What they should do is to run their own errands and hire somebody to do their thinking.

The State of the Union would be vastly improved if they spent all their waking hours visiting government agencies and if they are relieved of this angle of the job, only the good Lord knows what legislative devilment they will hatch up in their spare time.

We hope the bill is defeated and that they have to keep doing their own errands.

As long as they are on the run they won't be voting for some fool project thought up by International Communists to put the American Republic out of the picture.

We thought that everything that could be said on the subject had been said when the Adams case involving the payment of a \$2200 hotel bill by Mr. Bernard Goldfine, was aired by the Harris sub-Committee of the House.

But no sooner had these revelations begun to lose their shock value when the Associated Press dug up and broke out on the front pages of the nation's newspapers a story to the effect that in 1952 presidential candidate Dwight D. Eisenhower and his staff ran up a \$4,000 hotel bill for an overnight stay at the swanky Roney Plaza in Miami and then skipped town without settling the account.

The Tampa Tribune, according to the A.P. release, went on a sleuthing expedition to find out if the account had ever been paid but secrecy was clamped down and everybody, including the auditor of the Roney Plaza at the time, stood

on their Constitutional rights and refused to give.

We can remember in our childhood when some stranded "drummer," as all travelling salesmen were then called, would treat the village hotel keeper in a similar manner.

it and in keeping with this precept, we present a few notable instances herein which would seem to indicate that our policies of government and official actions have not only not been in opposition to Communism but have aided in giving it a strangle-hold in this country and throughout the world.

Perhaps the most colossal act of collaboration with Communists of which this country has been guilty was the selling out of the great friendly Republic of China to the Soviets by the American State Department in a manner described by one of the attaches in that agency as permitting China to fall to the Communists "without letting it be known that she was pushed."

Crowding that incident for first place in infamy was the withholding of American troops and preventing them from entering Germany at the close of World War II when the beaten armies of that defeated country were denied their request to surrender to American forces and the Communists permitted to rush in and indulge in the most dastardly orgy of rape, murder and plunder ever recorded in the annals of human warfare.

This miserable concession gave Eastern Europe to the Soviets and entrenched them so firmly in the Balkans that they were able to reach out and draw a score of helpless countries behind the Iron Curtain and to build up the tragic conditions which today threaten war to all the civilized world.

At Yalta, with an American Soviet agent at his elbow, an American President, overawed and outwitted by Stalin's clever and scheming brain, calmly agreed to plans which were to develop into the sell-out of practically all Asia to the Communists and give them a foothold there comparable to the one which was given them in Europe when American generals held back our troops and allowed the Soviets to rush into Berlin.

At Potsdam, another American President, outclassed and out-thought at every turn by Stalin, agreed that the independent nation of Korea would be divided and the Communists given the Northern half. This was in July, 1945 and one month later Communists troops swarmed into that country occupying 48,460 square miles of territory with a population of 9,000,000 people. In June of 1950 the Communist troops of North Korea invaded South Korea in what, for face-saving and diplomatic reasons was to be termed "Police Action" but which was to rank with the bloodiest wars in history.

On July 7, the President ordered United States troops into South Korea under the command of General Douglas MacArthur. At the same time, the President ordered the Seventh Fleet into Formosa to keep General Chiang Kai-Shek's forces from invading the mainland of China although it is widely believed in military circles that if the President had not interfered in behalf of Communist China and had allowed Chiang's Nationalist army to invade the mainland, the Chinese people would have risen in revolt against the Communists, Communism in Asia would have been stopped cold and thousands of American and South Korean lives would have been saved.

When General MacArthur had the North Koreans on the run, he was suddenly ordered to halt his forces at the Yalu River instead of pursuing the enemy and wiping out the North Koreans. This retreating action was on orders from the Commander-in-Chief in Washington—at least

the orders were delivered by him but there are several schools of thought concerning who originally issued them. We did not win the war, the South Koreans did not win and Red China was saved by the sending of the Seventh Fleet to Formosa.

At Geneva, still another American President, broke bread with and toasted in vodka and champagne the atheistic assassins of the Kremlin who had cold-bloodedly murdered millions of Christians, to the despair and heartbreak of the slaves in Satellite countries who had looked to the United States to deliver them from the serfdom imposed by brutal Soviet masters. In addition, he made a strong plea to the United Nations for a world plan of sharing the atomic secrets of this country with all other nations including Russia.

When the oppressed slaves of Hungary made a valiant attempt to regain their freedom which would have succeeded with any show of sympathy and assistance from professed opponents of Communism, the United States' part in protest began and ended with a soft note to the Soviets signed jointly with other members of a Communist-dominated United Nations.

When the Soviet monsters murdered Imre Nagy and three other Hungarian fighters we went through the same silly performance of writing a note and then sent our diplomats to Geneva, as if nothing had happened, to "confer" with Moscow gangsters concerning the possibility of stopping our own nuclear tests although we know full well that no such agreements by the Soviets will be kept.

Similar inexplicable actions on the part of leaders of a free Republic officially on record as opposed to Communist aggression but who, in reality, have helped to elevate International Communism to its status as perhaps the world's strongest power could be cited indefinitely but these few cases are enough to inspire deep foreboding and make the blood run cold.

To all this, add the fact that there are hundreds of alleged respectable organizations composed of men and women in high position who are promoting the Communist line as faithfully as though they were party members, together with thousands of free-lance traitors who operate in every sphere of human activity in this country and we have an amazing picture of unified and coordinated subversion which brings a chill of horror to the hearts of staunch Americans who fear for the survival of the Republic.

It could be that we and millions like us are in the minority in rejecting the premise that abject slavery is preferable to human freedom as a way of life but we and all other patriotic Americans will live and die in the firm and unswerving conviction that the American form of government based on Christian principles and human dignity is as near an invincible governing instrument as mortal mind can devise.

To us, there is no alternative, no substitute and no compromise.

At any rate, the sands in the hour-glass of time are running low and the day has come for God-fearing and patriotic Americans to take action which will determine what their heritage to posterity will be and whether their children will live in the reflected glow from the bright light of human liberty or have their dreams clouded with fear of concentration camps and secret police and dwell in eternal dread of a gentle tap on their door at midnight.

Racial Mixers Get Their First Major Set-Back

The first major retreat of integration forces from the Little Rock battleground occurred recently when a Federal judge ruled that racial mixing in the schools there will be postponed until September of 1961.

The Little Rock school board, which found itself unable to cope with the situation at Central High School last year, even with the aid of Federal troops and the Arkansas National Guard, had petitioned the Court for a ruling to this effect and members of the board were reported as highly elated at the outcome.

Back of the action taken by United States District Judge Harry J. Lemley, who handed down the decision, is reported to be a dawning realization on the part of white integration advocates that they have made a ghastly mistake in trying to force Soviet racial policies on the citizens of a free Republic.

Memories of hard-boiled soldiers pressing bayonets into the backs of white students and of an American public school system being dominated by an arrogant Negro woman with an alleged police record are proving hard to erase and it is believed that the sovereign State of Arkansas has heard the last of the degrading subject of racial mixing in the schools.

Of course when a Federal Judge makes a decision in keeping with the American Constitution, a rarity in these days of Modern Republicanism, there are naturally many rumors born of the incident.

One is that the President will hope that there will be no dissent from the Arkansas Judge's ruling on the part of the Supreme Court and that the matter will rest where it is. It takes the President off the hot seat.

After all, \$410,333.33 per Negro is a pretty stiff price for even the free-spending Eisenhower administration to pay for tuition for the colored students of Little Rock.

Also a retreat on the part of the administration at this time in the matter of integration might be interpreted by some of the President's advisers as a tactic which could ameliorate some of the intense bitterness against the Republicans on the part of the people of the South for the passage of Civil Rights legislation and for the administration's mongrelization policies generally.

The worst traitor yet is one who gets himself elected to office as a Conservative and then double-crosses those who elected him by throwing in with the Reds. We have far more respect for a left-winger who remains true to his convictions regardless of how wrong such convictions may be. A turncoat inspires the contempt of both sides.

Senator Lyndon Johnson of Texas says that there is great need for legislation which will get this country into outer space as soon as possible. What the senator does not realize is that we are already up in the air and have been for twenty-five years. What we need is to get back on solid ground once more.

Who Cares What Communists Think About Music Or Anything Else?

We could never understand why the young East Texas musician, Van Cliburn, had his head so completely turned because the Bolsheviks flattered and applauded his playing when he appeared in Moscow last Spring.

This month, Leopold Stokowski, symphony orchestra conductor in this country, also gave a concert in the Russian capital and, following the performance, gave out an interview in which he practically raved and tore his hair, if any, over the Communists.

"I want to say how much I like the Soviet people," he told the press. "They understand through their hearts. Most people understand through their heads but this is deeper, more fundamental." He added that the Soviet public is "just wonderful."

It was easy to understand Stokowski's partiality to the Soviets. He not only was a resident of Leningrad for a time but appears

to be extremely sympathetic to Communist ideologies.

According to Appendix IX of the Dies Committee Reports, Stokowski has been cited as a member of the National Council of American-Soviet Friendship (page 1202); also as having been affiliated with the American Committee for Struggle Against War (page 409) and listed as vice president of American Society for Cultural Relations with Russia. All of the above outfits are cited as Communist Fronts in the same report.

Also, back in 1934 the American Legion protested bitterly against his playing the Communist Internationale at the Philadelphia Symphony Orchestra concert, according to the Chicago Tribune of January 26, 1934.

Stokowski is permanent part-time conductor of the Houston Symphony Orchestra and is gushed and goosed over by many persons there as if he were the most dedicated American and patriotic citizen alive.

Time To Bury Sherman Adams Affair In The Graveyard Of Dead Scandals

We think that the subcommittee of the House of which Congressman Oren Harris of Arkansas is chairman would do well to drop the investigation into the affairs of Mr. Sherman Adams since the Democrats have proved their point.

The point is that there is essentially no difference in the two major parties, when the chips are down, and that the leaders of both perform with complete fidelity to the same pattern, both in their official actions and private conduct.

We have hammered a way for years on the thesis that there is not one particle of difference in the party policies of Modern Republicans and Fair Deal Democrats since both are committed to International Socialism and now it has been disclosed that there is no distinction in the measure of corruption which prevails in the inner ranks of both parties.

The only difference between them is the difference between a mink and a vicuna coat.

It stands to reason that men who have repeatedly been guilty of acting against the best interests of their own country and who have demonstrated time and again their vulnerability to Communist propaganda are of a moral and ethical stature which would make influence peddling come as natural to them, and to their associates, as the rising of the sun in the East.

Men of impeccable character and statesmanlike attainments and who are possessed of the attributes of honesty and personal integrity simply do not connive with conspira-

tors against their country to plunge the nation of their birth toward the abyss of bankruptcy, place an unbearable burden of debt on unborn generations or weaken the Republic's financial structure by robbing the people of their substance.

Under the barometer which measures human weakness and mortal error, peddling personal influence is a minor misdemeanor in comparison with the monumental betrayal of trust and of the people of the United States of which the officials of the three branches of government have been guilty for the past quarter of a century.

The effective, dignified and constructive way out of the whole mire of corruption which engulfs both major political parties is for the American people to clean up the intolerable mess in both.

This can be done by the selection of candidates for office at the lowest level who are honest, working on up to those to the national conventions with the objective of gaining nominees for President on both tickets whom decent Americans can support without holding their nose.

It is not enough to be forced to continue to select the least of two evils in choosing a candidate for the exalted post of President of the United States.

The Citizens of this Republic are entitled to a choice between two candidates of such ingrained incorruptibility that they will refuse to surround themselves with a staff which is unable to resist the tender of a mink coat or an Oriental rug.

If we still had Constitutional Government in this country, we would have no fear of Communism or any other kind of "ism" and we could return to Americanism again.

Indonesian Reds "Took" Us For \$122,000,000.00

President Sukarno is the Red Dictator of Indonesia who, with American help and money, beat into submission the anti-Communist forces there who tried to wrest their government back from the Kremlin partisans but were unsuccessful.

In June, 1956, Sukarno visited Washington for the purpose which underlies the visits of all foreign visitors to the American capital—he came for a hand-out, and, of course, got it.

After he had returned to Indonesia from Washington President Eisenhower wrote him a letter, according to an editorial in the Saturday Evening Post, which contained this touching paragraph:

"You have taken something of America with you."

What he has "taken" of America so far, according to the Post, is "\$122,000,000.00 plus the possible delivery of all Southeast Asia to the Communists."

Dallas School Board Rules For Continued Segregation

Another reassuring action in behalf of the law and common sense was that of the Dallas School Board which announced that segregation would continue to prevail in the 1958-59 term.

School board officials took note of the fact that Texas law prevents schools from segregating without an election being held on the subject. Those which integrate without following this procedure would sacrifice state funds for maintenance of public schools.

Integrationists, including the membership of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, have long had their eyes on Dallas where they had hoped to develop another Little Rock and perhaps induce the President to send Federal troops to protect Negro students.

Majority sentiment in Dallas, like that of the rest of the State, is heavily in favor of segregation and the decision of the School Board was heartily approved by the better element of the people of that city.

Federal Judges in Memphis Hand Down Sane Ruling

A three-judge Federal Court in Memphis, Tennessee, rejected firmly a suit filed by the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People for the abolishment of seating arrangement in city buses where segregation of the races is observed.

The suit by the NAACP was filed in the name of a young Negro recently arrived in Memphis and believed brought there for the purpose.

The action by the Federal judges in this case is believed inspired by a growing recognition on the part of authorities of the heavy Negro crime wave which has resulted from Communist agitation for integration of the races and which has given Negroes the impression that they are beyond the law.

When citizens of strife-torn Little Rock asked for and obtained a ruling by a Federal District Judge for a postponement of the disgraceful integration farce in their public schools for two and a half years, Senator Paul Douglas of Illinois is quoted in the press as having said: "I never understood that mob violence took precedence over the law of the United States."

Is that so? Then, obviously, the Senator from Illinois has never heard of labor unions and the manner in which they have operated in defiance of "the law of the United States" for almost a quarter century.

Apparently he has never heard of the Kohler strike in Wisconsin where labor union goons hurled bombs in the windows of homes owned by those whose only crime was that they wanted to work and who mercilessly clobbered men and women alike who dared cross the picket line; and all this with the connivance of men from the Governor on down who looked the other way instead of stepping in and upholding "the law of the United States."

Nor has he been told about the case in Indiana where striking criminals of a labor union shot a six-month old baby in the head as it lay in the cradle because the mother and father dared to defy an order to quit the jobs they both needed in order to live and support their child, while those charged with the duty of upholding "the law of the United States" have taken no action to this day to punish the culprits.

Has the Senator never heard of these and thousands of similar cases where "the law of the United States" meant less than nothing to union mobsters as they crippled, blinded and killed those who got in the way of their murderous plans?

And above all, hasn't the Senator ever heard of members of the Senate and House of the American Congress who swore, on taking office, to defend "the law of the United States" but who have been subsidized by campaign contributions from labor racketeers until they don't dare raise their voice, or vote, for measures which would restrict labor union officials from committing theft, embezzlement and extortion which violate "the law of the United States"?

Perhaps, like the President who recently defined the difference between a "gift and a bribe," the Senator regards the actions of segregationists as "mob violence" and crimes committed by labor union goons as a peaceful protest in defense of their rights.

If the Senator would chisel open his closed mind, he would be able to understand that not many days have passed since the old Wagner Labor Relations Act was passed that "mob violence" has not "taken precedence over the law of the United States."

Such Anti-Communists And Patriotic Americans, Yet

At its annual meeting in Washington May 16-18, Americans for Democratic Action—an outfit which insists until it is blue in the face that it is anti-Communist—called for the immediate diplomatic recognition of Red China, for the immediate cessation of nuclear tests by the United States and for vigorous action by the President and the Congress to end segregation of the races.

Resolutions were also passed which were critical of the McClellan Committee which is exposing theft and corruption in labor unions, condemned the Jenner bill which seeks to prevent the Supreme Court from freeing all convicted Communists and called for a re-examination of the cases of all government employes charged with disloyalty to their country.

If this action is indicative of "anti-Communist" sentiment in the ADA, it makes us shudder to contemplate what they might have demanded if they had been "pro-Communist."

That ADA would try to maintain the fiction that it is "anti-Communist" is perfectly natural as a protection from exposure of its true purposes, but that many Americans would accept this self-evaluation is a sad commentary on their intelligence.

Also, there was one man named Smith—L. M. C. Smith of Philadelphia.

United Nations Maintains Its Unbroken Record Of Failure

All informed Americans have known from the beginning that the United Nations is not worth its salt as an agency for peace, for quelling uprisings and ironing out the trouble spots of the world.

It would seem, however, that its most ardent champions among One-Worlders would be convinced of its utter futility after its abject failure in the recent Hungary situation.

Although they are members of this great "Peace and Humanitarian" organization Soviet Russia and Communist Hungary performed like the barbarians they are when they executed former Hungarian Premier, Imre Nagy and three other leaders of the Hungarian revolt after mock trials in Budapest.

Officials of the American State Department and those of other Western countries made a great hue and cry over the incident and called on the United Nations to do something about it immediately if not sooner.

Mr. Dag Hammerskjold, Director General of the U. N. sent a delegation to Hungary to "protest" the execution and to get information concerning it for further action by the U. N.

Lazlo Gyáros, one of the thugs who acted as official spokesman for the Hungarian government, laughed in the faces of the delegation, insulted them and did everything except order them out of the country. He told them that action by the U. N. in the matter was "interference in the domestic affairs of Hungary" and that he would give them nothing.

There was nothing for the members of the delegation to do but pick up their marbles and go home.

The Hungarian case is typical of the performances of the United Nations since it was set up by Alger Hiss and his associates in the State Department under the supervision of Joe Stalin as a propaganda organization for One-World Government and it will never be any different.

But watch members of Congress shell out and vote appropriations of American taxpayers' money to sustain the rotten thing when it is time to again vote on the matter.

Almost 300 textile mills in the United States have been closed down as a result of the reciprocal trade agreements by which Japan is permitted to send textiles, produced by cheap labor, into this country to compete with domestic workers. Ain't we got statesmanship?

It is claimed by some authorities that Progressive Education whose objective is to reconstruct society along Marxist lines is gradually being eliminated from the textbooks of the American schools but "gradually" is not fast enough if the future generation is to be saved.

White Russian Says Communists Out To Control The Whole World

Rockefellers Are Tripped Up By Their Own Folly

The Messrs. Rockefeller had better get on the beam and put some consistency in the recommendations which they constantly make for the improvement of social, economic and political policies of the United States.

The Rockefeller Brothers who inherited a vast fortune accumulated under the great American Free Enterprise System but are spending it in attempts to make a Socialist State of the American Republic, are forever making "reports" on something or other.

Their latest has to do with education in which they assert that it is wrong to hold back talented students because backward or slow-witted pupils can't keep up with them.

Of course that is true but it is right here that the Rockefellers have slipped a cog and forgotten that they must share the blame, along with an assortment of other rag-tag Liberals and shady left-wingers, for situations in which talented students must be held back because of the inability of dull students to advance as rapidly as they do.

This is the case in all integrated schools because colored students, as a whole, are simply not mentally capable of keeping pace with average white children.

And the Rockefellers have subsidized uncounted numbers of mongrelizers who demanded integration of the races in our public school systems.

The Honorable Archibald B. Roosevelt, by his magnificent work in behalf of American principles, is removing some of the tarnish from the family name.

During the period from 1949-54, following the betrayal of China to the Communists with the aid and assistance of the American State Department, the Red Chinese have, by the admission of Mao himself, liquidated 800,000 citizens of that miserable country. In the eyes of certain characters in this country this should not bar them from being accepted into the United Nations and perhaps they are right. After all, the number of helpless human beings the Soviets have liquidated is over a million and Russia is in the U. N. Bringing Mao's assassins into the outfit would make it just one big happy family of international murderers.

Any parent who does not believe that propaganda begins at the cradle should read some of the modern nursery rhyme books which have been re-vamped and tailored to make One-Worlders, Internationalists and Mongrelizers out of tomorrow's citizens.

Testifying before the House Committee on Un-American Activities on April 7 of this year, Constantin W. Boldyreff, 48-year-old White Russian, and son of a Lieutenant General in the Czarist Army, said in part:

"If there is to be a summit conference, then let us make it a good propaganda show and make sure that it results in a public and crushing disgrace to the Soviet bandits. Unless we are certain that this can be achieved, let us not embark into any negotiations at all. For such negotiations only disorient, embarrass, and bewilder the active anti-Communists behind the Iron Curtain.

"This is not a battle of nations against nations, but of a horrible machine of collectivism against every single living person in the world.

"The goal of the Free World is to preserve peace. The goal of international communism is the extension of Communist control over the whole world without resort to all-out war, if possible. For the Communists, atomic war at this stage with the United States is too risky, besides, the internal situation in Russia and the satellite countries is anything but stable.

"In this present conflict, the main efforts of each of the striving governments are mainly directed to influence individual citizens of the opposing nation over the head of their own government in an attempt to capture their allegiance. This entirely new situation calls for propaganda weapons.

"It is extremely important for Soviet citizens to learn the truth about the West, particularly about this country, to gain assurance that Americans are not their enemies. Our propaganda should be by the people, and for the people, not by bureaucrats to bureaucrats."

Press releases from Washington say that although Justice Felix Frankfurter and Justice Hugo Black of the Supreme Court are eligible for retirement, since the former is 76 and the latter 72, they have no intention of doing so. Both have indicated their intention of hanging on and perhaps it is just as well. While it is difficult to conceive of any one being appointed to the job who would do more damage to Constitutional Government or more effectively help to tarnish the Court's reputation than these two, the present administration would manage to do just that.

The give-away program in which money is taken from American taxpayers and given to Socialist Governments in foreign countries was first called the "Marshall Plan." Its name has been changed several times but the program has now become a permanent arrangement. From this time forward, Americans will be working to support alien people, including the enemies of the United States. Think that over in your spare time!

Court Comes To Bat For Reds Once More

Someday the Supreme Court may inadvertently make a ruling against Communists but so far their batting average has been one hundred per cent in favor of those who are opposed to the American form of government and who regard the Kremlin as a model in governing machinery.

Before going on vacation the high Court granted passports to Negro Paul Robeson and Corliss Lamont, both of whom have been refused passports for years because they refused to answer questions concerning their Communist affiliation.

"A passport cannot be withheld from a person because of his beliefs or associations," the Court held.

Presumably, these two characters are going to Russia to confer with their comrades in Moscow.

Those who yell loudest for "human rights" are the first ones to advocate the Federal government coming into a city, removing families from the slums and "urban renewing" the area. Have those who live in such sections no "human rights"? Are they to be moved around like pawns on a chess board? Maybe they don't want to move to a new location. Have the do-gooders ever thought of that?

When Pericles the ruler of Ancient Athens started giving money and free gifts to the destitute people of that city, his personal popularity was enhanced but the Athenian government perished.

Columnist Would Deny The Right Of Patriots To Express Views

We don't believe it is possible for the average American who makes no attempt to keep himself informed of the network of subversion which is enveloping this country, to understand how thoroughly anti-American sentiment is rampant throughout the nation.

For instance, there are those in important positions who actually dispute the right of American patriots to present their views to the public apparently on the theory that only left-wingers and International Socialists are entitled to be heard.

As an illustration we offer this instance:

The Honorable George W. Malone, one of the few able men who has sat in the United States Senate in recent years, incorporated into a book called "Mainline" all his knowledge and endless research on the disastrous effect of our foreign economic policies on American industry. This book was published by Long House of New Canaan, Connecticut, and the first edition was exhausted within weeks of its appearance.

Some sponsor, realizing that there was much that members of Congress do not understand on the subject of economics, presented each member of both Houses with a copy of Mainline.

Whereupon the ubiquitous Drew Pearson who has the dubious distinction of having been called

names which reflect on his ancestry so often that he has apparently come to accept the designation as authentic, charged in his column that this was an "anonymous" distribution of literature to influence members of Congress to vote against the Reciprocal Trade Agreement.

"The identity of the persons or organization mailing out this expensive book remains a secret," Pearson wrote. "Some one is putting up the money — not Malone."

What does it matter who put up the money to distribute a valuable document to members of Congress who prove almost daily their woeeful ignorance of the principles of a sound economy?

Tons of literature is distributed to members of Congress during each session by the National Education Association, Ford Fund for the Republic, Committee for an Effective Congress, Americans for Democratic Action, National Council of Churches, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, CIO-AFL and scores of other Socialist groups opposed to the American form of government and there is not a chirp out of Pearson. But let a sound, American document make its appearance and he throws a hissy.

Have we actually come to the point where the champions of Americanism are denied the right to speak their mind?

The answer is YES.

"A VICE BECOMES A VIRTUE"

(St. Petersburg, Florida, Independent)

Our social planners who insist that the way to bring about racial integration in schools, housing and other fields is to adopt a policy of "color blindness"—that is to insist that there is no such thing as racial consciousness—will find little support for the theory in a recent report by the Citizens' Housing and Planning Council of New York.

A great effort has been made in New York City to force racial integration in housing. Using the lever of federal aid, New York officials have forced the integration of public housing facilities. Some have gone further by supporting a proposed ordinance to make it illegal for the owner of private housing to refuse to rent facilities because of racial or religious grounds.

The Council's report, however, indicates that the "color blind" policy is not working out. Integration is being defeated because white families are moving out of public housing projects.

Two housing projects were cited to show the change in occupancy. One opened in Brooklyn in 1939. At the time the racial composition was 98.7 per cent white and 1.3 per cent Negro. But as of Dec. 31 of last year, it had changed to 32.6 per cent white, 50.2 per cent Negro, and 17.2 per cent Puerto Rican.

A second housing project in the Bronx was tenanted in 1953. At that time the occupancy was 65.6 per cent white, 25.2 per cent Negro, and 9.2 per cent Puerto Rican. By the end of last year this had changed to 49.5 per cent white, 36.5 per cent Negro, and 15 per cent Puerto Rican.

The Council while noting that the policy "was in the purest sense non-discriminatory" has failed to halt "a marked trend towards decrease in occupancy by white families in all projects."

Now in an effort to insure a more even ratio among the races in public housing, the Council proposes that the "color blind" policy be abandoned. In its place they would substitute the practice of carefully selecting tenants to maintain a desirable ratio of the races.

What this means, of course, is that prospective Negro and Puerto Rican tenants would be turned away in favor of white families who might be willing to live in integrated housing.

In other words racial discrimination, which the Council so righteously opposes, seems to become a virtue when practiced in the holy name of racial integration.

This, we are supposed to believe, makes good sense.

100,000 Group Meetings Would Get The Job Done

If there is any way to save the American Republic from the claws of International Communism, we believe that it is through small group meetings of interested citizens which are being held with increasing frequency and with enlarged attendance in many sections of the country. *

Usually these groups meet in the homes of informed Americans who seek to make those in attendance thoroughly familiar with the important issues on which members of Congress are to vote.

The attendance is usually limited to ten or fifteen and each in turn is asked to hold similar meetings in their home with their neighbors and friends invited and in this way the circle can be extended to unbelievable proportions.

It has been estimated that if 100,000 such meetings were to take place in the homes of American patriots during a year, the political intelligence of the populace would be improved to such an extent that the moral complexion of Congress would be lifted to a level which would preclude the continued domination of that body by left-wingers, One-Worlders and International Communists.

The idea back of the group meetings is that each one who attends them will, in his own way and his own words, communicate with his senators and representative and give them his own reaction to the various measures before Congress.

The American people in their own interest, must never forget that their concern in their representative does not end when they cast a ballot for him and that they must ride herd on him so long as he remains in office.

It is just as unwise to leave a public servant unsupervised as it is to trust a small child alone in the pantry with the jam pot and the cookie jar. A raid will follow in either case.

The course of wisdom is to look upon members of the House and of the Senate as not being quite bright—an assumption which has been confirmed recently by the majority in voting on foreign aid, reciprocal trade extension and the annexation of Alaska—and treat them as you would a retarded child who can't be left alone.

Otherwise the sentinel work is going to be performed by highly organized and well financed subversive groups who are able to take up the vigil in Washington and stay on the job each session until their Communist objectives are achieved.

One thing is for sure, members of Congress are being swayed and influenced by somebody and it had best be by unpaid, patriotic taxpayers who lobby by remote control rather than by such on-the-spot professionals as the National Education Association, National Council of Churches, CIO-AFL, Americans for Democratic Action, National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and a thousand other polygot outfits who are out to do the American Republic in.

As If We Hadn't Heard Enough of New Hampshire

Gordon M. Tiffany of New Hampshire, a protege of Sherman Adams of vicuna coat fame, was named by the President as Director of the Federal Civil Rights Commission.

Since he had never been convicted of a felony nor accused of dope peddling, the Senate confirmed him although what he knows about racial relations in the South, in view of the fact that there are only 731 Negroes in New Hampshire, was not established.

At any rate, this Tiffany individual kept still as a mouse while members of the Commission were assuring Southern members of the Senate that they would only go into voting rights of Negroes.

After he was confirmed, however, Tiffany broke out with a statement in the press to the effect that the Commission would also take up the matter of education and housing, although the legislation setting up the Commission gives them no such authority.

It is increasingly evident that dishonesty which has attended this infamous bill from the time Lyndon Johnson threw in with the enemies of the South and by-passed the Eastland Committee and brought it directly to the Senate floor, will mark its progress at each step of the way.

Like all small men armed with large power, these vest-pocket dictators on the Civil Rights Commission may be expected to do their worst.

As to this Tiffany person, it would be well if he could be given a nice vicuna coat and sent back to New Hampshire.

"HEADS YOU WIN TAILS I LOSE"

It looks like the State of New York is slated to have a millionaire Socialist as governor next time, regardless of which one of the two leading candidates are elected.

Averill Harriman will run for a second term and Nelson Rockefeller has announced that he will make the race against him.

Harriman calls himself a Democrat and Rockefeller likes to think of himself as a Republican, but Harriman is no Democrat and Rockefeller is no Republican.

Both are International Socialists.

Both have rendered yeoman's service to all types of Socialist projects advanced by New Deal, Fair Deal and Modern Republican administrations in Washington and neither has the remotest understanding of the principles of Constitutional Government nor respect for the fundamentals underlying the American Republic.

Both are strong proof of the claim that genius seldom reproduces itself, their fathers and grandfathers having made the vast fortunes which they inherited without effort on their part and which they are spending in the interest of National and International Socialism.

With New York, it looks like it will be a case of "heads you win, tails I lose."

We'd Like To See Him Drawing Unemployment Compensation Too

Since we have no more respect for cheap and tawdry politicians than we have for bums in Skid Row, we got a kick out of one of Westbrook Pegler's recent columns in which he stripped Earl Warren right down to the bare hide.

Going to Sacramento for his information, Pegler revealed some surprising data about the legislating Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and which has heretofore been generally unpublicized.

Warren receives, as a member of the Supreme Court, \$35,000 per year which is the highest salary he ever got in his life, according to Mr. Pegler, but that is only part of it.

The State of California is paying him \$12,101.88 per year in pension because he was once Governor of that State. That still isn't all. Recently Warren's henchmen in California were able to increase the pension which Warren will receive, beginning next January, from \$12,000 per year to \$16,000 per year.

"Warren's henchmen in that

State capital tried to fix things so that the public could not learn how much pension he is entitled to. But although they did establish 'secrecy' this stealth was undone by a little proviso elsewhere which compels the comptroller to tell the truth. Nevertheless the California public has come to accept secrecy with dumb docility so this essay will probably be news to many Californians," Pegler wrote.

When it is considered that Warren sucked the public teat in California thirty-nine years and has now latched on to the national udder which will sustain him for the balance of his life while enjoying a combined salary of \$51,000 per year, the inescapable conclusion is that he is not doing so bad.

Since he is an extremely mediocre lawyer and knows absolutely nothing about the Constitution and fundamental legal ethics, and is still trusted with the highest judicial job in the land, it is clear that he has fared well under the American system which he so heartily despises and which he seeks to abolish by judicial dictum.

Perhaps He'd Like To Put This Judge In A Concentration Camp

How respect for Constitutional Government has diminished in the minds of those whose responsibility it is to uphold it is demonstrated in the reaction of a member of Congress to the ruling of Judge Harry J. Lemley of Arkansas recently in which integration of the races in the public schools of that State was postponed for two and a half years.

Emanuel Cellar, chairman of the House Judiciary Committee and of its sub-committee and one of the most extreme radicals ever sent to Congress from New York which seldom elects any other kind, has threatened to "investigate" this Southern judge whose decision, in the view of normal and responsible persons, was in the best interests of the people of his State.

The wild-eyed Cellar pronounced the ruling "outrageous" and said hearings would be started by his Committee on the subject immediately. "I shall cause careful scrutiny to be made of the conditions out of which this decision arises," he snorted.

When it is considered that men of Cellar's stature who would destroy our independent judiciary system, make up a majority of our legislative representation, it is not surprising that legislative action has reached the lowest ebb in the history of organized government.

Leaders of the Methodist Central Conference meeting in Fort Worth said that the legalization of horse racing would be immoral and they were strongly opposed to it. But they held that mixing Negroes and Whites "in all relevant aspects of our common life" was a goal of the church and therefore "moral."

NAACP Organization Record Is Bared In New Brochure

Eighty per cent of the top leadership of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People has a record of Communist association and the Communist world knew in advance of the events which were to take place in Little Rock in connection with school integration, according to a document just published by Alliance, Inc.

Alliance, Inc., is a patriotic research organization with headquarters at 200 East 66th Street, New York 21, and the president of the organization is the Honorable Archibald B. Roosevelt, member of the responsible branch of that family, who wrote the preface to the new document referred to above and which is titled "Red Intrigue and Race Turmoil."

This brochure goes back to the beginning of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People in 1909 and traces its record with a thoroughness which characterizes all the research work of Mr. Roosevelt.

We tried to interpret the President's explanation concerning the difference between an outright gift and a bribe but the best we could make of it is that when Modern Republicans receive it, it's a gift but when Fair Deal Democrats accept it, it's a bribe.

Screwball Envisions Utopia Where Nobody Will Work

We are sure that there are many wonderful Americans who live in Aspen, Colorado, but possibly because of the inviting climate or something, it has become a "nut haven" and seems to draw left-wingers, one-worlders and other off-beat characters like black-strap molasses attracts flies.

The latest is the Aspen Summer Institute Lecture Series which was addressed by one Mortimer Adler who blossomed forth with a new social theory that has even Karl Marx backed right off the boards.

In this addle-pated Socialist's view, work is degrading and undignified and those who engage in it are slaves. He made it clear that only fools are guilty of performing manual labor.

He predicted that the "good life" in which nobody will turn a hand to support himself, is coming with a "second great revolution" which will bring about the "dispersal of capital so that all people are owners." As might be expected, this ideologically perverted specimen spent a large portion of his life holed up in an institution of learning—the University of Chicago—where he taught his Socialist theories to his classes.

Since Adler was addressing off-beat characters like himself at Aspen no particular harm was done. The regrettable part of it is that newspapers — who are always ready to publicize and glorify those who are opposed to the American form of government — carried a picture of Adler on their front pages in which he was pictured not as a nut but as a "philosopher" who had presented "culture enthusiasts" with a "new vision of Utopia."

How much better to have presented him as the ridiculous figure he is or to have ignored him altogether.

In an address in Cleveland, Ohio, October 28th, 1945, according to the Cleveland Plain Dealer, Adler is reported to have said that in order to achieve real world government "we must do everything we can to abolish the United States . . . the only answer to the threat of atomic war is world government, complete relinquishment of United States and all other national sovereignties."

On a University of Chicago Round Table broadcast, Adler appeared with Max Lerner and when Lerner made the statement: "We not only must abolish the national sovereignties . . . we must abolish reactionary capitalism . . . we must have a genuine Socialism before we can have peace" Adler is reported to have said: "I would go with you on that."

OPEN A TEXTILE BUSINESS IN INDONESIA AND GO TO TOWN

"We also might be able to finance the installation of public facilities such as power, transportation, etc., if not otherwise available near desirable plant sites. These and other possible means of ICA assistance could be discussed in detail with any of your members who might be interested."

So step right up, boys, and get in line. The ICA of the State Department will not only subsidize your business, handle all details for you and underwrite your losses but they will also provide you with a nice, fat, greasy Indonesian as a partner.

If you are a textile manufacturer in the United States and have had the daylights shot out of your business by the Reciprocal Trade Agreements Act, don't just sit around and suck your thumb. Here's the chance to recoup your losses. Become a citizen of Indonesia and thereby be assured that the American government will take care of you, finance your business and guarantee you against loss—something they couldn't think of doing so long as you are a resident of this country.

Your trouble is that you are just a stupid American. So get wise; move to Indonesia and you've got it made.

Johnston Pleads Cause Of Obscene Motion Pictures

Mr. Eric Johnston, President of the Motion Picture Association of America, is a man of many parts.

It matters not whether a New Deal, Fair Deal or Modern Republican is the occupant of the White House, when any dirty work needs to be done or the public mind slugged into insensibility preparatory to a big raid on the treasury, this little man from the West Coast comes to bat.

"Think of the drive toward safe schools for our children! Safe schools! What can they mean? A school where independent thinking is an offense, where dissent and protest are throttled, where the inquiring mind is greeted by the off-limits sign? That isn't a safe school. That's a mausoleum."

Having delivered himself of this defense of Progressive Education, Johnston warned his listeners that "Americans should be aware of what is happening to them before it is too late," to which we say, "Amen," but we don't mean what Mr. Johnston does.
