







Plate LXXXVIII. Boat House, Jamaica Park—Detail Working Drawing.




Plate XCIV. Proposed Boston City Hall—Perspective Study.




Plate C. Subway Covering, Boston Common—Detail Working Drawing.









Plate LVII. Boston City Hospital—Pathological Building—Detail Working Drawing of Chapel.


