Further referring to mine of May 16th:

I think it is pertinent to mention that on this occasion as well as on several previous occasions Dr. Peter Gray Sears has indicated deep interest in the welfare of the negro and has been particularly interested in and highly commendatory of the Houston Negro Hospital. Indeed he went so far on one occasion as to be rather critical that I had not seen to it that he make the major address at the dedication, which called for an explanation that all of this had been arranged by the Advisory Committee of which you were Chairman.

However, this leads to a thought and suggestion that I feel should have Dr. Slaughter's consideration and yours, namely, placing Dr. Sears on your board, a position that I feel sure he would greatly appreciate and, as I see it, might be very helpful to you.
