The undersigned contractor, with offices at Houston, Texas, having carefully examined the plans and specifications for your Negro Hospital Building, all as prepared by Maurice J. Sullivan, Architect, and having visited and examined the the site, herewith proposes to do all the work called for on the plans and in the specifications for the sum of Fifty Six Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Eight (\$56,378.00) Dollars.

ALTERNATES

- A. If composition floors are used where indicated, add to any bid the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Ninety One (\$1,491.00) Dollars.
- B. If Terrazzo floors are used where indicated add the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty (\$1,460.00) Dollars.
- C. If Black Bangor #1 clear slate 20" to 24" long by random width, with galvanized iron nails are used in place of tile, deduct the sum of Five Hundred Forty Nine (\$549.00) Dollars.
- D. If 6" x 12" x 12" hollow tile is used in place of interlocking tile, laid flat-ways, deduct the sum of One Thousand One Hundred Seventeen (\$1,117.00) Dollars.

If awarded the contract, we agree to complete the same in 125 calender days.
