcox, assistant Secretary of State, in an address to the National Education Association's convention at Philadelphia, stressed the need of American schools and college to teach students about Communism. Mr. Wilcox and the State Department can stop worrying on that score. Just as long as the NEA is on the job, American students will be taught Communism—not just "about" Communism.*

*A member of Congress has dug up an item of \$223.49 which the State Department paid to the Gold Liquor Company in Washington. Asked about it, one of the Department's bureaucrats explained that it was from Secretary Dulles' "emergency fund" and that it paid for liquor to entertain foreign dignitaries. Years ago, it was brought out that the Department's "Wine, Women and Song" division is a vital part of modern diplomacy, and party girls who are on call by the State Department when visiting firemen need cheering up, are said to receive among the highest pay checks in Washington.*

On September 14 and 15, the Third Annual Constitution Day Convention will be held at the grand ballroom of the LaSalle Hotel in Chicago.

This event is sponsored by We, the People, a patriotic organization with headquarters in that city and is usually attended by large delegations of concerned Americans from every State in the Union.

Among those who make the pilgrimage to the Windy City for Constitution Day ceremonies are business men who are alarmed at the progress of Socialism in this country with its toll of business failures; farmers who are being persecuted, fined and jailed for growing more grain than politicians think best; physicians and surgeons who fear Socialized medicine and taxpayers generally who are paying tribute to Washington in amounts that range from 20 to 91 per cent of their earnings.

Many outstanding Conservative members of Congress have addressed the Convention in the past and it is expected that several will be on hand at the September meeting.

We had the privilege of attending the event last year as an observer and were greatly encouraged and inspired by the evidence of so much constructive activity being carried on by determined Americans from all sections of the country who intend to fight to the last ditch for the preservation of the Republic in spite of constant assaults against it by dedicated internationalists and one-worlders in Congress, on the Supreme Court and in the White House.

## With Some Exceptions We Are Proud of Southern Governors

### Organized Hate Mongers Petition the President

On Sunday, June 30, according to press reports, Glenn L. Archer, executive director of Protestants and Other Americans for Separation of Church and State, wired President Eisenhower requesting that he veto a bill which would permit two Catholic members of Congress to accept an award of the Ecclesiastical Order of St. Gregory the Great from the Vatican in Rome.

Archer claimed that the acceptance of this decoration by public office-holders would "recognize the Vatican as a foreign power."

We hear a lot about "hate mongers" these days but this outfit headed by Archer and which is responsible for a large share of such charges, is really a classic example of bigotry, intolerance and hatred among so-called religious groups.

Archer is the gentleman who was practically run out of Houston in March of 1953 when he went there to organize a local chapter of his hate group. As most similar outfits do, his group met in the Houston YMCA. Here is what the Houston Chronicle of Saturday, March 7, 1953 had to say about Archer's trip to Houston and his hasty exit therefrom:

"The brotherhood observance now being held nationally took on added significance here when Protestants took the lead in routing an anti-Catholic speaker at a meeting held at the local YMCA. The organization holding the meeting was the Protestants and Other Americans United for Separation of Church and State. The speaker was its executive director from Washington, D. C., Glenn L. Archer. The organization and the speaker came in for a good working over by the audience, most of whom accused the organization of being anti-Catholic and tinged with Communism. The encouraging part of this fine display of brotherhood was that most of those taking the floor to oppose the speaker's viewpoint declared themselves Protestants.

"May this serve as a lesson to the harbingers of hate and bigotry who seek to spread their prejudices here. No one is advocating a state church or state domination of any one denomination, nor is anyone advocating that any church dominate the state. The Constitution guarantees that there shall be freedom of worship and prohibits an established church and religious tests for office holders.

"At a time when Communism is threatening to knock out the underpinnings of our religious civilization, there must be understanding and brotherhood among Christians . . . among all who worship a single and benevolent God. To stir up hatreds among the various denominations is to aid and abet the Communists.

"Those who attended the meeting at the YMCA and routed the prejudice-spreading speaker deserve the thanks of all thinking persons of the community. It is much to their credit that they challenged such ridiculous statements as the one that the House Un-American Activities Committee is dominated

Citizens of the South who think straight have every reason to be proud of the way Governor Thomas B. Stanley of Virginia and Hon. James P. Coleman, Governor of Mississippi, performed on the "Meet the Press" television program during the Governor's Conference at Williamsburg, Virginia, recently.

There was no pussyfooting, quibbling or fence-straddling on the part of either as members of the press tried to put them on the spot in regard to the possibility of integration in their respective States. Both of them said simply and firmly that there would be no integration of the races in the schools of their States and all efforts of press representatives to confuse them or lead them into involved and abstract arguments on the subject failed dismally. They talked and acted like Southern Governors should and faithfully represented not only their deep convictions but the almost solid sentiment of the States of which they are Chief Executives.

While Governor George B. Timmerman, Jr., Governor of South Carolina did not appear on that particular program, he did give out interviews to the press and all his statements on the subject of segregation were clear, unmistakable and to the point. There was no equivocation or squirming but a straightforward assertion that there would be no segregation in his State.

We do not know whether or not Governor Marvin Griffin of Georgia attended the Governor's Conference but if he did, and if he said anything at all, it was the right thing and left no doubt where he stood on the subject.

We wish we could say the same thing of Texas' Governor Daniel but we can't. He was at the Conference and appeared on another national television program and made a statement which probably sets an all-time record for clear, brilliant and eloquent insipidity.

The Associated Press quoted him as saying, when asked his views on Segregation, that he thought "it was proper, where both White and Negro leaders were willing, to have Segregation." Ye gods!

At the last election, the people of Texas voted heavily, almost four to one, for continued Segregation, a mandate which Daniel and the Legislature failed miserably to get enacted into legislation at the last session. A few half-hearted measures were passed after being held up until the last minute and being given little thought, but the subject was not given the full measure of consideration it deserved.

## If You Thought That Your Rights Were Divinely Ordained Read This and Weep

Referring to the infamous "Civil Rights" bill, Senator Richard B. Russell of Georgia threw out this challenge to those sponsoring the Communist-inspired measure which has enraged a large section of the nation:

"If you propose to move into the South in this fashion, you may as well prepare your concentration camps now, for there are not enough jails to hold the people of the South who will today oppose the use of raw Federal power to forcibly co-mingle white and Negro children in the same schools and in places of entertainment."

Earlier, he had proposed that the matter be submitted to a referendum vote.

Negrophiles whose regard for the colored race is exceeded only by their contempt for white people, immediately broke out in a cold sweat at the idea of the American people being allowed to vote on the matter and thus put a crimp in their pet plan for lassoing Negro votes, and opposed it violently.

At his press conference, the President effectively squashed the idea by emphasizing that the American people

no longer have any say-so in such matters.

"There have been court decisions on the civil rights questions and a referendum could have no effect on them," he said.

So there you are, serfs. The Supreme Court is all-powerful; its pronouncements are as Holy Writ and you must put up with their decisions until a World Court takes over and really makes you step lively.

Knowland of California and Javits of New York, chief spokesmen of the colored race in the United States Senate, chimed in that Senator Russell's proposal was unworkable.

We agree with these three that it should not be necessary for the matter to be submitted to the people for a vote, but for an entirely different reason.

It is already taken care of in the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution and if the officials of every State in the Union, instead of only four or five in the Deep South, had an iota of integrity or understanding of the paramount Rights of the States, the Reds could go on and pass their Civil Rights bill and see where it would get them.

### Impeachment as A Weapon Is As Outmoded as the Musket

Honorable George W. Andrews of Alabama and Honorable Noah Mason of Illinois, together with other members of the Lower House of Congress, are said to be working quietly among their colleagues to get a resolution of impeachment against all nine members of the Supreme Court, passed by that body.

If this could be accomplished, it would be a long step toward the restoration of Constitutional Government in the United States and toward the elimination of corruption in the judiciary.

Unfortunately, it is useless to hope along this line because we have had too much proof during recent years that impeachment as a weapon of punishment, has been abandoned.

Personally, we don't believe that impeachment charges would be preferred against high-bracket politicians in Washington if absolute proof were provided that they had been guilty of every crime in the calendar including theft, murder, rape and high treason.

It is the people—the voters of the United States—who should be impeached and barred from citizenship for allowing themselves to become so brainwashed and regimented that they tolerate the skulduggery and malfeasance in office of our public servants.

Corruption on the part of elected or appointed representatives is possible only where the electorate is indifferent, apathetic and lacking in the will to resist tyranny.

### Chickens of Violated States Rights Come Home to Roost

## Two Nosy Old Dames Who Could Get Lost and Never Be Missed

On that occasion she ominously warned the people of that great Commonwealth that unless officials of the Old Dominion knuckled under to Northern integrationists, all private schools for which Virginia is famed throughout the world, probably would be destroyed root and branch.

With nostrils flaring, eyes blazing and hair bristling, this arrogant old battle-axe displayed such open hostility and burning antagonism toward private schools for young persons of culture as to leave with some of her audience the distinct impression that, some fifty years earlier, she had either been denied admission to one such institution or had been kicked out on her ear after crashing the gate.

Just for good measure, she also flung out a threat against Catholic schools and warned that if "class-conscious" Virginia officials persisted in opposing the promiscuous mixing of white and black children in public schools, the Federal Government would likely pass legislation to deprive "all non-public elementary and secondary schools of tax exemption". And the next step, she snorted, would be "Federal legislation to the effect that every American child must attend public schools during the elementary and secondary grades".

This fiery Nemesis of private schools did not explain who authorized her to speak for Congress in promising "Federal legislation" against them. However, it is possible that, before leaving Washington, she had conferred with Earl Warren and that he, in turn, had gotten in touch with Gunnar Myrdal. In that event, of course, her threat carried weight and authority since all "Federal legislation" on American schools now originates in Stockholm and then trickles down to the Supreme Court of the United States, after which it is passed on to the American people in the form of judicial decisions.

After she had disposed of private schools, she paid her respects to the "Byrd Machine," "power-drunk officials of Virginia," "worn-out Virginia aristocracy," and "State officials who are living in the Eighteenth Century" and wound up her tirade by calling Virginia's governor, Honorable Thomas B. Stanley, a "typical example of 'the people be damned' policy."

Her long-winded harangue covered five full columns in the Richmond News-Leader whose editor printed the drivel in its entirety because, as he said editorially, he wanted the people of Virginia to see "the stony face of Statism and the shrill voice of the demagogue" in action. From the letters of condemnation which subsequently poured in to that paper, he was correct in warning his readers that they would be infuriated after reading the Meyer address.

With Eleanor Roosevelt, heaping insults on the South is almost a full-time job and she works hard at it, never hesitating, however, to hand out advice to the ignorant and benighted people of this section along with her barbs. The Meyer dame is equally vicious and vindictive and her excursion into Virginia proves that she is a worthy rival of the meddler from Hyde Park. Neither of them overlooks an opportunity to hurl a brick-bat at the South or to refer to Southern citizens as ignorant, backward and totally lacking in understanding of "the needs of a changing world".

Right here, we propose to reciprocate and to give these impertinent old crows a little advice in return for all the wise counsel they feel they are bestowing on the peons of the under-privileged South.
