Executive Committee of University
of Houston - House of Rep.

The Executive Committee Meeting, of the University of Houston House of Representatives was called to order by Speaker, Charles-La Monte, at 7:00 P. M. in the Student Government Office.

Linda Knapp, Social, Education, and Development chairman and Allan Segal, Process and Procedure chairman were absent.

Charles announced that these meetings would be very informal.

Jerry Monroe, Chairman of Monetary and Fiscal gave his committee report. He recommended the following changes in the following bills:

Bill Number 1, Moot Court Bill - Law School Transportation by auto wasn't as far as the bill stated. Therefore, only \$51.00 would be allowed for transportation. Also, since the papers were already printed up that they wanted Student Government to pay for, there was no need for Student Government to spend this extra money for printing already done. This is for both of their conventions.

Bill Number 1 will be allowed \$99.00

Bill Number 1, part 2, will be allowed \$72.20.

Bill Number 2 was approved as it was.

Bill Number 3, the Optometric Bill was amended also in the committee.

The committee saw no need for four students to be going to the convention. No one can make all the meetings at all the conventions usually, so three should be able to do the job as well as four.

It was amended for 3/4 of the bill. \$459.81. - also because of lack of funds.

It was then brought up by the rest of the executive committee, that when plane was the means of transportation, that there should be a standard of sending only 2. This was the opinion of the executive committee. It was to be sent back to Monetary and Fiscal as the committee's opinion.

Certification and Installation chairman - Barri Bodden. She and Speaker, Charles La Monte, due to the controversy of swearing in House Members, will call the names of those sworn in at the last meeting and reswear them in again, this time by the speaker. However, the Speaker may delegate the power to the chairman of Certification and Installation to do the swearing in of new members.

Since there was no further business the meeting was adjourned.
