SINISTER FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTE TO DEMORALIZATION OF AMERICAN LAWMAKERS

Supreme Court Decides In Favor Of The Enemies Of Christianity

The American people have become used to the Supreme Court striking down the Constitution in so many cases that it has practically lost all shock value but when the Court handed down a ruling recently striking a blow at Christianity itself, there were reverberations throughout the country.

Since the United States is a Christian nation whose institutions are based on Christian Principles, all Federal and State officials have been naturally required to express a belief in God when taking the oath of office.

Now the Supreme Court has delivered a ruling which holds that it is Un-Constitutional for the Federal government, or any State government to require a "belief in the existence of God" as a qualification for public office.

This lethal blow to basic Christian policy to which this nation has adhered since the beginning of the Republic is believed to be the culmination of the fight against Christianity which has been conducted with relentless vigor for many years by anti-Christian forces in the United States and throughout the world and to the example of the Godless United Nations where any recognition of God was banned from the beginning.

If this highhanded attempt to discredit Christianity in the conduct of the various units of the American government and give sanctuary to Atheism and Godless Communism does not bring charges of impeachment against the justices on the Court who are guilty of this outrage then we have abandoned all pretense of honor and integrity and as a nation have sunk to the moral and spiritual level of the Soviet Republic and its satellites behind the Iron Curtain.

By The Way Did Anybody Ever Find Out Who Promoted Peress?

The great stir about the "leak" of military secrets out of the Pentagon and the President's action in calling on the FBI to make an investigation, leads back like every other treasonable act that is happening now, to Senator Joseph R. McCarthy and to his futile attempts to get these "leaks" stopped up many years ago.

If our continued references back to McCarthy seem like editorial nagging—all right that's just exactly what it is and we intend to keep on nagging and throwing him in the faces of those who crucified him every time some prediction which he made concerning the traitors who were operating within the government and the Army is fulfilled.

We watched in agony during the entire proceedings of the McCarthy hearings when little cheap, two-bit Washington politicians conspired to thwart him at every turn and to prevent him from making public the information concerning subversion in vital agencies which is coming to light at this late date.

Surely no person with a memory an inch long has forgotten how he tried to bring out that the Reds in the Pentagon and in the State Department were doing everything within their power to aid Communism and help to spread it throughout this country and the world.

His fearlessness in this connection was one of the reasons why he and his lovely wife failed to receive invitations to shoddy White House receptions where no color line was drawn but the door was barred against a patriot whose concern in the safety and security of his country cost him his life.

Well may President Kennedy be concerned about "leaks" in the Pentagon which of course are partly responsible for the Soviet's progress in the nuclear weapon field; but the responsibility for this shameful condition should be placed where it belongs and that is on the officials of the administration which was in power during the McCarthy hearings and who were not so much concerned in protecting our internal security as they were in discrediting the Senator from Wisconsin.

During the upcoming investigation of the Pentagon by FBI perhaps they may accidentally find out who promoted Peress.

There was so much favorable reaction to our front page editorial last month titled "What Became of Great Statesmen who Once Served in the United States Senate?" that we have decided to elaborate on the subject a bit and try to point out some of the factors which impel these specimens of the human race to perform as they do. The names used in the following editorial are fictitious to protect the identity of the guilty but the facts are attested by the almost \$300,000,000,000 indebtedness of the United States; the lost prestige of our Republic among other nations of the world; the copious stream of borrowed dollars which continues to flow into the coffers of foreign foes and friends alike; the contempt in which the American Constitution is held by our national leaders; the Marxist legislation which emerges in increasing volume from each session of Congress and the vanishing American freedoms and diminishing rights of the people, of property and of the States that provided the solid cornerstone on which our Constitutional Government rested.

There are many sinister elements which operate in the cases of comparatively honest, capable and sound-thinking Americans who happen to get elected to Congress but who, once they are in Washington, are transformed from solid, reputable and trustworthy representatives of the people into cringing and subordinate stooges of slick party chieftains in both Houses who lead them around like a prize bull with a ring in its nose.

In attempting to point out some of the factors which contribute to their disintegration, let us take the imaginary case histories, for example, of two outstanding leaders of the Senate—the Honorable I. Will Steele, Republican, who hails from the town of Mudpuddle in the corn belt of the Middle West and the Honorable Canby Hadd, Democrat, a native of Hogwallow in the Bible belt of the Deep South.

Through a quirk of the American electorate—whose strange motivations are known only to God—these two candidates on the same November day found themselves elected to membership in the highest lawmaking body in the land—the Senate of the United States.

Neither man had any particular qualifications for the job but, on the other hand, there are no cut and dried rules by which an untried contender for the office can be judged. Therefore, there was no reason to anticipate that either or both of them would not respect the solemn promises they made on the stump or that they would not represent the best interests of their States and of the nation to the fullest extent of their ability.

As in all similar cases, there was nothing in their background, environment or record to foretell that one day they would emerge as full-fledged political confidence men and as powerful leaders of the biggest gang of legally organized thieves ever to operate outside the underworld.

There was no hint that the day would come when, by their influence and concurring votes, they would be largely responsible for the passage of House tax bills which rob American citizens deaf, dumb and blind and which financially mutilate and denude their victims and leave them with only their shirt-tails flapping in the wind.

There was no possible way to look ahead and visualize these two public servants voting away the God-given freedoms of the people; stipulating by law who an employer should hire or fire; deciding how many hours a man should work and his pay therefor; authorizing the Federal government to latch onto a laborer's wage before it ever reached the hand of the earner; denying the citizen the right to run his social affairs or to associate with persons of his choice; knocking down the rights of the States like ten pins in a bowling alley; confiscating the

'Ambassador of Spending' Reports Successful Trip To Latin America

Adlai Stevenson returned from a tour of Latin America and announced that his trip was highly successful.

In this connection, he was probably speaking in behalf of the Latin American people to whom he promised \$10,000,000 of American taxpayers' money for "social and economic" benefits to their country. It was certainly not a successful trip from the viewpoint of the American people who have to cough up this money.

property of the citizen and appropriating his money and scattering it like confetti among beggar nations of the world; and above all, ripping the Constitution to shreds and swapping a Constitutional Republic for a Welfare State in which the citizen is denied the dignity of providing for his own security and that of his family.

And so the Honorable I. Will Steele and the Honorable Canby Hadd went to Washington where levelling-off and downgrading factors would begin to operate and process them and eventually mold them into the uniform type of lawmaker who now writes the statutes under which honest, decent and respectable Americans must live and conduct their business and try to make a living.

Perhaps the most devastating and demoralizing experience of the two embryo solons came with the sudden plunge from comparative and genteel poverty into surroundings of such luxurious appointments as would have bewildered and overpowered the emperors of ancient Rome or the Oriental potentates of the mysterious East. Thick wall-to-wall carpets on their office floors, for instance, where they sank up to their shins in velvet when the softest material on which either had ever trod back home were a Sears-Roebuck rug in the living room and battleship linoleum on the kitchen floor. Perhaps it was at that moment that they first began to have delusions of grandeur and to become imbued with the conviction that money grew on trees.

Special elevators for the use of senators whisked them from floor to floor with lightning rapidity and tempted them to take frequent rides in the gadgets whether they were going anywhere or not and their fascination was unbounded for the little fancy trains which whizzed them from one building to another even if it were only a hundred yards away and whose extensive use is claimed to have caused the legs of many Washington legislators, like their brains, to have become vestigial organs.

Next was the impact of their fabulous salaries which, added to hidden emoluments and fringe benefits, including all they could get away with through padded expense accounts on committee assignments to foreign countries, amounted to a king's ransom when compared to the eight or ten thousand bucks per annum they were able to haul down when depending on their own limited talents, ability and resources in trying to make a living back home.

Big-money talk is also a prime distraction which rattles the brains of simple boys from the sticks and sends them into a tailspin from which they never quite emerge during their tenure of office. How to give away billions of dollars of other peoples' money and to apportion it equally among the vast army of foreign political crooks who perpetually have their hand out is a daily subject of luncheon table conversation and any man who mentions less than a million dollars stamps himself as a newcomer since such paltry amounts are regarded as peanuts and useful only as pocket change.

Scores of million-dollar lobbies, principally representing educational, labor and church council groups, who are out to shape the economic and social policies in a New World Order, are prepared to render service to the newly-elected solons by making up their minds for them as to how they should vote on major issues thereby relieving them of the responsibility of thinking for themselves and releasing them for more urgent duties such as delivering public lectures for pay.

An institution which indirectly influences the behavior of a new lawmaker suddenly projected into what is loosely called Washington society is the cocktail party which, like Tennyson's brook, goes on forever and the old boys whose wildest indulgence back home consisted of

sneaking an occasional slug of Bourbon, with branch water for a chaser, soon learn to bend an elbow with the best of the cocktail circuit riders.

At these social rat races are to be found swarms of a little publicized but highly potent breed of friendly persuaders in the matter of influencing a freshman lawmaker's future official conduct. These are the unpaid feminine lobbyists who are usually the attractive wife or girl friend of agency bureaucrats who are eternally on the make for more money for their departments. So they sick these slick broads on a particular new lawmaker and they take out after him like a hound dog treeing a coon.

The hot line they hand their victims nearly always works because it has to do with what a sensation he has created during the short time he has been in the nation's capital and what a bright future awaits him provided he follows the right advice and plays along with the right crowd. Confidential tips on "who's who" in Washington are slipped to him which he swallows whole. When, after three highballs she finally cuts loose and starts really telling him what a great man he is, she finds it duck soup to sell the old goat on the idea. After a few doses of this pap, strategically administered as to time and place, his sneaking suspicion that he is a hot-shot who knows all the answers, develops into a definite conviction which nothing short of an earthquake is ever able to shake.

But the most powerful and lethal instruments of all for taking the raw material as represented by a rookie lawmaker and transforming him into a finished Marxist product are the hordes of political economists and social scientists who, regardless of what administration is in power, hole up in the White House and in government agencies like rats in a corn bin.

Individually they get in their dirty work on their victims in personal conversations at social gatherings, through the distribution of innumerable tracts presenting the liberal side of every social and economic subject on earth and through discussions at conferences which take place around the clock. But, collectively, they run a perennial propaganda mill in Washington which constitutes a sort of Political Crime School for instructing members of Congress in the art of peacefully blowing up the American government, wrecking the Constitution and committing mass robbery of the people, all in the name of social reform.

After completing the prescribed course, the Honorable I Will Steele and the honorable Canby Hadd graduate *cum laude* from this Political Crime School and thereafter reflect eternal glory on their alma mater by going forth as fluent advocates of Social Security from the Cradle to the Grave; Public Ownership of Power and Light; Federal Aid to Education; Medical Care for the Aged; unrestricted Foreign Competition with American Industry; repeal of the Connally Amendment; repeal of all State Right-to-Work laws; abolishment of Poverty, Ignorance and Disease in all nations of the world and, finally, the total surrender of American Sovereignty to the United Nations.

By this time their outstanding qualities as progressive American statesmen and their undisputed capacity as potential world leaders has been so impressed on the public mind by liberal newspapers and left-wing columnists that the national chairmen of their respective political parties begin to lay plans to secure their nomination as the two major candidates for President of the United States.

And thus are good plain old country boys who otherwise would have made fair small-town lawyers, accountants or justices of the peace, caught up in the vortex of politics, whisked to Washington and put through the Marxist mill where all honest conviction, respect for the Constitution and loyalty to their own country is squeezed out of them and they are then deemed ready to be catapulted to national and world leadership.

We Don't Have To Worry Any More About Federal Control Of Schools

It now appears that disturbed Americans can quit worrying about the Federal government taking over the nation's educational system which has been a major threat for many years.

Yes, they can relax and take it easy.

UNESCO is planning to take it over instead.

When it became evident recently that the bills in Congress authorizing Federal Aid to Education—and thereby assuring that Washington would take over the nation's class rooms—were meeting with such widespread opposition that there was serious doubt of passage, One-Worlders transferred their frantic efforts toward getting the UNESCO Treaty called "Convention Against Discrimination in Education" ratified by the United States Senate.

Such ratification will mean a short-cut to victory any way for the National Education Association propagandists and other One-World Socialists whose ultimate plans called for UNESCO to be the final recipient of the nation's educational system. It was just to be transferred to the Federal government first but now that won't be necessary. The Red educators will do it the hard way by cutting out the middleman in the form of the Health, Education and Welfare Department which had hoped to have a whack at the job of running the nation's schools before they were turned over to world supervision.

The American people are indebted to Florence Fowler Lyons of California for doing a magnificent job of research on the subject and pointing up the forces who are behind UNESCO in its fight for the school systems not only of the United States but for those of all nations of the world.

The Treaty which is now before the United States Senate for ratification was written by delegates from the Communist countries of Bulgaria, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland, Bylorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic and the Union of Soviet Nationalist Republics, Miss Fowler has revealed.

Two different versions of the Treaty have been submitted to the Senate and of this clever ruse to remove education from domestic control and deliver it into the international UNESCO jurisdiction, Miss Fowler says: "The diabolically clever UNESCO Communists and the Soviet agents and pinkos in the State Department have provided a neat trap for the U.S. Senate . . . They have drafted two identical documents; one they label 'Convention Against Discrimination in Education' and the other is called 'Recommendations Against Discrimination in Education.' The end effect will be identical with the ratification of either version . . . In other words the trick is to get one version or the other approved . . . and then rely on the World Court (which is written into both) to make the decision at the proper moment that the United States, by its approval of the 'Recommendation' is as legally

obligated as if the 'Convention' itself had been ratified."

On March 20, 1957 when the matter of appropriating \$491,800 to finance the investigation and screening of United States citizens for employment in international organizations, was before Congress, the Hon. H. R. Gross of Iowa, made the following statements which were printed in the Congressional Record of that date:

"In the November 1956 issue of the United Nations Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization's publication, entitled 'UNESCO Chronicle,' there is an interesting bit of information under the heading of staff appointments. I am quoting now from this publication:

"Mrs. A. Jegalova (Union of Soviet Socialist Republics), who was formerly Chief of the Inspection Division in the Soviet Ministry of Education and more recently Chief of the Division of International Literature in the Publishing House of Foreign Literature, Moscow, has been appointed Chief of the Secondary Education Division (of UNESCO.)"

"In considering the implications of a Communist occupying such an important position, bear in mind that UNESCO is the organization which has referred in its "educational" publications to children "breathing the poisoned air of nationalism," and has called for children to be educated "to prepare themselves for citizenship in a world society."

"Then in the December 1956 issue of UNESCO Chronicle there is the following:

"UNESCO gave financial and technical assistance to the Yugoslav (Communist) National Commission for the organization of an international seminar on the economic education of workers."

"Among the countries represented at the seminar was Red China.

"The United States each year pays almost one-third of UNESCO's operating costs, and the above-quoted items are submitted as examples of who and what we support with American taxpayers' dollars.

"Here we are spending a half million dollars to investigate United States citizens who seek employment in international organizations, including the United Nations and UNESCO, and yet, sitting over those people in UNESCO is a Communist from Moscow, Russia. How stupid can we get?"

Any way, we can stop worrying about Washington taking over our schools and educational institutions.

UNESCO is ready to relieve us of that worry.

Former Governor of Texas Enjoying 'Sweet Revenge'

In Texas people are still talking about the election of John Tower to the United States Senate in the recent election. To most Texans, Mr. Tower's victory in a formerly solid Democratic State is little short of a miracle.

And of course there are many post-mortems discussing the whys and wherefores. Credit for much of the success of the Wichita Falls educator is given to effective, but quiet work on the part of the former governor of Texas, Coke Stevenson. Mr. Stevenson took no conspicuous part in the campaign but is said to have invoked his still formidable support in behalf of the Republican candidate.

For those who have forgotten the story, Governor Stevenson emerged from the election in 1948 as victor in the race for the Senate and was so proclaimed in the press.

But several days after the ballot boxes had been closed, 87 Mexican votes were brought forth after which Mr. Lyndon Johnson was announced as the new senator from the Lone Star State. That all the Mexicans involved were dead and buried and had been for years, was beside the point.

After all, no less a personage than the Honorable Hugo Black of the Supreme Court of the United States, and who was sitting alone on the Court during the vacation period, ruled that Johnson was the winner, thus nullifying an earlier order of a Federal judge in Texas, Whitfield Davidson, who had decided in favor of Stevenson as being the selection of a majority of the "live" voters of the State.

A sidelight on the affair, as announced in the press at the time, was that Harry Truman was in the State and talked personally on the telephone to Hugo Black shortly before Black overruled Judge Davidson.

At any rate, former governor Coke Stevenson is said to be wearing a smug smile of content these days and to feel that he has had sweet revenge at long last.

It is reported that the Democratic party is so split in Congress that the aid to education bill is endangered. We hope it splits right down the middle every time any other such Socialistic legislation comes up for consideration.

Now that legislation has been passed by Congress enabling men to retire at 62 instead of 65, we are led to hope that the day is not far distant when nobody will have to work and everybody will live off of the Federal government.

"The policy of Metro is to get agents who have been trained under them appointed as city managers. These managers then appoint other graduates of 1313 to positions until they have complete control of city government. They pretend to work in the interests of efficiency but what they really do is usurp the powers of the electorate. Like termites, they gnaw and destroy.

"The Bible says: 'Woe unto him who taketh violently a house which he did not build.' Write to your senators and congressmen and protest this legalized robbery."

One of the greatest dangers threatening the American people is the fact that we have leaders in high places who actually think that the Soviet Union is observing the "gentlemen's agreement" on nuclear testing and that the test has been abandoned in that country as it has in the United States. Negro Thugs Attack White Gathering At Kansas City With Baseball Bats

In Kansas City some hundred persons were calmly watching a teen-age baseball game on Friday, June 30th in a public park, according to an AP dispatch.

Suddenly, and out of the blue, three automobiles drove up and a gang of young black bucks jumped out swinging baseball bats and clubs and tore into the crowd scattering the watchers in all directions.

Screaming women cowered or fled and four persons were so badly injured they had to be hospitalized and one was reported in critical condition.

Seven of the thugs were arrested. Their spokesman when asked for an explanation replied: "We

were drinking beer and wine and just decided to go to the ball park and start a fight."

The supervisor of the baseball team, McPherson A. Horner, had to undergo brain surgery as a result of the attack, and public indignation in integrated Kansas City is said to be at a high pitch.

Similar incidents are happening all the time, some of which are reported in the press and some not. These brutal attacks will grow in number and intensity as soft-hearted do-gooders continue to plug for racial mixing which, as any fool should have learned by this time gives the Negro a distorted idea of his importance and his "rights."

Repeal Of Sixteenth Amendment Would Take No Legitimate Income From U.S.

Repeal of the Sixteenth Amendment to the Constitution will eliminate over 700 wasteful Federal corporate activities, release one million government employees; give you more of your own money to spend; abolish triple taxing on goods and services and keep a tight rein on a spendthrift government, says the Organization to Repeal Federal Income Tax, with headquarters at 725 N. Western Avenue in Los Angeles.

The repeal of the Sixteenth Amendment can be done without taking any legitimate income from the government, officials of ORFIT insist and point out that the corporate activities now engaged in by the Federal government are contrary to the Constitution and that tax money used by bureaucrats in trying to run private business is wasted.

Four State legislatures have passed resolutions demanding that Congress submit the Amendment for Repeal of the Sixteenth Amendment to the States for ratification as provided for in the second method for amending the Constitution set forth in that document. These four States are Wyoming, Texas, Nevada and Louisiana and when 32 more States have taken similar action, it becomes mandatory on Congress to submit the amendment for ratification.

Fearful citizens who are concerned for the future of the Republic as a result of the increasing and irresponsible squandering in Washington can render no better service to the Republic than to discuss the matter with members of their legislature and request action at the earliest possible date.

Able-Bodied Men Must Get Out And Hustle Or No Relief Checks

The small city of Newburgh, New York, has come up with a revolutionary idea which is going to be bitterly opposed by social scientists with all the force at their command.

In the future officials of that city will require that all able-bodied men who are on relief must do 40 hours work per week to balance off such relief. If they are capable of working and refuse to do so, there will be no relief money.

Also they are going to cut down on the amount of relief money paid to professional prostitutes who have babies on the side in order to keep steady money coming in.

This is going to be looked upon by professional do-gooders as an infringement on the civil rights of loafers and prostitutes and no doubt the Civil Liberties Union will take a hand in the case and perhaps go to court.

Commenting on the matter the Shreveport Journal said in part:

Now that New York has taken

a lesson from Louisiana and started withholding welfare checks from unwed mothers who continue to have children, it will be interesting to see if the U.S. Department of Health, Welfare and Education becomes enraged.

Last year when Louisiana decided to end some of the "profits" which prostitutes were reaping by becoming mothers, the federal government became so adamant that it threatened to cut off ALL welfare aid to Louisiana — even the pensions for old folks.

It will be interesting also to see if the British press reacts as violently to the crackdown on the motherhood-for-pay prostitutes in New York as it did to those in Louisiana. Remember how the poor, misguided women of England felt so sorry for the starving children in Louisiana that they took up a collection and sent foodstuffs to America? Let's hope that, if any such sympathy movements are revived in England as a result of the New York action, the funds which might be raised will be applied to Britain's debt to America!

Inflammatory Film Causes England To Lambast U.S.

The Columbia Broadcasting Company made a distorted and inflammatory film dealing with the freedom-riders incident in Alabama in which the facts were slanted in favor of the white and black hoodlums who went to the South to incite violence.

Later this film was shown by the British Broadcasting Company in England and together with an earlier showing of Edward R. Murrow's film titled Harvest of Shame, caused the Britishers to launch their usual criticism against the American people.

England has its hands full, according to reports from overseas, with the daily shiploads of Negroes flowing into the tight little isle from its various colonies and former dependents and, also according to these reports, the people of England don't like forced association of the races any better than the American people.

Meantime, what could possibly be the idea of the Columbia Broadcasting Company in mixing into the matter and trying to inspire criticism of the United States by a foreign country?

Isn't there enough bickering as it is and enough lambasting of the United States by foreign countries who don't like anything about us except our money?

"No money shall be drawn from the treasury but in consequence of appropriations made by law," says the Constitution, but according to columnist Raymond Moley, President Kennedy has asked Congress for authority to spend between \$30,000,000,000.00 and \$40,000,000,000.00 through the "back-door" method which means drawing directly on the treasury instead of waiting for Congressional appropriations. Newspapers Join In Misrepresenting The Facts In Texas Political History

Mrs. James E. Ferguson, former Governor of Texas, died at her home in Austin recently. She was Texas' only woman Governor and one of only two in the United States.

Mrs. Ferguson's death was not unexpected as she had been hospitalized much of the time recently, and was 86 years old.

What amazed us in connection with Mrs. Ferguson's death was the misrepresentation concerning her late husband carried in the press and repeated by practically every newspaper and news service in the country, in announcing her death.

The accounts stated that Governor James E. Ferguson was impeached for "fiscal irregularities."

This was definitely not true. There was not a penny of State funds that was not accounted for and the record will so show.

Governor Jim as he was called, was impeached because he ran a foul of crooked political educators at the University of Texas.

Up until his election, appropriation bills for the University had always been approved without

question and although it was generally known that there were many "irregularities" in that institution, no Governor dared take any action because of the political strength of the organized educational forces of the State.

University professors were not the highly organized and formidable subversive force that they are today, but they were perhaps the most powerful political group in the State and they did not hesitate to exercise this power.

When the appropriations bill for the University was passed by the legislature and went to the Governor for signature, he refused to sign it until the names of the dead men who clogged the university's payroll were removed and other irregularities were corrected. The head of the university went to Governor Jim and warned him that if he vetoed the bill, they would "get him".

Governor Jim promptly vetoed the bill and they "got him".

That is the true story of the "fiscal irregularities" to which the newspapers referred in reporting on Mrs. Ferguson's death.

Incompetency And Conformity Will Probably Govern Selection Of Judges

"Good lawyers and good laws are indispensable in any society where there are bad people," says the weekly newspaper the American Adviser, Sapulpa, Oklahoma, editorially, which adds:

"But good laws and good lawyers can do little if judges are incompetent and corrupt. It's no more the function of the judge to make law than it is the umpire in a ball game to make the rules. No man can be at the same time both judge and lawmaker, for if he makes the law there is no issue for him to adjudicate."

The above is a wise, forthright and unassailable statement of fact in outlining American judicial policy and the words of this editor should be pondered long and seriously.

For the President of the United States is now appointing some seventy or more Federal judges in keeping with a law which has been passed by Congress.

And any one who thinks that in the selection of these Federal judges, the President is going to steer clear of "incompetency and corruption" and choose only men of learning, or legal probity and established qualifications in jurisprudence, is too naive and gullible to be allowed to cross the street alone.

We are glad that way back there when the State Department officials were wining and dining Castro in Washington and saying he was the George Washington of Cuba and all such claptrap, we published the truth about him—that he was a Communist tool.

The President is supposed to appoint both Republicans and Democrats as judges but since there is no longer any Republican or Democratic party, this means he will select seventy Socialists whom he regards as being in accord with his own ideological views. No unbiased and ethical judge will even be considered in all probability.

In the case of so-called Democrats his yardstick will be how zealously the potential appointee supported the New Frontier last November and in the case of so-called Republicans, the test required will be that such appointee is a "Moderate" Republican which means that he is a New Dealer but afraid to say so.

Also any men he will appoint will, of course, be imbued with the idea that the office of Federal judge carries with it the authority to legislate since this precedent has been set by the small-bore politicians on the Supreme Court who snatched this power from Congress and got away with it.

In other words, the Federal judiciary will not be lifted or exalted by the appointment of a slue of new judges. We will probably have seventy or more characters qualified as police court judges sitting on Federal benches.

Utah Senator Introduces Resolution To Put An End To 'Backdoor Spending'

Senator Wallace F. Bennett of Utah has introduced a resolution in the United States Senate which would put an end to "backdoor spending" and would require Senate Appropriations Committee approval of any spending proposal, including those which are currently financed directly from the Treasury.

This "backdoor spending" is a means by which Washington politicians can reach directly into the till without going through the process required by the Constitution which says that no money shall be spent except that appropriated by Congress. In other words, it is a short-cut to thievery of the taxpayers' money and one which has proved very effective in the perennial race of the spenders to see how quickly they can bankrupt the Federal Treasury as per instructions of Lenin and Marx.

Like almost everything else that is evil and subversive in Washington this "backdoor spending" deal was instituted during Franklin D. Roosevelt's administration when the RFC was given a key to the Treasury's back door. However, the practice has not only been continued by succeeding administrations, but has been enlarged upon, and \$140,000,000,000.00 has been filched from the taxpayers in this underhanded manner.

Of course the primary purpose of this method of financing is to carry on the wild spending sprees with a minimum of publicity and keep taxpayers in the dark as to what is being done with their money. When the Constitutional procedure is observed and money is spent only through appropriation by Congress, the people more or less are informed through the press which reports on the action by the

The Fort Worth Star-Telegram says that "The country will be healthier politically if it has a chance at election time to choose between a conservative party and a liberal party" which is true but there are two factors which will probably prevent this happy choice being extended the American electorate. One is because Southern Conservatives in the Democratic party act like liberals at Convention time and agree to a Marxist platform. The other is because "Modern Republicans" gang up at convention time and insist on a platform which practically duplicates the Marxist planks of the Democrats. And so we drift along with two National Socialist parties.

Statesmanship in action. During the consideration of the Socialistic housing bill last month the Senate, at one point, voted to throw out the whole program by a vote of 49 to 44, but after a 13 1/2 hours continuous session, the thing was finally passed by a 49 to 44 vote, an exact reversal. It is not known, of course, what back stage pressure, in the nature of promises or threats, was used against the solons but that is what happened according to press reports.

Appropriations Committee. But when the spenders have a private pipe line to the Treasury and can raid it at will, embarrassing publicity is avoided.

It goes without saying that all the programs financed through this method have no proper place in a Constitutional Government and would be declared unconstitutional if we had a Supreme Court which concerned itself with interpreting the Constitution instead of devoting its time to the promotion of sociological program.

Among the programs financed by "backdoor spending" are the Depressed Areas legislation which authorized the administrator of that program to take \$300,000,000.00 directly from the Treasury after bypassing Congress. The Public Housing program is also financed in this way as are many others and President Kennedy has asked that the Foreign Aid Program be given authority to use the key to the back door of the Treasury in robbing American taxpayers for the benefit of foreign beggars.

A similar resolution has been introduced in the House by Congressman Thomas M. Pelly of Washington State, but it was blocked by the stacked House Rules Committee by a vote of six to eight.

The resolution by Senator Bennett will probably meet the same fate unless there is widespread interest in keeping the dirty cotton-pickin' hands of thieving politicians from reaching directly into the public till and this interest is manifested by direct communication with members of the Senate by their constituents.

Senator Bennett's resolution is Res. 155.

Congressman George H. Mahon of Texas speaking of the condition of the Federal treasury said that this country has reached the point where it has no money and added that a taxpayer in the same predicament would know he had "insufficient funds" in his bank account to pay his bills.

President Lauds Late Author As One Of World's Greatest Men

Ernest Hemingway whose recent death is mourned by legions of his admirers was able to build a successful writing career on the depravity of human nature. His books were filled with slime, filth and obscenity and, in keeping with current morals, they became best sellers which brought him distinguished prizes and awards.

On his death, President Kennedy eulogized him as "one of the greatest citizens of the world" who had "almost singlehandedly transformed the literature and the ways of thought of men and women in every country of the world," and declared that he had "brought renown to America."

Hemingway went as a correspondent to the Spanish Civil War and because of his sympathy for the Communists in that conflict, the *Daily Worker*, official Communist publication in the United States carried an article on January 11, 1941, page 7 concerning him. This article stated that a number of the veterans of the Spanish Civil War, being angered at the picture of the Spanish Civil War presented by Ernest Hemingway in his latest book, *For Whom the*

Bell Tolls, had announced their intention of speaking from the floor at a symposium of the book which was to be held at 50 East 13th Street, headquarters of the Communist Party, U.S.A., under the auspices of the Workers School.

In October 1941, Hemingway, with Lillian Hellman, headed a committee of sponsors for a dinner-forum for Communist refugees at the Hotel Biltmore in New York. Governor Herbert H. Lehman revoked his sponsorship of the dinner-forum when he learned that many of the sponsors had been connected with Communist activities. (Page 234, Fourth Report, *Un-American Activities in California*).

These remarks are not intended to cast discredit on the late author because he was very proud of his ideological beliefs and expounded them fully and frankly but is merely meant to show that contempt for Americanism and American institutions is no bar to one seeking to achieve fame in the United States.

Constitutional Rights Of Nearly Two Centuries To Be Discarded

Discussing the creation by Executive Order of the United States Disarmament Administration, an agency which has been described as "the propaganda arm of the State Department" and whose objective is claimed to be to bring about "international security with an international police force," the June, 1961 edition of the *New Age*, a Masonic publication, said editorially in part:

A so-called "briefing session," in reality part of an indoctrination course in internationalism, was reported to have been held at the State Department on March 23, 1961, at which about 75 persons representing non-governmental groups attended upon invitation. Those attending were admonished to work for a permanent disarmament organization through legislative process. Among these groups were the United World Federalists, Americans for Democratic Action, Women's International League for Peace, American Association for the United Nations, Federation of American Scientists, Twentieth Century Fund, United Automobile Workers, and the General Federation of Women's Groups. It was specifically stated that admission to this session was refused to certain conservative patriotic groups. The Deputy Director of the Disarmament Administration, E. A. Gullion, was in charge assisted by other State Department employees.

It is highly important for our people to know that this group of paid government officials with \$400,000 of the State Department funds immediately in hand is asking for an additional \$600,000 from Congress for the purpose of expediting the substituting for our present constitutional republican form of government a world government that could succeed only in shackling us to a totalitarian tyranny. It is worth noting that Mr. Gullion explained that "it was difficult to work under the 18th century Constitution."

It should also be remembered that State Department officials are known to favor abandonment of the Connally Reservation, a step that would place this nation completely in the power of communism by way of the International Court, an arm of the United Nations.

Mr. Gullion's alleged further statement that the Disarmament Administration must not be responsible to the Congress or to the White House, but only to the Secretary of State demands critical analysis for its implicit content. Here seems to be clearly outlined a plan for the unhampered acquisition of governmental control by non-elected officials in no way responsible for their actions, either directly or indirectly, to the electorate.

It could mean only the eventual complete suspension of all our constitutional rights as we have known and understood them for nearly two centuries.

It is equally important to know that patriotic groups having the national interest at heart were not only not asked to attend this meeting but were virtually prohibited from doing so. It would seem to be quite obvious that these officials hope to accomplish unobserved a purpose they could not undertake openly.

Public Law No. 85-474 of the 85th Congress, as amended, forbids the use of public tax funds for the purpose of advancing the cause of world government. These "briefing sessions" are reported to have been carried on for years by the Department with no newspaper publicity and almost no invitations have been offered to strongly conservative patriotic organizations. Those who have regard for their own freedom and in the maintenance unimpaired of our national sovereignty should ask their elected representatives in Congress what they can and will do about this new threat to our liberty.

Almost every user of a postage meter has a plate with some sort of wordage devised by the lessee of the machine. In Mr. Heinsohn's case, the plate used by his Cherokee Mills reads as follows:

"This is a Republic, not a democracy — let's keep it that way! Cherokee Textile Mills."

Pitney-Bowes' reason for demanding return of the plate and cessation of the use of it by Lessee Heinsohn is the claim that the slogan is "controversial." The leasing corporation wants the addition of the phrase "Advertisement By Mailer."

Mr. Heinsohn has declined to exchange his present meter plate for the one with the amended wording as suggested by Pitney-Bowes.

Aside from the fact that the sentence or exhortation of the Heinsohn plate, as it now stands, has the full support of the federal Constitution, it seems to us that the meter manufacturer in this whole controversy is assuming power of censorship completely without justification. We agree with Mr. Heinsohn for once of a few times in our lives, that when he leases a postage meter, provides the envelopes and

University of Texas Faculty Goes All Out For Red Pitch

When the Kremlin first started the campaign in the United States for integration of schools in the South, their agents were instructed to say that the movement was only to help Negroes get an education.

They soft-pedaled any suggestion of social mixing beyond that necessary during class hours. This was done, of course, to soften up opposition to integration and to bring in line those who would have retreated in horror at the suggestion that the races mingle at social functions.

But as the program has advanced the Reds have gotten bolder and all pretense that integration is merely to provide an opportunity to get an education has been discarded.

They want mixing all down the line and they do mean ALL down the line.

A forceful example is the University of Texas whose faculty recently adopted a resolution calling for the admission of Negro students to "extracurricular activities" at the University. "A great university is not limited to formal instruction," said the sociology professor who submitted the resolution, "but includes dormitory bull sessions, the playing field and the concert hall."

The professor was proceeding exactly according to schedule — inch up a little at a time so the impact on decent people will be gradual and the shock value of the movement will be lessened.

Then, according to plan, the time will come when the objective of integration is accomplished and Southern universities will have the ennobling experience of seeing black men and white girls strolling arm in arm around the campus, and vice versa.

When, and if, that time comes it will mean that we are completely instead of only partially taken over by the Soviets, but this could be averted if the management of certain Southern schools and universities were cleansed of the subversives now directing them and decent, responsible and representative educators put in their place.

Members of the Governors Conference apparently had a high old time at their Convention in Honolulu what with flitting around in aloha shirts "that would shame a rainbow" as one reporter put it, being kissed by half caste island girls, eating poi with their fingers and drinking potent concoctions served by their hospitable hosts. Potsdam; will they tell their students of Harry Hopkins' betrayal of this country to the Communists by providing them with the formula for secret weapons intended to protect us from the Soviets; will they tell them of our State Department's betrayal of China into the hands of Communists; of the Supreme Court's surrender to Swedish Communist Gunnar Myrdal's demand that they hand down rulings which knock out the Rights of States and shatter customs, practices and traditions which have prevailed in the United States for almost a hundred years in order "to cause strife and confusion between the races and make them ripe for Communist take-over; will these Red teachers explain all this and scores of other cases of betrayal of the American people to the Communists in order that the students may actually get the true picture of the menace of Communism? If the schools and colleges in the United States will do this, Communism will automatically be discredited, a new generation of Americans will be salvaged and Communism will cease to flourish in the American Republic as it has done for the past quarter century.

There is no more occasion to start teaching Communism in American schools and colleges than there is to teach Fascism, Nazism or any other abominable and perverted ideology and the fact that the leaders of the American Bar Association cannot see this palpable fact is discouraging to patriotic Americans who are determined to stamp out Communism within our borders rather than contribute to its spread.

Newspapers referred to the awarding of the "Lenin Peace Prize" by the Soviet Union upon Fidel Castro as "Today's biggest laugh" but, somehow, we saw nothing funnier in that than in the action of the Freedoms Foundation in this country which recently bestowed the George Washington Honor Medal Award on the National Council of Churches of Christ for allegedly bringing about better understanding of "the American way of life."

One Of The Nation's Greatest Tragedies Occurred In 1952

There was a note of sadness in the visit of General of the Army Douglas MacArthur to the Philippines recently which brought a lump to the throats of the millions of Americans who adore him as the greatest hero in the military history of the United States. His first and only defeat occurred when he ran up against a President who believed that the proper way to fight a war was to lose it.

In Manila, the ovation to the General was overwhelming with the greatest crowds paying tribute to him ever assembled in the history of the islands. The universal acclaim and the cordiality of his welcome served to emphasize the shabby treatment accorded him by a former Captain of the Infantry in this country who happened to have the political power to embarrass the great military genius who outshone him as the sun outshines the tawdry sparkle of an imitation diamond.

This great nation has suffered no greater tragedy since the beginning of the Republic than the fact that General MacArthur was double-crossed out of the nomination for President at Chicago in 1952. His enemies claimed he was too old for the office but even now, nine years later, he is still more vigorous physically and mentally than some of those who were regarded as being highly qualified for the job.

At any rate, we've got a young one at the helm of the Ship of State now.

Youth is in the saddle and we shall see what will happen.

Spenders Raise The Debt Ceiling Again

Instead of making an effort to reduce the national debt, the Kennedy administration asked Congress to again raise the legal debt limit, this time to \$298,000,000,000.00.

Out of a membership in the House of 437, only 148 voted against the proposal to up the debt ceiling.

Most of the opposing votes were cast by Republicans although Democratic Congressman Clarence Cannon of Missouri joined in warning his colleagues of this repeated refusal to face the situation realistically and begin plans for retirement of the national debt which is now the highest in all history and more than that owed by all other countries in the world combined.

In selecting his staff and all the personnel involved in running the government, we hope that the next President of the United States chooses only men and women who have worked their way through college. In this event, they will not have had time to stuff their heads with Socialism and will perhaps have some measure of common sense. By that time, however, we may already have gone over the brink to total oblivion because of the fact that educated fools have ruined a Constitutional Republic.

If Only He Had Practiced What He Is Now Preaching

The Honorable Dwight D. Eisenhower is fast becoming one of the best Presidents the United States ever had and if the members of Congress would only take his advice this nation would soon be back on the road to Constitutional Government again.

The only trouble is that he waited until he was out of office to show what a good President he could be. When he was in the White House he performed almost the opposite of what he is now claiming is the proper way to administer the American government.

In every speech he makes he dwells on economy in government to an extent that is laughable when it is remembered how he advocated foreign aid "on a permanent basis" while still President, Federal Aid to Education, and all the other Socialistic measures which Mr. Kennedy is now pushing with equal vigor.

His criticism of the new President's squandering policies and his suggestion that Kennedy preserve the rights of States and freedom of the individual come with poor grace with one who forgot these rights and freedoms while he was still in position to do something about it.

We hold no brief for Mr. Kennedy certainly and have no doubt that before he is through with the job, he will excel Eisenhower's record for squandering and for violating the rights of States, since each President of the United States seems destined to become progressively worse along this line.

But at least so far, Kennedy, while he sent U.S. Marshals into Alabama, has not yet ordered out the militia to jab bayonets into the backs of peaceable citizens defending their schools. Neither has he invited Khrushchev so far, to come to the United States and insult the American people on their home base.

In short, President Eisenhower is fast becoming the Conservative, sound-thinker that the majority of American voters thought he was when they elected him President in 1952.

The President continues to lay stress on the fact that one of his principal objectives during his tenure of office is to "abolish poverty throughout the world." This is a noble and altruistic program but we wish he would begin it right here at home and quit sending recommendations to Congress which, if enacted into law, will eventually make paupers out of the taxpayers of the United States. There is not much percentage in banishing poverty in the rest of the world, at the same time, planning the impoverishment of the people of his own country.

There is a strong conviction in many areas that the bearing down on business concerns under the guise of the anti-trust law—from which labor unions are exempt—is merely another facet of the conspiracy to abolish American free enterprise and hasten World Socialism.

Texas Solon Praised As Outstanding Example Of American Statesmanship

Words of such extravagant praise as are seldom showered on a public official were heard in both the House and Senate on June 12 when Democrats and Republicans alike joined in tribute to Mr. Sam Rayburn for "his 58 years of public service."

But politics being what it is, it is equally certain that there are a few million others around over the State who are a mite skeptical that he possesses all the abilities of pure and undiluted statesmanship attributed to him.

On occasions like this, we are reminded of the following story which is so old it has whiskers a foot long but which is always applicable to any of us mortals when we are inclined to take at face value the appraisal of our friends and associates who, for this reason or that, may be slightly biased in our favor:

There was a notorious town bum who hadn't done a lick of work in years; who beat his wife and forced her to take in washing to support the family; who cheated his pals in card games and who had been known to sneak out in the early morning hours and steal the milk on his neighbor's front porch.

Finally he became ill and died.

There was a new preacher in town who knew none of these things and who was called on to preach the funeral. Wishing to make a good impression in his new job, the preacher pulled out all the stops and went to town in his eulogy of the departed townsman. He told of the devotion of the late lamented for his family; of his activities as a model citizen and held him up as an exalted example of a life dedicated to the betterment of his community, his state and the nation.

When his encomiums had reached a pitch where caution was thrown overboard and only superlatives were employed to describe the manifold virtues of the deceased, the bedraggled widow sitting quietly with her brood of seven children reached over and whispered to her oldest boy: "Son go up and take a peek in that there coffin and make sure it's your pa he's talkin' about."
