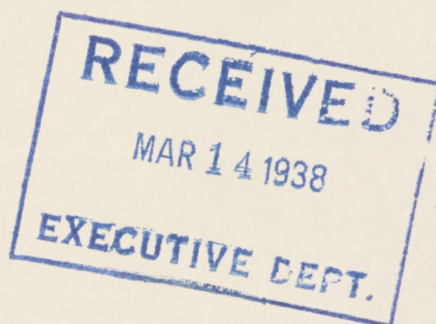

My dear Governor:


This is to thank you for your communication of March 4th, enclosing the report relative to our Health Department.
