been referred to me for reply.

As you requested, we are sending under separate  
cover a catalog of our College of Engineering.

In reply to your question about the University's  
attitude toward Negro students, I must report that  
the matter of desegregation is currently a subject  
of serious study on the part of the University and  
its Board of Regents. To date no Negro has been  
admitted to the University of Houston, and it  
appears likely that desegregation at the graduate  
level will be preliminary to admission of under-  
graduate Negro students.

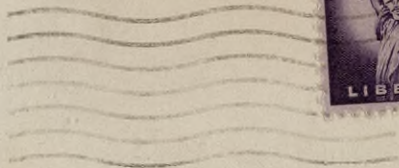
