Referring to your telegram of the 14th:

While I saw the small sketch of the grounds in one of the prints, what I referred to was the ground plan of the property which has a print having our file number, which I believe Mr. Sullivan copied. This should be brought down to date, showing the location, distances, etc. of all present and prospective buildings, structures, etc. of all kinds.

If it has not been done by Mr. Sullivan's office, he should furnish the dimensions and the correct information that may be added to our tracing by the Engineer.

Prospective buildings should now show the dimensions of such to provide for the ultimate requirements, which, as I recall it, we fixed for a plant of 300 or more beds.
