Court of the County of Fayette, & Republic aforesaid.
Now if the aforesaid W. B. Meriwether
shall discharge the lawful duties of admin-
istrator upon the effects of the aforesaid
deceased, then this obligation shall be void
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
unto the end of the Law, Signed sealed and
