Envy, malice and jealousy have always found lodgment in the hearts and minds of small men and are often reflected in the record of a nation's history.

When an Athenian peasant voted to condemn Aristides "The Just," he was asked what wrong this good man had ever done him and he replied: "None. I am tired of hearing him called 'The Just'."

In order that the spirit of vengeance might not slumber, King Darius had his Secretary say to him each morning: "Sire, remember Athens" and his Persian army was cut to pieces in the Battle of Marathon.

Hannibal laid his hand on the altar and swore to get revenge against Rome and his Carthaginian army was annihilated on the Plains of Italy.

When the security of a nation hangs in the balance, its leaders cannot afford to harbor malice and an administration torn by the demon of jealousy is a dangerous threat to the country and to its people.

There is no doubt in the minds of informed persons that Senator McCarthy's success in exposing Communism in government, in the army and in defense plants and the admiration of the public for his courage, inspired the envy of little men who wouldn't recognize an enemy spy if they caught him in the act or, if they did, would cover him up as they did in the case of Alger Hiss, Harry Dexter White and the man who promoted Irving Peress.

Ours is not the only nation which has been hastened on its downward course toward destruction by blindly following leaders whose blood was burning with the fever of envy, scorn and hatred, and who could not lift their minds above personal animosity and political ambition.

We might as well face it. We have a weak and vacillating national leadership and the Ship of State is operating with a wobbly rudder. It is every good American's responsibility to try to direct them back toward the safe and sane course of Americanism.

As the New Year peeps over the horizon, an era is being ushered in that may witness the liquidation of the traditional two-party system of government in this country; total repudiation of the concept of the paramount Rights of States on which the American Union was based; a rising national indebtedness which will enslave unborn generations of American children; absolute surrender of our national sovereignty to a World Government and the deployment of American troops to forty-one foreign countries after stripping them of the protection of the American Flag; disavowal of the sacred and cherished principles which sustained the American Republic for more than a hundred and fifty years and final abandonment of Constitutional government in the United States.

Irresponsible Americans who whistle in the dark to indicate contempt for danger will accept optimistic, politically-biased messages to Congress as a true reflection of the national picture but the taxpayers who think for themselves and keep an apprehensive eye on the Washington scene, cannot escape these conclusions:

Because our national leaders for more than two decades have ignored the wise counsel and advice of far-sighted statesmen of an earlier day who laid down the sound policy of non-interference in the affairs of other nations, the United States is in trouble all over the world.

Our influence is at an all-time low and the outward gestures of respect of other nations for this country are largely bought and paid for through gifts of cash and the flow of billions of American dollars into their coffers.

Through treaties and executive agreements, the sons of American mothers are now committed to fight and die for forty-one different countries scattered around over the face of the earth and, in some cases, these fighting men have been stripped of Constitutional guarantees and protection of the American Flag.

Because of our membership in the United Nations, we have been deprived of the Constitutional right of self-protection against an enemy, without approval of the United Nations, as the right to declare war has been surrendered by Congress to the World Organization. Before this year is out, if proposed amendments to the United Nations Charter are adopted, all rights and privileges which Americans have enjoyed from the beginning of the Republic will be taken from them and they will become chattels of internationalist masters.

Our switch from a national to an international basis and our adoption of the United Nations' international program by which we are compelled to assume the responsibility of providing for the security and defense of many other countries aside from our own, has run the national debt of the United States up to a figure that chills the heart and frightens the wits out of any American concerned in the solvency of the American Republic.

The national debt ceiling is fixed by statute at \$275,000,000,000.00 and the current indebtedness is crowding that figure to such an extent that the President, who was elected two years ago on an economy platform, has asked Congress to lift the ceiling higher.

Millions of Americans Think It-The Southern Conservative Says It

The Valiant Efforts of Another Communist Investigating Committee Add Up to Nothing

One of the least publicized and most effective committees of the Congress in developing the Communist conspiracy throughout the world was the House Select Committee to Investigate Communist Aggression of which the Honorable Charles J. Kersten of Wisconsin was chairman.

In a series of hearings in Chicago, New York, London, Munich and Berlin Congressman Kersten and his committee developed testimony from witnesses from the Baltic States concerning Soviet atrocities which, for sheer horror, have no equal in all history.

Serving with Congressman Kersten on the committee were Fred E. Busbey of Illinois, Edward J. Bonin of Pennsylvania, Patrick J. Hillings of California, Ray J. Madden of Indiana, Thaddeus M. Machrowicz of Michigan, Thomas J. Dodd of Connecticut and Michael A. Feighan of Ohio.

The death of between five and six million citizens of the Ukraine from starvation at a time when bumper crops were being harvested was told by a Ukrainian national who provided extensive testimony for the Committee and the committee learned that 1,692,000 citizens of prewar Poland were deported to the USSR from 1939 to 1941.

The wholesale deportation of 500,000 citizens of the Chechen-Ingush Republic, a non-Communist nation in the USSR by Russian troops which was related by a former captain in the Russian MVD, Soviet National Police, constitutes an unparalleled chapter in infamy.

Under the guise of unity between the Red Army and the people of that Republic, Russian troops were brought into Chechen-Ingush to "train and advise the people" for participation in the USSR program of harmony and unity. These troops remained a month,

listing the population and making secret plans for the mass evacuation of the people who had no inkling of the plot.

At the appointed time, the Chechen-Ingush people were lined up, from new-born babies to the oldest among them, and marched through a corridor of armed Russian soldiers to awaiting trucks which, incidentally, were American trucks sent to Russia by the United States Government under lend-lease.

These people were then crowded in the boxcars until there wasn't standing room, the cars were sealed, headed toward Russia and the Chechen-Ingush Republic was no more. Meantime a brass band played Soviet music to the accompaniment of the screams, groans and moanings of the betrayed people.

The high-point of horror in the testimony was furnished by no less a personage than King Michael, former ruler of Rumania who told of the conquest of his country and of the orgy of terror in Bucharest following the invasion. Young children were placed in cells where they were assaulted during the night by syphilis-infested Russians and sent home to their parents with a card around their necks advising them of what had happened and warning them of worse in the case of resistance.

There are hundreds of similar villainous incidents in the report participated in by the beasts with whom we are now urged to live in "peaceful co-existence."

For his exhaustive efforts in exposing the brutal Communist conspiracy, and as further evidence of Communist influence in this country, Congressman Kersten was defeated in the November election by a Fair Deal Democrat.

"We must not let ourselves regard the Russian people as our enemies" says a pamphlet issued by the National Council of Churches of Christ titled "Christian Foundations for Lasting Peace." "The Russian people are sons of God like ourselves, anxious and fearful, eager for security both political and economic, no more desirous of war than any of us. It is doubtful that their leaders desire it, either..."

There is one American at least who will agree with this twaddle and that is Senator Ralph (Fathead) Flanders who, on Thanksgiving Day, while his resolution was pending to censure another senator for exposing Communist spies, addressed a broadcast to the Bolsheviks in which he slobbered all over the microphone with endearing terms such as "brethren" and "Friends". Pink Professor Gives Somewhere Along the Line Only Half the Story We Lost National Pride And Self-Respect

Robert M. Hutchins, former University of Chicago president and now president of the Fund of the Republic, a Ford Foundation grant to be used in investigating those who investigate Communists, spoke at the University of Texas recently.

While in Austin Hutchins who is known principally for his insistence that Communists should be allowed to teach in American schools, gave out an interview in which he claimed that "the quality of university education in this nation has been steadily declining for a decade and the outlook is that it will continue to decline."

For once he is right, but he stopped before giving the reason for this decline. It is because of persons like himself on the executive and teaching staffs of American universities.

Nowhere in the Constitution of the United States is there any authority for the Congress to appropriate one thin dime to provide standing Armies of any country except our own or to protect the general welfare of foreign nations or raise their standards of living. In addition, the American people, by and large, are not internationalist-minded and are vastly more concerned in the preservation of this Republic than in bolstering impoverished foreign Socialist States.

To bring Americans around to the international viewpoint and soften them up for One-World Government, millions of their own dollars are being spent in propaganda and the left-wing trend in Washington is so pronounced as to cause the distinguished American journalist, David Lawrence, to suggest the possibility of the abandonment of the two-party system in this country and the amalgamation of all "liberals" into one party with the President as their candidate in 1956.

Recently that writer observed in his column: "Eisenhower is popular with the Democrats and now that he has made common cause with the so-called 'left-wing' in the Republican Party, it would be logical if the 'left-wing' Democrats should want to see him nominated on their ticket, too, so as to assure the 'left-wing' of continued control of the government."

In a further swing to the left, all authentic, big-scale investigations of Communist infiltration have been officially halted in Washington. Thousands of small-fry subversives will be exposed amid a fanfare of publicity but any American who seeks to flush the big-time operators out of strategic positions in the government, in the Army, defense plants and other vital agencies will get the axe. There is no argument about this because we have seen it happen with our own eyes.

The planned assault on States Rights was highlighted by the Supreme Court's ruling on segregation by which they illegally and un-Constitutionally assumed jurisdiction over the public school systems of the nation and by the suggestion of a member of the President's Cabinet, Labor Secretary Mitchell, who proposed at a CIO convention in Los Angeles that all right-to-work laws of the various States be abolished.

The Socialist share-the-wealth plan of taxation instituted by Roosevelt and extended by Truman has become a permanent policy of government and all idea of balancing the budget is now recognized as merely another whimsical device for influencing votes and winning elections.

In brief, we are practically back where we were in 1952 when vast hordes of American voters swarmed to the polls to throw the Fair Dealers out and "clean up the mess." At the current session of Congress more Socialist legislation is proposed than Roosevelt and Truman ever dreamed of at the zenith of their power and such measures as Socialized Medicine and Socialized education through Federal Aid to schools will be pushed with all the resources of an administration which now openly admits its leaning to the extreme left.

It all adds up to a grave and menacing situation which the people of this country should seriously ponder during their every waking hour and especially those of the younger generation who will constitute tomorrow's citizens and on whom the burden of debt and lost liberty will fall with the heaviest impact.

To those of us whose shadow is beginning to fall toward the East, it can't matter too much and too long as our deep concern in the tragedy must necessarily come to an end when Charon comes to row us across the River of No Return.

Chinese Communists Merely Took Up Where American Army Left Off

The penalty for treason used to be death and should still be, but we cannot understand why the Army keeps court-martialing men who, they claim, were indoctrinated with Communism by the Chinese when it has been definitely proved that the Chinese were only doing what our own Army did.

"Soldiers in World War II were taught the Communist line by men wearing the American uniform from the time they entered the Army until they were mustered out."

The above charge was made by a United States Senator, the Honorable William E. Jenner of Indiana who, as chairman of an investigating committee of the Senate, heard almost endless testimony to this effect.

Jenner added that the testimony showed that the program "to which every GI was subjected, was heavily loaded with pro-Soviet propaganda and staffed in many instances by men with Communist records. . . . The writing was done and the troops instructed, in many cases, by men who later used the Fifth Amendment as a protection against self-incrimination to avoid revealing their Communist records."

It is understandable why the Chinese Communists should wish to implant Communism in the minds of prisoners of war but we imagine it is pretty difficult for parents of young men on trial for having accepted this horrible indoctrination to understand why their sons are being punished for accepting beliefs taught them in the American Army.

The Chinese Communists merely took up where our Army left off in the indoctrination courses and that the Army is still infiltrated with Communists is proved by the sly and tricky manner in which Communist Peress was promoted, honorably discharged and sneaked out of the Army to avoid exposure by the McCarthy Committee.

Not only were American soldiers indoctrinated with Communism through a regular Army program but the Moscow plan of mongrelization of the white race was furthered by an Assistant Secretary of Defense who worked diligently for the indiscriminate mixing of the races in all branches of the services.

It is all pretty sickening and the more the story unfolds, the more revolting it is.

One Way to Handle An Embarrassing Situation

Alexander Wiley of Wisconsin was on the spot in the "censure session" of the Senate last November.

If he voted against censure of the junior senator from Wisconsin, he would have had the administration down on him like a ton of brick.

If he voted for censure, he would have had the socks beaten off him at the next election in Wisconsin.

So he took the way out which harassed politicians have embraced as a last resort from the beginning of time—he took a powder and skipped.

As his colleagues squabbled and wrangled like a bunch of little boys in a marble game, he was reported to be lolling in the sunshine on a far-away beach.

Dr. William Borborg, representative from Denmark to the United Nations told the American Psychiatric Association sometime ago that a "psychiatrist should sit behind every United Nations delegate", and deplored the fact that there were not enough psychiatrists to go round. This suggestion was made following the discovery that U. Only a Big Man Will Admit A Mistake and Apologize

In addition to his qualifications as a statesman and an American patriot of the highest order, Joe McCarthy has proved his stature as a man.

He found that he had been mistaken and had done wrong and he had the manhood to publicly admit it.

He apologized to the people of the United States for having urged them to vote for Eisenhower for president in 1952 and for assuring them at that time that the new administration would utilize every resource within its power in fighting Communism at home and abroad.

Instead, the White House, during the past two years, placed every possible obstacle in the path of those who were sincerely striving to halt the Communist menace in this country and especially directed its antagonism against Senator McCarthy for his successful efforts to expose Soviet spies in high places.

When the Wisconsin senator was convinced in his heart that this was true, he did the only manly and honest thing left to do—he apologized. And in expressing regret for his honest mistake, he was voicing the sentiments of millions of other good Americans who were likewise deluded into the belief that the Republican Party was immune to the alien influence which had destroyed the Democratic Party. They, too, are now kneeling at the mourner's bench and repenting of their error. It takes a man, and a big man at that, to admit a mistake and ask forgiveness.

'The Mystery Deepens' As the Plot Thickens

In our last edition we told of the book put out by the State Department, paid for with taxpayers money, called "Soviet World Outlook—A Handbook of Communist Statements."

Since that editorial appeared scores of persons have tried to get a copy of this publication from the State Department without success. Even members of the Senate have been denied the privilege of reviewing it and in one or two instances were told that no such publication existed.

Well, it does exist for we have in our possession one of the books which says on the fly-leaf that it was first published by the State Department in January, 1950 and revised, brought up to date and reissued on April 30, 1954. Where we got it is nobody's business but our own, but we have it.

It contains 434 pages and from beginning to end paints a glowing picture of Communism in the words of Soviet leaders and there is not one word added to refute this poisonous ideology.

In our former editorial, we expressed amazement that such a publication should be put out by an agency of the American government at taxpayers' expense.

Now that its existence has been denied, we are really wondering what gives.

In the National Republic for May, 1954, William M. McNamara, Caribbean correspondent for that publication told of a meeting of the Communist Party held in Mexico City in 1944 with Lombardo de Toleando presiding in which plans were laid for perfecting organization in all Latin American countries, "to liquidate Anglo-American Capitalism and then consolidate a full economic and political autonomy for these countries." In the six-point program laid out at this meeting, the Communists said among other things: "The Foreign Affairs Ministry at Moscow is giving tremendous impulse to our activities through its mission in these countries. WE CAN BE THANKFUL, TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF STATE FOR THE CONTRIBUTION OF SOME OF ITS AGENCIES TO THE WORK OF OUR CELLS." (Emphasis ours).

This occurred during the Roosevelt administration when full cooperation with Communist plans was all in the day's work but why is a "Handbook of Communist Statements" revised, brought up to date and reissued by the State Department in 1954?

Somebody in authority might well go into the matter fully and give the American people who footed the bill a complete report on the matter.

United States delegates to the United Nations gave up and knuckled under to the World Organization in the matter of payment of \$179,400 wage indemnities to eleven former Communists employed by the United States and who were discharged, after pressure was brought by real Americans. Rhodes Scholar Fulbright who is a U. S. Delegate to the UN outfit, made what is perhaps the most absurd, weak and inane assertion in history when he explained: "The United States respects the World Court which upheld the payments, too much to oppose its decision." He should have explained that he was speaking only for himself and his ilk, as no responsible, informed and patriotic American respects the World Court or anything else that overrides the American Constitution.

Among the heavy contributors who gave large sums of money to the NCEC were such names as Deutsch, Levin, Bernard, Wolf, Sieroty, Lipschuts, Strauss, Blitzer, Barchoff, Epstein, Karelsen, Kislak, Rosenberg, Kaplan, Lubin, Tuchman, Rothschild, Kramarsky, Schauer, Zechendorf and others.

Kit Clardy of Michigan and Charles J. Kersten of Wisconsin have done splendid work in Congress in exposing Communists and they were both beaten by Fair Deal Democrats in the last election. McCarthy did not come up for re-election this time so the Commies concentrated their fire on getting him censured.

Investigating Committee Makes Amazing Claim in Press Report

How many Americans from the "extreme right" have stolen confidential papers and top-secret information from government files in Washington and peddled it to Soviet spies?

How many Americans from the "extreme right" have protected traitors such as Alger Hiss and Harry Dexter White from exposure and kept them in high government position until their work for their Russian masters was practically completed?

How many Americans from the "extreme right" have connived with Soviet agents for the surrender of our American sovereignty to the United Nations and to place the shackles of slavery on the people of this Republic?

Was it Americans from the "extreme right" who nullified the Constitution of the United States, put government in competition with private business, aided in passing legislation based on the Communist Party platform, abrogated States Rights, helped the American government fulfill Lenin's prediction that we would spend ourselves out of existence or fell all over their own feet in their haste to comply with Moscow's demand for the mongrelization of white Americans?

Was it Americans from the "extreme right" who removed the protection of the American Flag from Americans fighting in foreign lands or who withheld ammunition from our forces in Korea and abandoned captured American soldiers to rot in Chinese prison camps?

Was it Americans from the "extreme right" who made it practically impossible to weed out Communists in the Army and defense plants and was it Americans from the "extreme right" who conducted a program to infiltrate American soldiers with Communism in World War II or who promoted the Communist Irving Peress, and gave him an honorable discharge from the Army?

To accept this perverted theory voiced in the Committee statement, we must repudiate every moral principle instilled in the human mind from the cradle.

In effect, this degenerate pronouncement would have us accept the premise that virtue is on a level with vice; that good ranks along with evil; that right belongs in the same category with wrong; that honesty and dishonesty are one and the same and that a state of human perfection lies in fluctuating half way between probity and infamy.

In practical effect, it means that the eminent and revered Daughters of the American Revolution, defenders of the American Flag and the Republic for which it stands, are no better than the subversive Americans for Democratic Action, committed to the abolishment of our form of government and the American way of life.

To carry the analogy further, it means that the dedicated and patriotic gentlewomen who compose DAR are no better than ADA's Eleanor Roosevelt. This thesis, in our humble opinion, will be staunchly challenged by all responsible Americans.

No one seems willing to admit authorship of this incongruous charge by the Committee and we don't blame them.

Harold Velde of Illinois who was still chairman when it was released was on his honeymoon at the time and, naturally, was absolved from responsibility concerning this or anything else, and it is understood that Francis Walter of Pennsylvania who succeeded him as chairman of the Committee disclaims any connection with it.

We do not know of course, what staff member's malignant and sinister brain gave birth to this declaration but, whoever he is, he should be run down and punished.

We do not exactly advocate boiling him in oil but at least, he should be taken out of circulation, placed in restraint and divested of his official power to perpetrate any more such dastardly assaults against truth and decency.

Personally, we regard ourself as belonging to the "extreme right" and when any half-witted bureaucrat charges us with similarity to a left-winger, we are not going to take the insult lying down.

'Dignity' of the Senate Is Not Tarnished by A Stolen Election

The vote of the two Texas senators in the censure farce occasioned much discussion in the Lone Star State, following the silly and childish performance in that body in November.

Not many persons expected Johnson to perform otherwise than as he did, although we can't see why. After all, members of the Senate were extremely lenient with him in 1948 and ignored the assault on their "dignity" when he entered the sacred portals of that exclusive club by grace of a stolen election.

Although documented evidence was offered proving that Boss George Parr in South Texas had come across five days after the polls closed with enough votes of dead men and Mexican Nationals to put Johnson over by 87 votes after his opponent had been legally elected, not a word was said about the "dignity" of the Senate being assailed and no charges were heard about "conduct unbecoming a Senator."

Of course that was six years ago and it may be ungracious to bring it up but facts are facts and that's all Americans should be concerned in during these grave and perilous times in the nation's history.

With Daniel, it was different. Somehow, he has become identified with conservatism in the public mind although his partiality to Union labor was pronounced during his early political career. Many influential Texans who backed him with what it takes during his campaign for the Senate, were predicting throughout the censure proceedings that he would repudiate the insolent demand of the Daily Worker that they "throw the bum out" and would vote against the censure motion.

Inspiring almost as much resentment as their vote against McCarthy's exposure of Communists, was the clumsy effort of both senators to alibi their behavior by claiming that the vote to censure McCarthy had nothing to do whatever with his fight against Communists. They should have voted against him if they felt so inclined and let it go at that. They had no right to insult the intelligence of their constituency.

On the same floor where had stood such brilliant and forceful Texans as Horace Chilton, John H. Reagan and Joseph W. Bailey, these two little boys from Texas meekly bowed their heads and obeyed commands like performing poodles in a circus act.

But at least they helped to keep party lines intact and for that they will probably receive due credit, although there may be some divergence of opinion about just what party line they were following.

We say it with sadness and regret but many of our theological Seminaries are religious factories which produce domestic Reds and the product they turn out is almost as genuine as the imported article.

Official Report of Congressional Committee Proves Several Large Foundations Are Menace to Security of United States

Now that the path has been cleared and fighting Communism has been officially designated as unpopular, the Ford Foundation's \$15,000,000 program is getting under way.

This program has for its announced objective the "elimination of restrictions on freedom of thought."

This means in plain language, that the Foundation which has financed scores of Communist movements and individuals is getting ready to crack down on Americans who are so heedless of Soviet interests that they actually dare to feel and express concern for the safety and security of their own country.

This, in the view of the pin-head progeny who control the Ford millions, is rank treason against the internationalists who seek to openly control the government of the United States, instead of continuing the under-ground domination which they now enjoy, and fifteen million dollars of the Ford money is to be spent in achieving this end.

The saga of some of the large Foundations, who pay no taxes to the government, is an ugly, filthy story—a story of subversion and of infiltration into their ranks of some of the worst characters in the United States who are diverting the millions of dollars amassed by the blood, sweat and tears of American pioneers and captains of industry into subversive movements for the ultimate betrayal and overthrow of the American Republic, under whose orderly processes these large fortunes were built.

There are literally hundreds of struggling groups and individuals in this country who are striving with all the forces at their small command to awaken the American people to the danger posed by subversive alien influence to the American form of government.

The Ford Foundation would see them starve and drop in their tracks before one penny in "grants" would be allowed them but the officials who control this Foundation have voluntarily stepped forward and planked down fifteen million dollars to be expended in investigating those who expose Communist spies operating within the government of the United States, in the Army and in American defense plants.

The two Reports of a Committee of Congress set up to investigate the activities of the Foundations just released, cover approximately fifteen hundred pages and show that there is scarcely a subversive organization or member of a Communist Front in the country that has not been financed, at one time or another, by one or the other of the large Foundations. The accuracy of the reports and the unimpeachable sources of reference, together with the excellent job done by the Chairman, Hon. Carroll Reece of Tennessee, have made him a likely victim of the smear groups who go into action against any American who exposes any phase of the Communist conspiracy against the United States.

Any thoughtful American who reads these two reports cannot escape the conclusion that such Foundations as Ford, Carnegie, Rockefeller and others who were organized primarily to escape payment of death taxes, and have fallen into the hands of Internationalists, One-Worlders and plain Communist sympathizers, are a major menace to the security and safety of the American Republic.

Wayne L. Hayes of Ohio, is so pink that it is a rank flattery to call him a Fair Dealer or a left-winger. In his campaign for re-election to Congress in November, he stood a fair chance of being beaten by his opponent until he dragged out and presented for display what a prominent Washington columnist called his "secret weapon." It was a photograph of President Eisenhower inscribed "For Congressman Wayne L. Hayes with best wishes to a distinguished American. Signed Dwight D. Eisenhower". He was re-elected. It was he who sabotaged the hearings into the Foundations who are charged with having subsidized Communist individuals and movements. One of them, the Ford Foundation, has put up \$15,000,000 to investigate those who are investigating Communists. Hayes was largely responsible for stopping the investigation.

From a reader in New Hampshire: "We have only one live paper which tells the political facts of life in New Hampshire . . . I would give a lot if you would transplant yourself to this State and give the papers up here some competition."

Another Good American Whose Eyes Have Now Been Opened

Some weeks ago a big two-fisted six-foot-two cattleman came in our office and, alternately, wept on our shoulder and made the air blue with some choice, West Texas profanity.

When he finally calmed down, we found out that his ire had just now reached the boiling point over something that happened almost ten years ago.

Like so many good Americans he had been so busy making money and directing his various interests that he had not had time to stop and find out what was going on.

It seems that he had just read David Lawrence's magazine the U. S. News & World Report and had learned, for the first time, about General Eisenhower holding back his troops two weeks while the Russians took over Germany at the close of World War II in 1945, an action that "shaped for Russia the gigantic victory that she is now enjoying in Europe," according to that publication.

When he expressed surprise that we were not wrought up over it too, we told him we had done our crying over it when it happened and that so many things were currently taking place that are equally indefensible and disastrous that we can't afford to linger too long over something that is practically ancient history.

The point of the incident is that one more fine American citizen who was asleep at the switch has become alerted to the danger facing the Republic and will be watchful of its interests in future.

Just Hold Everything Brother, Its Coming

Another blow was aimed at States Rights by a Cabinet Member during the December meeting in Los Angeles of the CIO which is on record as opposed to all rights except those of Union Labor and those of minority groups.

Labor Secretary Mitchell told labor leaders in attendance that the Right-to-work laws which have been enacted by the various States should be repealed and the whole thing left to the Federal government.

Apparently Mitchell became impatient and jumped the gun without waiting for nature to take its course.

If he will just keep his shirt on and bide his time, not only the right-to-work laws but all other State legislation, as well as all federal enactments will be repealed under the administrations ultimate, over-all plan to nullify State and Federal laws in this country and, through the United Nations, let a World Government decide all municipal, State and national issues, for the American people.

We have said it so much that it may sound like a chant but we want our readers to take this into consideration and remember it when dealing with their national lawmakers: Individually, members of both Houses of Congress usually behave like gentlemen and scholars which most of them are. Collectively, they frequently perform like a gang of horse-thieves, and should be treated accordingly.

At Least He Will Never Be the Subject of 'Censure'

One of the Christmas gifts reported to have been received by McClellan of Arkansas was a pair of soft velvet gloves.

He will succeed Joe McCarthy as chairman of the committee which must deal with tough Communists who delight in insulting those who question them concerning their treasonable activities against this country.

We can well imagine a dialogue something like this when McClellan takes over: Question: "Pardon me sir for asking you a personal question but would you mind telling me if you are a member of the Communist Party and if you have engaged in espionage in defense plants"? Answer: "You're darn tootin' I'd mind. It ain't none of your business and if you want to make somethin' out of it, just come out in the hall." Chairman: "No, no. You misunderstood me. I just wanted to get the information while, at the same time, guarding your sacred right of free speech and guaranteeing you Constitutional immunity from disclosing your political views. Please don't be offended. Next witness, please."

Communism Demands Hatred

Press reports indicate that the communist government of Russia is undertaking a campaign to drive all forms of religion out of Russia and its satellites. The reason was given recently by the Soviet Commissar of Education in the following words.

"We hate Christians. Even the best of them must be regarded as our worst enemies. They preach love to one's neighbor and pity, which is contrary to our principles. Christian love is a hindrance to the development of the revolution. Down with love for one's neighbor! What we want is hatred. We must know how to hate, for only at this price can we conquer the universe . . . Our task is to destroy all kinds of religion, all kinds of morality." — Christian Economics.

There used to be an old saw to the effect that if you gave a Socialist Five Thousand Dollars, he immediately changed into a Capitalist. This is not true any more since we have thousands of rich Socialists like the Roosevelts, the Harrimans, the Fords, Rockefellers, Morganthaus and others in the top financial brackets.

Senate Ignores National Security In Move That Pleases Daily Worker

In order that the American people may have no illusion about the attitude of the United States Senate on the critical subject of Communist infiltration into American institutions, they should keep constantly available the names of a small group of fearless members of that body who did not compromise with the enemy in voting on the McCarthy "censure."

Dworshak of Idaho, Barry Goldwater of Arizona, Bourke B. Hickenlooper of Iowa, Roman L. Hruska of Nebraska, William E. Jenner of Indiana, William F. Knowland of California, Thomas H. Kuchel of California, William Langer of North Dakota, George W. Malone of Nevada, Edward Martin of Pennsylvania, Joseph R. McCarthy of Wisconsin, Eugene D. Milliken of Colorado, Karl E. Mundt of South Dakota, William A. Purtell of Connecticut, Andrew F. Schoeppl of Kansas, Herman Welker of Idaho, Milton R. Young of North Dakota. Brown of Nevada and Guy Cordon of Oregon belonged on this list but they are no longer in the Senate.

Pat McCarran of Nevada had crossed the Great Divide when members of the Senate faced the crucial test of their Americanism but it would be an insult to his memory to question how he would have voted. It is hoped that Senator Alan Bible will measure up to his great predecessor.

Strom Thurmond of South Carolina was not yet in the Senate but it is a safe bet that he, too, would have put the security of his country before any imaginary insult to his personal "dignity."

Watkins and Flanders owe a debt to Joe McCarthy that they can never repay, although they would be the last to acknowledge the service he has, inadvertently, rendered them. Neither of them were ever heard of, outside their own little limited sphere of influence, until they were brought to public attention through their fight on McCarthy. The Wisconsin Senator's name is known all over the world and he is either devotedly loved or cordially hated, according to each person's views on Communism. Watkins and Flanders have inspired neither love nor hatred and not one person in ten thousand even knew they were members of the Senate. They have received their first, and perhaps their last, public recognition because of McCarthy.

The American State Department sponsored, and American taxpayers paid for a tour of this country by Miss Ann Godwin of England. She is secretary of the Office Workers International Unions Locals, a world Socialist organization, and was in this country to speed up the organization of office workers here. She is also on the General Council of the British Trade Union Congress, another Socialist group. The news article telling of Miss Godwin's trip did not make it clear whether the money allotted for this expense was contributed only by American Socialist taxpayers or whether the tax money of good Americans was diverted to this purpose. There should by all means be some distinction made in the matter. We, as one humble taxpayer, were not consulted and we haven't heard of any one who was. For our part, we should have been delighted if Miss Godwin had stayed at home.

From a Chicago reader: "Your paper is wonderful and it is generally acknowledged that your writing attracts more attention than all the other similar publications put together, but I have one very serious grievance against you. There are plenty of other fine American groups doing good work but you never mention them or use the material they send you. Maybe there's something in a name after all—Anna Louise Strong, Anna Lord Strauss, Anna Rosenberg, Ana Pauker and Anna Eleanor Roosevelt.

Editor of A Chinese Communist Paper Honored by American Press

The Woonsock, South Dakota, News, makes this pertinent observation: "People come in three sorts; the few who make things happen, the many who watch things happen and the overwhelming majority who don't know what happened". May Heaven spare us the unforgivable sin of belonging to the latter class.

Ordinarily it is pure, unadulterated ignorance which makes a person refer to the United States as a "Democracy" but not always. Many of our most brilliant citizens are Reds and they deliberately call it a "Democracy" although they know better.

Before he enters on the duties of his office a President of the United States must take the following oath: "I do solemnly swear, or affirm, that I will faithfully execute the Office of President of the United States, and will to the best of my ability, preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of the United States". Oh, Oath of Office, what perjury has been committed in thy name!

Daily Worker, take notice: Fulbright of Arkansas says that "the condemnation of Senator McCarthy of Wisconsin was the Senate's greatest single accomplishment during 1954". From Moscow's standpoint, he is so right.

It is reported that there is a move on to have Fathead Flanders "censured" by the Senate for conduct unbecoming a senator but there is nothing to be gained. Just as McCarthy was not hurt in the eyes of real Americans by being censured or being condemned by self-serving politicians, any similar action would not make Flanders any more or less of a heel and shrimp than he is already. A man is what he is and his character is not changed by a Senate vote.

During World War II, there were scores of creatures who apparently crawled out from under a log and landed in various government agencies in Washington.

One of them was John W. Powell of San Francisco who got a job with Elmer Davis' Office of War Information.

Later he was sent out to China where he became editor of the China Monthly Review which, according to testimony before a sub-committee of the Senate Internal Security Committee, was a Communist publication devoted to the praise of Communist China in comparison with such odious Capitalistic countries as the United States.

Former American prisoners of war in China told the committee during the past summer how this China Monthly Review was distributed among them in the camps where they were held.

Articles and editorials extolling Communism in the magazine were marked and American prisoners were instructed to read them and make written comment on them. If the comment was unfavorable, those making the criticism were sent to a labor camp known as "the hole" where they underwent indescribable torture.

During his residence in China Powell made a trip with his wife, Sylvia, to Moscow to receive instruction and "absorb culture" in the Soviet Union.

Back in this country, Powell was haled before the sub-committee and when questioned about his membership in the Communist Party refused fifty-one different times to reply on the ground of the Fifth amendment.

Commenting on the despicable behavior of Powell, the chairman of the sub-committee Senator William E. Jenner said in part: "I was shocked beyond words to learn that this renegade American was permitted to hold a press conference yesterday in the National Press Club of Washington.

"It is reasonable to assume that John W. Powell is in this country to soften up the American people as he tried to soften up our fighting men, so we will agree to trade with the Soviet bloc, and keep quiet if Red China is admitted to the United Nations. We sentence a Corporal Dickinson of Cracker Gap to ten years in prison and give a dishonorable discharge to Colonel Fleming, although these men withstood most of the horrors of imprisonment in Communist prison camps, while we let a renegade American, who indirectly helped to torture them, travel freely about the country and spread poison.

"It is time to end this folly. Yesterday, I asked the Attorney General of the United States to press a treason charge against Powell. He is an American citizen. He has adhered to our enemies in wartime and given them substantial aid and comfort, as the testimony came from former soldiers and officers who were taken prisoners in that war. I am submitting the testimony of these hearings to the Department of Justice and I hope for quick action."

Senatorial Apology Given Those to Whom It Was Due

Louis Budenz and other former top-ranking Communists who have repented of their affiliations, have told often of the Moscow propaganda campaign in this country among newspapers, columnists and radio and television commentators, in a gigantic effort to get them to slant their headlines, distort facts in their reporting and otherwise conforming to the Communist line.

How well they have succeeded becomes evident almost every time we pick up a paper, or listen to some commentator hold forth on the radio or television.

We are thinking, especially, of the instance in which Senator Joseph R. McCarthy, after tolerating every insult the White House could devise, including public congratulation by the president of Watkins and Flanders, finally broke down and said what he thought about such shabby behavior and, incidentally, we believe, what a majority of American voters think of it.

His remarks were restrained in the extreme, considering the provocation, and he merely reflected the resentment which naturally wells up in the human heart in retaliation for continued injustice, insult and ingratitude.

"The exposure of Communists in defense plants handling the secret weapons which may determine whether the sons of American mothers may live or die is, in my opinion, important beyond words" the Wisconsin senator said in what he referred to as his "temporary" swan song as chairman of the subcommittee of the Senate Committee on Government Operations which has been effective in exposing Communists and which is to be taken over by McClelland of Arkansas who will probably perform in a manner more to the president's liking.

"There has been considerable talk about an apology to the Senate for my fight against Communism" McCarthy continued, "I feel, rather, that I should apologize to the American people for what was an unintentional deception upon them.

"During the Eisenhower campaign, I spoke from coast to coast promising the American people that if they would elect the Eisenhower administration that they could be assured of a vigorous, forceful fight against Communism in government. Unfortunately in this I was mistaken".

With the release of the senator's statement, the pink press had a Roman Holiday. "Bitter Blast at President" "Political Storm Sparked by McCarthy" "Double barreled Attack on President" were some of the terms used in blaring headlines of newspapers who had never seen fit to refer to endless attacks on McCarthy from the White House.

But his words inspired a heartening reaction on the part of millions of Americans who admire and respect his assertion, not only because it implied no appeasement, conciliation or surrender of moral principles, but because he was speaking the blunt and unvarnished truth, which, in wide circles of America, is still regarded as a cardinal virtue.

GOVERNOR MAY MAKE TEST CASE OF GOVERNMENTAL EXTORTION

The governor of Utah, Hon. J. Bracken Lee, has announced that he will take a step that we have been urging and praying for throughout the years.

He has consulted with the Attorney General of Utah concerning a test of legality of the Federal government's foreign aid program before the Supreme Court of the United States.

In this test suit, it will be sought to prove that "it is a violation of our United States Constitution when our government gives away our hard-earned money".

In a talk to a civic club in Salt Lake City, the governor pled for a return of the moral integrity which would "eliminate the desire for power which allows the government to take money at will from Americans and give it with equal ease to peoples of other nations."

The only thing that dampens our spirits in connection with the whole thing is that the Supreme Court will have to pass on it. That's the catch.

We are afraid that the results will be those that might be expected in the case of a burglar being tried before a jury of safe-crackers.

The Forgotten Man in this country is the White Christian American. In Washington, he has no friend at court and about the only privilege left him is that of paying the bill for the social legislation and decisions in favor of minority groups in this country and throughout the world.

Chief Executive Compelled to Perform as Jack of All Trades

Swiss Wisdom

Switzerland's income tax expired this year and the Swiss have rejected a proposal to extend it.

Texas Women Will Now Enjoy "Equal Rights"

Texas will now have women on its juries following the adoption of a Constitutional amendment to authorize this procedure.

The matter has been agitated for years by a small minority of frustrated females who, for some reason, felt that the sex was being discriminated against because women were not compelled to hang around the court house bullpen awaiting their chance to pass sentence on criminals.

The argument which seemed to prove most effective in the campaign was the claim that Texas was one of only a few states which did not compel women to serve in this capacity. To us this was no argument at all and was additional reason why the State should retain its originality and continue to protect its womanhood from this often humiliating experience. But too many voters take on the quality of sheep when they go to the polls and will follow the leader even if they get their tails hung on a briar bush.

We are hereby giving notice that we personally don't intend to take any chance on getting tied up with a hung jury lasting for days and nights on end. If called, we will disqualify ourself right quick by asserting, truthfully, that when a person commits an atrocious crime against another human being, we favor giving him or her the electric chair. Period.

We don't imagine, however, that in the overall picture, there will be any noticeable change in the administration of justice from that which now prevails.

Whereas an all-male jury is inclined to look with a jaundiced eye on a handsome masculine criminal, women will, no doubt, find a logical reason why he should be set free. By the same token, men jurors are strongly influenced in favor of a blonde lawbreaker with shapely legs and sex appeal, while an all-woman jury will probably give her the works.

So, it will very likely all balance up in the end.

Watch for a highly organized smear campaign to get under way for the purpose of discrediting Senator William Knowland of California for his sensible suggestion that we break diplomatic relations with Russia and for his vote against the Communists in the McCarthy censure.

What has been done in the case of the American planes which were shot down by Russia last Fall? There was a lot of blustering talk and then it died down and the silence concerning the dastardly incident is overpowering.

"Human Rights Day" in December was designated by the President who promised the American people he would not ask Congress to ratify the Human Rights Treaty of the United Nations.

Congress Makes the White House the Repository For Vast Sums of Money

The Constitution of the United States very specifically provided that the President should handle no public monies except his own salary and to Congress alone was delegated the authority to appropriate and disburse funds drawn from American taxpayers.

A good time to stop and consider how flagrantly these provisions of the Constitution have been violated is at the beginning of the year of our Lord, 1955, which will probably see finis written to Constitutional government in the United States.

The practice of turning money over to the Chief Executive was begun by Roosevelt's "Yellow Dog" Congress which started tossing him fifty thousand or so at a clip, but it turns out that the New Deal President was a piker and a cheap skate by current standards.

On last August 16th, while the American people peacefully slept and members of the Senate were scurrying around like wharf rats framing a forthcoming "censure" of one of their colleagues for calling some of them by their right names, the Congress passed the "Mutual Defense Assistance Act" which few had read and probably none of them understood.

To assume otherwise would be to class them as embezzlers of public funds and traitors to the taxpayers whose interests they are paid to serve. To attribute their wantonness with the public purse to ignorance and rank irresponsibility is the most charitable conclusion that can be reached.

There are thirty-four pages covering this "Mutual Defense Assistance Act" and each page is heavily dotted with amounts ranging from a few hundred thousand dollars up to billions not only for "defense" but for "raising the living standards" of practically all countries except the United States.

There is no grand total given and there is no way for an ordinary person to arrive at the overall amount because of overlapping amounts and ambiguous provisions designed, apparently, to confuse and cloud the human mind to such an extent that only expert accountants could make heads or tails of it.

We have, however, been able to deduce after fighting through the mass of figures that this Act provides for the squandering of the largest amount of money in the history of organized government and that the President is made a virtual dictator by the Act with unlimited power never dreamed of by the Potentates of antiquity.

Aside from the billions piled upon billions which are to be sent to various countries, the president is allocated a billion, five hundred and twenty-four million and four hundred thousand dollars to be dispensed as he sees fit. To do this he is given authority to hire and fire personnel for carrying out provisions of the Act. He may maintain special missions or staffs around over the earth "for such periods of time as may be necessary". He may transport persons from other countries to the United States and vice versa and exercise other authority never provided for by the founders of the American Republic.

Our discussion of the subject has to do solely with the direct violation of the Constitution which attempted to keep the White House separate from the Treasury Department and we do not presume to touch on the moral aspect of it.

Far be it from us to imply that any president of the United States, past, present or future, would not be impeccably honest or that the money would not be expended along strictly humanitarian lines.

But we do know that if that much money, which belonged to every one in general and no one in particular, were handed to us to do with as we pleased, we would be like the Negro Deacon who suddenly found himself alone with the collection plate brimming over with church funds and who dropped to his knees and prayed:

"Oh, Lawd, please deliver me from this awful temptation and if you can't do that, Lawd, please turn yo' head the other way."

Engineers and Scientists of America is a federation of thirteen labor unions who are bargaining agents for scientific and engineering employes of companies engaged in defense work. It has applied to the Supreme Court to prevent the firing of a Dr. John P. Peters, one of its members whose loyalty was questioned by government agencies. We must be vastly ignorant but we didn't know it was the Supreme Court's business when a man is fired. We thought that in this country an employer could fire an employe for any reason or no reason at all.

The Senate has just one woman member although another member of the fair sex had a fleeting whirl at the job. Some skirt from Nebraska, a Mrs Abel, was named to fill in the unexpired term of a senator who died. She trotted to Washington for the special session, voted against the exposure of Communists, and trotted right home again. She didn't raise the feminine standard in that body, but, on the other hand, she didn't lower it any either. Just left it in status quo.

Postmaster General Summerfield has reported that 166 security risks have been fired from the Postal service and that the surface has only been scratched. And the Postal Service is the main communications system in this country.

Star of One Californian in Ascendancy as Another Sinks

The whole country is observing with approval the growing stature of Senator William Knowland of California and the manner in which he is measuring up to the confidence reposed in him by the late Senator Taft who chose him as his successor as Republican leader in the Senate.

His confidence in demanding severance of relations with Russia and a blockade of Communist China in retaliation for the shooting down of American planes and the imprisonment of American flyers as spies, proves that he will no longer wear the brass collar of Dewey Fair Dealers and administration appeasers. His refusal to follow the Daily Worker in the McCarthy censure movement has added to public confidence in his leadership.

There was a time when the future of Richard Nixon, also of California, was rosy with promise in the matter of party leadership. But his complete capitulation to the Fair Deal wing of Republicans, including his noisy flop into the camp of anti-segregationists, has written finis to his ambitions so far as conservative, right-thinking Americans are concerned. Many are predicting political oblivion for him after his term as vice president expires.

He had it made, but didn't have the strength of character to maintain and enlarge the reputation for conservatism and sound-thinking he was building up in the minds of the American people.

Brazen Effrontery of The Daily Worker Not Resented by Senate

It is possible that there might be an honest difference of opinion on McCarthy among individuals although there is not the slightest doubt that the silly action taken by the Senate against him was inspired, stage-managed and brought to a successful conclusion by Moscow Communists and their allies in this country.

But surely there can be no difference of opinion, except among Communists themselves, about the effrontery of the Daily Worker, official organ of the Party in this country, in daring to address an open letter to the Senate of the United States excoriating a member of that body.

This letter, dated November 10, which was delivered to every member of the Upper House of the American lawmaking body said in winding up its tirade:

"The special session of the Senate has the further duty, it seems to us, of probing more deeply into the McCarthy conspiracy and unseating him".

No official denunciation of this brazen act on the part of Malenkov's cutthroats came from the Senate and if their "dignity" suffered any set-back from this insulting incident, there was no evidence given to the public to this effect.
