As international bickering and dissension grow in bitterness and the black clouds of war hang menacingly over vast sectors of the world, a deeper feeling of respect and reverence wells up in the hearts of loyal and respon-sible Americans for the most prophetic phrase ever formulated by human minds: "Friendly relations with all nations; entangling alliances with none."

The Time Has Come When We Must Face Up to the Facts

The first requirement for membership in the United Nations is that a country desiring to join must be a "peace-loving" nation.

Also, the main objective of United Nations as proclaimed throughout the world is the prevention of aggression and the preservation of peace.

Russia is a powerful member of that same United Nations compos-

that same United Nations composed only of "peace-loving" nations. And yet within recent weeks, the Soviets have committed aggress against Hungary, invaded that nation, killed thousands of helpless people and shipped thousands more off to slave camps.

It is plain then, that Russia must be expelled at once from the UN or else the whole Charter must be amended as to requirements for

membership and as to the objective of the organization.

As it now stands, and so long as Russia remains a member, the United Nations is actually commit ted to aggression against small countries, the murdering of innocent men, women and children, and its objective is war and not

The United States has recently gone through a Presidential election following a campaign in which no fundamental issue was discussed by either major can-didate, where no mention was made of the Constitution, no basic law or tradition of the Republic defended, and where the voters were again faced with the everrecurring American Dilemma in which they must seek to choose the lesser of two evils. While it is perhaps natural that the winner should profess to see in the results a "vote of confidence," an honest, soul-searching appraisal on his part must compel the admission that this is not true and that the American electorate was merely in a bad spot without recourse to any other action than that which was taken. It was a case of Scylla on the one hand and Charybdis on the other with the dangerous whirlpool of National Socialism, Mongrelization of the white race and One-World Gov-ernment swirling beneath them, regardless of which path they elected to follow. Starting now, American voters can avoid this noxious impasse in 1960.

The best and the worst which can be said of the battle of the ballots on November 6 is that we are right back where we were and are no worse and no better off than before the election, with the exception of the psychological damage which could accrue if we deliberately, or unwittingly, mis-interpret the meaning of the victory of New Deal Republicans over New Deal Democrats.

One cold stark fact that stands out in bold and vivid outline is that nothing was settled at the polls which is of value in the preservation of the American Republic. Both major parties remain, as before, the outspoken champions of Marxian Socialism. Also, the enemies of the United States, both domestic and foreign, still stand poised and ready to sweep this country into a Communist-type, totalitarian One-World Government when, in the opinion of invisible rulers, the time seems right.

The relative strength of Conservatives and Liberals also remains undetermined as there was no chance to evaluate such division on November 6, since both candidates for President were extreme leftists whose personal ideological beliefs were identical and whose respective

November 6, since both candidates for President were extreme leftists whose personal ideological beliefs were identical and whose respective party policies were indistinguishable. The issue, if any, was merely a question as to which candidate could best administer the extraneous social projects and international give-away programs of a government which now operates wholly outside the Constitution and basic law.

It continues to be our conviction, however, that Conservative sentiment predominates in this country and this belief is based on the fact that it was the overwhelming Conservative vote which elected Eisenhower in 1952 under the mistaken impression that he belonged in that category.

If this premise is correct and the authentic Conservative element of the nation will begin right now to organize under intelligent and responsible leadership with the objective of effecting the nomination of a candidate in 1960 who stands for Constitutional Government and whose loyalty and first allegiance is to his own country and its institutions, there is every reason to believe that the movement will be successful. We know for a fact that hundreds of thousands of Conservatives who voted this time for "Modern Republicanism" held their nose as they did so.

Urban Leagues all over the United States are, of course, propaganda organizations promoting racial mixture and Fort Worth is understood to be the only city in Texas which includes this outfit as a "charity" organization.

stayed away from the polls altogether. In Texas alone, approximately a half million eligible voters failed, or refused, to support either of the candidates and stayed home or went fishing. There were 2,410,188 qualified voters in the State and of this number only 1,930,781 exercised this right.

Apparently an appreciable number of these non-voting Americans in the various States refused to panic at the sickening prospect of having a few amateurs in the pro-Communist league trooping into the White House to advise Adlai Stevenson in the face of the unhappy alternative of having sinister and subtle experts doing the same thing in case of an Eisenhower victory.

Although there was no change for better or worse in the case of the election of a President, there were many by-products of the balloting which should provide genuine cause for rejoicing by responsible Americans and which should inspire renewed hope for 1960.

The overall blessing to the nation, of course, lies in the fact that the Socialist structure known as the Democrat Party has been delivered a death blow which caused it to turn over on its back and expire, and, at the same time, the Marxist egg-head, Adlai Stevenson, was forever shorn of his ambition to national leadership. If similar treatment can be accorded "Modern Republicanism" in 1960, good Americans can once again lift up their heads and look toward the state.

No single casualty of the balloting caused more widespread satisfaction perhaps than the elimination from general circulation of that obnoxious, loud-mouthed, braying donkey from Tennessee, Estes Kefauver, open and avowed enemy of his State, the South and the white race. Equally welcome was the knock-out blow to the political hopes of Frank "National Guard" Clement of the same State whose colossal courage takes the form of ordering guns trained on unarmed citizens, including women, who dare to protest unspeakable indignities to their children. The anti-Stevenson vote in Tennessee practically insures that the political future of this boy wonder is all in the past.

Another break in favor of the safety, security and perhaps the perpetuation of the Republic lies in the fact that the Senate and House will remain in opposition control. While the ideological beliefs of the two parties, as presently constituted, are identical, they still operate under two different labels and the innate jealousy and antagonism of each for the other will probably prove a necessary check on "Modern Republicanism" in attempts to take us all the way into One-World Government, after first having set up a police State in Washington to handle Civil Rights.

Repudiation of Stevenson in Texas for the second time means that this State must be considered doubtful in future which is the best thing that could happen. Since Roosevelt's treachery in overturning the two-thirds rule in 1936, the citizens of Texas have been able to participate in the affairs of the dominant Democrat Party only to the extent of voting for its repugnant candidates. This also applies to Florida, Tennessee, Virginia and Louisiana where the revolt is equally pronounced.

The most heartening aspect of the overturn in Texas was that it made bums out of Lyndon Johnson and Sam Rayburn and left them in the ridiculous attitude of resuming their positions as "leaders" in the forthcoming Congress but having no "followers" in their own home State outside of a few straggling Liberals in the CIO and the defunct NAACP.

Another cause for rejoicing by sound-thinking Americans was in the death knell of the ADA, a motley and nondescript crew comprising the misfits and riff-raff of humanity who shout from one side of their mouth that they are against Communism and, from the other, loudly proclaim its doctrines.

Not to be verlooked for its import in connection with future action is the fact that a practically unknown American, T. Coleman Andrews, with no organization, no leadership and with his name appearing in only a half dozen small States or so, under different party listings,

received around 150,000 votes while a write-in of the name of Senator Harry F. Byrd of Virginia, against his wishes, accounted for an equal number of votes. When it is remembered that these 300,000 Americans had no remote idea of winning but merely wished to register a vigorous protest against National Socialism, Integration and One-World Government, it must be admitted that this solid and unyielding bloc of patriots will figure in any future plan to restore Constitutional Government in the United States.

The myth of a "solid labor vote" in which all workers ballot as a unit on instructions from Union leaders has been blown to Kingdom Come and the illusion of Reuther's great "power" has gone up in smoke. During the campaign his "Committee on Political Education" mailed out more than fifty million pieces of literature and paid for 10,000 television programs in a staggering amount not yet revealed, in an all-out attempt to elect Stevenson and a heavily Democratic Congress. Stevenson won in only seven out of forty-eight States and the House and Senate remain Democratic practically by the same slim majority as before.

And thus the once illustrious party of Jefferson has hit the skids to oblivion. It was first betrayed in the 1930's by charlatans, quacks, and demagogues and was finished off in 1956 by labor racketeers and other assorted political confidence men.

But, even as it lies amid the ruins of its shattered prestige, it anomalously provides the foundation for the re-building from the wreckage, a sound and sturdy structure which could once again restore it to the strength, power and respectability bequeathed in by its founders.

This Herculean task of rehabilitation could be accomplished within the next four years through the assumption of leadership by such strong political figures as Harry Flood Byrd, Herman Talmadge, Allan Shivers, Marvin Griffin, Richard B. Russell, James O. Eastland, John L. McClellan, Strom Thurmond, Jimmy Byrnes, John Bell Williams, Martin Dies, James C. Davis and other Southern Democrats who have never been tarred with the New Deal brush.

Since Conservative Republicans are being purged from that party, as recently publicized by that blabber-mouth phony, Paul Hoffman, and its control by International Socialists is now cinched, it is reasonable to assume that the sound and substantial element from that group would be amenable to a revitalized movement for restoring Constitutional government in this country, regardless of title or name. What have they got to lose?

A Third Party movement has never been successful in the United States to any appreciable extent but the names of the two major parties have been switched back and forth, the principles of each completely changed and reversed and this could be done again. To the faint-hearted who doubt the logic of this reasoning, we offer the reminder that Liberals, Leftists, Socialists, Communists and other Red fringe elements took the party away from the Conservatives in 1936. Are the Conservatives possessed of any less courage, determination and manhood that they can't take it back in 1960?

This would require stamina, vision and dedicated hard work from the grass roots on up as well as the whole-hearted cooperation of the many patriotic groups throughout the country who are already organized around sound principles of government, but the achievement of this glorious end would restore hope for the reclamation of a Republic which, under a quarter century of "Liberal" administration of its government, is fast slipping from its solid mooring.

American Friends Service Committee Now See What Can Happen to Will Live Up to Its Unbroken Record

Although the American Friends Service Committee was recently roundly denounced by the Texas Quakers of the Religious Society of Friends, the former group has just announced that Professor Milton Mayer will fill speaking engagements in Texas in April and May under the Committee's sponsor-

The Texas Quakers charged that the American Friends Service Committee "furthered Communist propaganda" and asserted that their Institutes of International Relations were "schools for Communist propaganda and liberal religions".

Although the Texas Quakers merely made the charges and let the chips fall where they would, they could, if they had desired, have backed up their charges with some very interesting facts. They could, for instance, have produced the record showing that the American Friends, Service Committee ican Friends Service Committee has sponsored such enemies of Amhas sponsored such enemies of Americanism as Alger Hiss, Norman Thomas and Bayard Rustin. They could have produced the record showing that the Friends have presented as speakers at their Seminars such Communist-Fronters as Kirby Page, Georgia Harkness, Stringfellow Barr, Mordecai Johnson, John Zwomley, Olcott Sanders, Bernard C. Clausen, R. O'Hara Lanier, Otto Klineberg and A. J. Muste.

The Texas Quakers could have even gone further and pointed out that the American Friends Service Committee has never been known to sponsor an established anti-Communist or a repentent ex-Com-munist trying to undo the wrong he has done to his country.

As to Professor Milton Mayer whom the friends propose to send on a lecture tour of Texas, he has perhaps the most unsavory record of any of their proteges. He is re-membered best for his infamous statement made at an Institute of statement made at an Institute of International Relations at Syracuse, New York, on February 16th, 1947, at which time the Syracuse Post-Standard quoted him as saying that in order for World Government to prevail "we must haul down the American Flag and if I wanted to be vulgar and shocking, I would go further and say, haul it down, stomp on it and spit on it."

When a storm of protest broke over his head, Mayer claimed that his statement was misunderstood but he has never asked the Post-Standard to retract it and they have offered no apology.

Mayer is a reported affiliate of Mayer is a reported arillate of the Fellowship of Reconciliation which is the fountain-head of a movement to destroy the spirit of patriotism of the American people. He has also been shown as consected with the Great Books Foun nected with the Great Books Foun-

Announcement of the time and place of Mayer's lectures has not been made but it will be interesting to see if the YMCA, YWCA or tax-exempt churches who invariably provide facilities for the Friends-sponsored speakers will come forward with an offer in the case of this particular one.

Segregationist Are Swept Into Houston School Board

Mr. Prather made it clear that the new organization would be "independent" and would have no interest in the State Republican organization.

Texas has proved in elections of recent years that the majority sentiment of the State is Conservative, although voters have not always been especially fond of the candidates they have supported, but rather have cast their ballots against candidates they definitely disliked.

A statewide meeting of Conservatives will be called for an early date, it is reported, and plans possibly begun with the 1960 elections in view.

Americans Sympathize With Dulles in Tragic Illness

Regardless of their attitude toward Secretary of State John Dulles officially, all Americans will deeply sympathize with him personally because of the serious illness which has attacked him.

If the strenuous travelling program in which he seemed to compete with Eleanor Roosevelt in covering the greatest mileage in the shortest time, has contributed in any manner to his physical breakdown, it is doubly regrettable, because we would be far better off if most of the things he has done had been left undone.

It seems such a tragic and unnecessary sacrifice to make to no good end.

We Want to "Contain" Communism but Give Tax-Free Billions to Promote Its Spread

In spite of the fact that five different agents of the Bureau of Internal Revenue have reportedly recommended that the tax-exempt privileges of the Ford Fund for the Republic be revoked, the matter seems to have died down and nothing has apparently been done

Meantime, these Foundations who are not only in politics up to their neck but in subversive movements intended to overthrow the government of the United States and bring it under the domination of a Communist One-World government, continue to be allowed to operate without paying taxes, while loyal Americans must pay until it hurts.

For instance, the Carnegie Peace Corporation sometime ago made a grant of \$1,500,000 to the Institute of International Education, Inc. Later the Rockefeller Foundation made a grant to this same outfit of \$250,000 and still later the Ford Foundation contributed the staggering amount of \$3,500,000 which will be paid to them over the next ten years.

It is unnecessary to go into the record of this Institute of International Education, Inc., to learn what it is because we know what kind of outfits the big Foundations concentrate on in making their grants and donations.

But for the benefit of those who never heard of it, interesting information will be given them in Union Calendar No. 838, House Report No. 2244 of the Second Session of the 84th Congress.

Beginning on page 4 of this report, the Committee on Un-American Activities of which the Honorable Francis E. Walter of Pennsylvania is chairman, gives a list of the "American Branches of the Communist International" and

right in the big middle of it appears the name of the Institute of International Education, Inc.

This Communist organization, to which these big-name Americans give millions, is listed in such company as TASS, Third International, Young Communist International, International Workers Order, Soviet Travel Agency, International Cooperative Alliance, Society for Cultural Relations with Russia, International Friends of Soviet Russia, Communist Party, U.S.A., and thirty-eight other groups and organizations committed to the Communist conspiracy against the United States.

This Institute of International Education holds a Summer School in Moscow and part of its activities in behalf of International Communism is to exchange students between various countries. It will, for instance, take students from Communist countries into non-Communist countries to infiltrate young people there and will, in turn, send students from non-Communist countries into Communist countries where they are indoctrinated with Communist ideals.

If we regard the United States as a non-Communist country, why are these big Foundations permitted to enjoy tax exemption on huge fortunes which are being used to spread Communism over the world while our politicians in Washington run around in circles trying to "contain" Communism and prevent its further spread?

Is there any more effective way to "contain" Communism than to cut off the billions of dollars which our own citizens are donating to the cause of promoting it?

What in the name of all that's Holy is the matter with us any way?

Constitution Takes Another Shellacking

We didn't need to prove the point, but the Supreme Court took one more step recently to indicate how definitely the Constitution has been abandoned in this country and to show that ours is no longer a country of laws but of men.

Governor J. Bracken Lee of Utah sought to file an original petition with the high Court concerning the Foreign Aid program. Lee, in his petition, contended correctly that Congress has no power to collect and expend taxes for the support of foreign nations, and he pled that the Secretary of the Treasury be enjoined from using Taxpayers' money for such purposes.

Of course the Court turned down Governor Lee's petition since the nine old men on the Court have long since abandoned the Constitution as the instrument of basic law in this country. Not only did the Court, inferentially, deny this principle but they refused to let Lee even file his petition.

Also, Lee was handicapped, of course, by the fact that he is a sound Conservative American and not a Communist sympathizer or member of a minority group.

No sooner had these books been removed from the news stands, however, than a lawsuit was threatened against the Censor-ship Bureau and the final outcome of the matter was that the books were restored to the news stands where they again went on sale to teenagers.

The group making the threat to lawsuit against the Censorship Bureau was not composed of the perverted publishers of such books nor the depraved retailers of obscene publications who offer them for sale.

The threat to bring suit unless the books were restored to news stands was — the Detroit Council of Churches, an affiliate of the National Council of Churches.

The success of the Detroit Coun-The success of the Detroit Council of Churches in preventing the suppression of this obscene literature is told in "The Religious Newsweekly," official publication of the Office of Public Relations, National Council of Churches, 297 Fourth Avenue, New York, in a bulletin released for publication November 1, 1956, on page 1.

Common Sense Action Would Save Taxpayers \$100,000,000 Per Year

The resignation recently of Theodore Streibert as head of the United States Information Agency which broadcasts the Voice of America program, afforded an ideal opportunity to disband this worthless and detrimental activity which, at best, has been a joke and, at

Set up under Reorganization Plan No. 8 of 1953, the United States Information Agency was launched August 1, of that year to "combat Communism through different media of communications." Previously the agency had operated as the International Information Administra-

Instead of "combatting Communism" the program from the beginning has used Communist material in preparing its scripts and was so pro-Communist in its leanings that a Subcommittee of the Committee on Government Operations of the Senate was called on to investigate its activities in 1954.

The investigation developed that the Voice of America was not only not fighting Communism but was distributing books by Communists and Communist fronters and that its staff had been instructed specifically "not to do or say anything that would outrage the sentiments of Soviet nationalism". (This was at a time when pro-Communist groups were carrying on a vigorous campaign in this country to break down the strong spirit of nationalism in the United States.)

At the hearing, Senator Everett Dirksen of Illinois brought out that during the Lincoln Day program put on by the voice of America the only reference to Lincoln was when the broadcaster read a letter to Lincoln from Karl Marx in which this broadcaster left the inference that Lincoln approved of Marxian theory

The investigation brought out that while Congress was appropriating more than a hundred million dollars annually to carry on the U.S.I.A. activities including this Voice of America program for the purpose of fighting Communism, the works of such Communists as Howard Fast were being used in the broadcasts. Earlier Fast had appeared before this same committee and repeatedly refused to tell whether he was a Communist on the grounds that such answer would "incriminate" was a Communist on the grounds that such answer would "incriminate"

On July 7, 1955, Streibert released a statement to the press giving the names of the country's "leading writers" who were writing the scripts broadcast by the Voice of America. Included in this list were those of such Communist fronters as Dorothy Canfield Fisher, William Saroyan, James T. Farrell, Erskine Caldwell, Pearl Buck, William Carlos Williams, Vardis Fisher, Upton Sinclair and others.

Instead of seizing on this opportunity to discontinue an agency which has caused so much embarrassment to this country, which is a heavy drain on the taxpayers and which has done only harm through its corrupt operation, the President is reported in the press as having chosen Arthur Larson to take Streibert's place and continue the farce.

When Larson's name is before the Senate for confirmation at the next session, it would seem that there would be some responsible member of that body who would point out the idiocy of the Voice of America program which has always done more harm than good and would propose complete elimination of the project and offer a bill to that effect.

Instead, the chances are that this atrocity which costs taxpayers one hundred million dollars annually will be left undisturbed and that Larson will be confirmed.

It is unnecessary to add that Larson is of the same ideological stripe as Streibert and, if possible, more so.

Amarillo Commands Respect of Patriots In Outstanding Tribute to Americanism

The admiration and respect of loyal Americans throughout the country have been centered on the Amarillo, Texas Globe-Times for the spectacular observance of United States Day on October 23rd and for the gracious and inspiring tribute paid to Americanism and American institutions by that outstanding Daily of the Texas Panhandle.

Featuring the celebration of the occasion by Amarillo's Hanson Post of the American Legion, of which Charles Gibson of that city is chairman, the Globe-Times carried the American Flag in color on the front page together with the Legion chairman's plea that American citizens always "fly the United States Flag and no other — either National or International."

Carried also was a warning from the Legion concerning the loss of American freedoms which imperil the Republic.

"As shocking as it may sound, we have already lost much that our forefathers fought and died to attain," Gibson was quoted as saying. "By an arrogant usurpation of power, without the consent of the people or of Congress, the Federal Courts have changed the meaning of the Constitution. They have restrained the rights of individuals and of the States contrary to all previous decisions of the courts. Likewise, by the encroach-

The only persons who do not seem to know how to handle the situation with regard to Russia and her unspeakable behavior toward other nations, are those in Washington whose responsibility it is to handle it. As sound-thinking Americans without number have pointed out, over and over again, it could be cured automatically by withdrawal of all foreign aid to Russia and other Communist countries and by severing relations with these countries. Former President Says He Has No Regrets

In a speech in Chicago recently, former President, Herbert Hoover, said he had no regrets for having opposed the entry of the United States into World War II.

He certainly should have none for the whole world recognizes now that our contrived entrance into a war that should not have concerned us, was one of the worst of our many blunders.

At that time, Mr. Hoover urged that we should stand aside while two monsters, Stalin and Hitler destroyed each other pointing out that by this course we could, by our strength, dignity and neutrality, bring lasting peace to the world.

But of course we had to get in the act because the alien countries who had more to say concerning our foreign policy than our own leaders, told us to. And we took as our "ally" an uncivilized and brutal nation who is now doing everything within its power to spread Communism all over the face of the earth, and to destroy the United States in the process.

The United Nations which Secretary of State Dulles calls that "vigorous instrument of international order and justice" was willing and eager to send its "international police force" into Egypt to "halt aggression." Just How "Secure" Is Our National Security Program?

Five times since 1952, officials of the General Electric Company have appeared before Congressional committees in Washington to urge more adequate legislation on Communism in industry in the interest of national security.

In all this testimony before the committees, it was emphasized that there were two aspects of the problem; first the danger of Communists functioning as labor leaders and, second, the peril of individual subversives in the employment of defense industries.

The primary cause of the trouble is that Federal law compels heads of industry to recognize and bargain with any labor organization certified to it by the National Labor Relations Board and as pro-Communisthave been frequently flushed out of the NLRB when some outside source exposed them, that agency is naturally not too concerned as to whether the Union it certifies is or is not Communist - dominated. To expect otherwise, would be like asking a skunk to purge the odor from a den of polecats.

General Electric is forced to deal with the United Electrical Workers which has been repeatedly accused by Congressional committees of being Communist-dominated. When any attempt has been made by official committees to investigate this UEW, witnesses almost invariably have pled the Fifth amendment when asked if they belonged to the Communist Party.

When Lemuel R. Boulware, vice president of the General Electric Company last appeared before the Internal Security Sub-Committee of the Senate, he pointed out that the government has, for the most part, refrained from taking any action against Communist dominated Unions and reminded the committee that when Attorney General Herbert Brownell prepared a list of "totalitarian, Fascist, Communist or subversive organizations," no labor unions were included.

He expressed amazement that the United States Government should order defense plant employers to bargain with unions generally regarded as being under the control and domination of Communists. He expressed the belief that it was the responsibility of the government to investigate and find out who are Communists among union leaders and to prevent such union leaders from functioning in any way as the bargaining representatives of employees.

He also pointed out that the basic principle of the Wagner and Taft-Hartley acts is to guarantee that employees, and not employers — will choose the Union to be bargained with.

Mr. Boulware further stated that during the Korean War, his company repeatedly asked the government to furnish names and information concerning any General Electric employes who might be considered subversive. This information was refused.

Such criminal neglect and carelessness in matters having to do with the national security is almost unbelievable and it is perhaps impossible for many to comprehend it, but for those who must keep up with such matters from official records, it is just one instance in hundreds in which our policies are indefensible.

In this connection, it might be advisable for the social psychologists and political psychiatrists who are running wild on the bases in an effort to turn up mentally ill persons, to do a little research work among those who are trusted with guarding our national security.

Indescribable Immorality Results From Mixing of Races in Schools

The Washington D.C. public school system, which was so bravely touted as an example in integration "for the whole nation to follow" has become, instead, a sort of educational Black Hole of Calcutta from which thousands of white children are escaping as their parents move away or transfer them to private schools.

When the black cloud of integration descended on Washington schools in 1954, practically without warning or preparation, as a result of the gruesome ruling by the Supreme Court, an insufferable situation developed which finally resulted in the appointment of a committee of the Congress to investigate.

Every possible obstacle was thrown in the way of the investigation by the same forces which invariably gang up to halt probes into Communist infiltration in this country, integration being, of course, one of the most vicious facets of the Communist apparatus, but members of the Committee refused to be intimidated. They have conducted a thorough probe of the matter and will continue with the investigation, refusing to let anything throw them off the track.

Washington school teachers, risking the loss of their jobs, appeared before the committee and testified to the horrible conditions which this unnatural mixing of black students with those of the white race has brought about.

So far as education is concerned it was the consensus of the testimony that, rather than white children lifting colored children up to their own level, the Negroes were dragging white children down to the colored level with the result that the standard of Washington schools which was one of the highest before integration, has dropped to an all-time low.

Morally, conditions are almost indescribable. The most common complaint seemed to be that Negro boys send obscene notes to white girls, make indecent exposure of their persons in the class room, carry switch-blade knives, destroy school property and steal money from other students, gang up and beat white children and are openly insulting to teachers. More pregnancies on the part of students have occured in the past two years than in all previous history and a case was reported in one room where a Negro girl bragged to white students of being an un-wed mother.

Evidence was also offered that one big Washington newspaper which is definitely pro-Red slants all information given to the public about conditions under segregation; that it deliberately reduced the number of cases of unwed Negro mothers in one school from 25 to 7 and that when a reporter was sent to one school to get a photo of the Negro honor students and was told there were none, he refused to make any picture at all.

Although strong attempts are being made to prevent a complete report given out concerning the investigation, it is understood that such report will be made and that it will probably be available to the public.

Members of the Subcommittee to investigate the situation are James C. Davis of Georgia, Chairman, John Bell Williams of Mississippi, Woodrow W. Jones, North Carolina, A. L. Miller, Nebraska, Joel T. Broyhill of Virginia and DeWitt S. Hyde of Maryland.

Western Diplomats Insulted at Party Given by Soviet Officials

Officials of the "peace-loving" Soviet Republic which is a topdog in the "peace-loving" United Nations, threw a party in Moscow on November 18 which, believe it or not, was attended by our Ambassador and those from other Western Countries.

No sooner had they arrived at the party until the vodka-swilling swine, Nikita S. Kruschchev, Communist Party head began showering them with insults for no obvious reason except, perhaps, just to keep his hand in and not get out of practice in his favorite indoor sport.

"We will bury you" was his cheerful greeting to the American envoy and the English and French representatives as well. "If you do not like us, do not accept our invitations and do not invite us to you". Adding sacrilege to insult the drunken beast bragged of conditions in the Soviet and added: "Things are going very well with us. If we believed in the existence of God, we would thank Him for it".

Incredible as this barbaric behavior may seem, it is even more amazing that official representatives of supposed Christian Nations should be present at such degenerate orgies.

It was the second time in recent weeks that the Western Ambassadors had attended a similar event in Moscow and insults to their countries were hurled at them on both occasions. They walked out the first time and then came back for more.

The explanation of the affair, not of Kruschchev's performance, but of the presence of the American Ambassador at the second event, after being forced after repeated insults to leave the first, should be interesting and informative.

Full details of Kruschchev's conduct was given in a United Press release on November 19.

Mongrelizers Take Up Where They Left Off

It must have irked the souls of members of the Supreme Court to have to wait until after the election to continue the job of total mongrelization which they have set for themselves.

But the ballots were no sooner counted than they were up and at 'em. Emboldened by the fact that they have gotten away so far practically with murder they ruled, not in an inter-state but in a state bus case, that segregation must go.

Specifically they were ruling on Montgomery, Alabama, buses but other integrationists will jump the gun and try to put it over all over the South.

The only heartening thing about the whole lamentable affair is that, in those Southern States where there is strong, vigorous and determined leadership, there will be no de-segregation of bus passengers, Supreme Court or no Supreme Court.

Later: As we go to press, Herbert Brownell, Jr., Attorney General of the United States through appointment by President Eisenhower, is reported in an announcement from Washington to have stated that "The United States will force scrapping of Bus Segregation, in the 14 Southern States where the statutory enactment calls for segregation on buses."

The announcement from Brownell came just at the height of the Dock Workers strike which threatens to become nation-wide, and which is intended to cause general demoralization throughout the country, thereby aiding the Communist cause. His announcement also came at a time when the situation in Hungary and the Middle East threatens to involve the whole world. What an appropriate time to announce more aggression against the South by the Federal government.

This latest assault by the Supreme Court should at least have one effect and that is to cause Americans to have more sympathy for the Hungarians who are being over-run by hordes of Soviet terrorists. In a milder form we are suffering a threat to our freedom and our rights from tyrants, even though these tyrants are only nine old men on the Supreme Court.

House Democratic members are said to be in a dither over the propriety of seating a newly-elected Congressman from Massachusetts who has served a term in the penitentiary for income tax evasion. A good way to settle it would be for each member to figure up the total amount of extortion against taxpayers which he and his colleagues are guilty of. It will then be easier for them to judge the morals of the new House member.
