In discussing a matter pertaining to the above this morning, it came to my notice that a

who I believe is employed by our folks and others as seamstress and who is reported to be a very capable and reliable woman, reported that the wife of her negro servant was taken to the Negro Hospital some weeks ago where she died.

It seems that while she was there Mrs. Currie as well as the husband of the woman visited the hospital, and were quite critical regarding some inhumane consideration and treatment to which they took exceptions, and whether their statements are substantiated or not it would seem to be of such nature as would demand investigation and consideration by the Negro Board as well as the Advisory Committee.
